FORGOTTEN GOD? HOW CAN THAT BE THE PROBLEM? sent from David Smith

While I was still a child, I recall hearing a number of older people offer the following explanation for the great disasters that had befallen Russia: Men have forgotten God; that's why all this has happened... (After) fifty years working on the history of our Revolution... I repeat: Men have forgotten God; that's why all this has happened. - Godlessness: the First Step to the Gulag - Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn 1983.

With the exception of a few individual Christians, the Church in its most general sense has been one of the great casualties of the 20th century. It has continually narrowed the Gospel of the Kingdom, which Christ took such pains to teach, into a narrowly defined 'gospel of salvation'. Congregations often contain people who have received spiritual revelation, but who are then, without realising it, imprisoned in comfort zone assemblies which go no further than the perpetuation of personal blessings. **The idea that the Christian has enlisted in a growing movement for universal change, where the kingdoms of the world become the Kingdom of our Lord is a mystery to the majority.** The blame for this must sit to a large extent on pastors, priests and ministers. Instead of equipping Christians and sending them forth in the battle for Truth, the minister is too often consumed with the size of the congregation under their direction. If 'politically-correct' is an evil, 'spiritually-correct' should be anathema. The Sunday service and a host of evening groups and functions have become an end in themselves.

Any issue which might 'divide the congregation' is banished from the Church environment. The eighth deadly sin is to 'be controversial'. The result is that for many the Church scene is stifling. Much of what is being done in effective Christian practice is by refugees from the denominational scene. To this perpetuation of neutrality must be added an obsession with dispensationalism – the notion that prophecy has bought us to a 'last-days' syndrome, where the unfolding of events has reached a 'count-down' stage which no longer yields to faith or hope. Apart from a brand of evangelism which is often denominational recruitment, the nearest Christians come to social responsibility is 'ambulance-aid'; an attempt to help victims without ever challenging the causes of casualty... Within a 40 kilometre radius of my nearest town there are 69 congregations holding weekly services. It has had little effect on the social conditions in the town, which has the usual quota of crime, poverty, breakdown and suicides. It was not always so.... *J. TRAVELS IN CULTURAL NIHILISM By Richard Miller

However, that was a review based on a review, but now I have read this excellent book and have a few words to add here. First, this is our kind of book written by a British academic, Dr Leonard being at the time a Fellow of Exeter College Oxford. I was curious enough to search the web to see if he still held a fellowship, or was made redundant, but in all honesty he still seems to be in the academic system. Not only that, but he proudly displays his book as part of his academic output. This is surprising because basically Leonard says much of what the contributors at this site have been saying about the ethno-racially caused collapse of Europe due to mass immigration, especially of Muslims. The book deals extensively with the Swedish decay, but being published in paper, and in 2017, much of the book is dated, not incorrect, but the situation has got so much worse.

Again, readers can access a large number of articles published at our site alor.org, on Sweden. On this point, Leonard ponders why societies such as Sweden, facing impending collapse, still have majority support for multiculturalism policies, but recent polls indicate that in Europe public opinion is beginning to sour about open acceptance of unending migration, a matter that others have discussed at this site. *(continued on next page)*

(continued from previous page) As an academic, Leonard devotes considerable attention to the collapse of free thought on the Western university campus, the 'waste lands of groupthink', and the domination of discourse by the antics of 'champagne socialists'. In the 1960s these creatures championed orthodox Marxism, but beginning in the 1970s and accelerating in the 1980s, they went full diversity mode, with the fanaticism of a fundamentalist religion, all backed by taxpayer's money. Leonard diagnoses this evil disease well, but his ultimate solution is a little limp: conservative academics need to oppose this orthodoxy and fight it (p. 31). Yes, fine, and he has done this, but, the new class have worked ceaselessly to eliminate academics like him from the system.

In Australia, there is no-one working as an academic at any university who could do what Leonard is doing. He is the singularity. Thus, he fails to fully appreciate his own argument about the utter level of corruption of the universities in the West. multiculturalism and who will defend a whole schema of freedom infringements in order to achieve it'. (p. xix)

In doing so, the new class have moved to embrace anyone who can act to destroy traditional values, and they align themselves with this other, and defend and nurture them, encouraging their growth. In a sense, then, **the new class elites are partners in a form of cultural terrorism**, more dangerous than a knife or truck attack.

What is to be done? As usual, this is the weakest part of any book or article on these sorts of crippling topics, because answers are hard to come by beyond coming up with some way of getting the lead back into the white man's pencil, so to speak. Leonard says that the ideologies which have produced this crisis are being revealed as self-defeating (p.286). He hopes that communities of strong localists, schooled in philosophies of anti-globalism and financial independence, will soon emerge to challenge the rotting status quo. In particular, globalist organisations such as the EU need to be dismantled. Yes, that is a good start, but we need a more comprehensive program than the suggestions made by Leonard in the closing chapter of his book. ***

CLIMATE LESSONS FROM KING CANUTE By Viv Forbes

Climate Aristocrats and Bureaucrats from 190 nations are meeting in Bonn, dreaming up rules 'to prevent the globe from warming more than 2°C'. They have forgotten the lesson of mighty King Canute - he demonstrated that not even his great power could roll back the tide. Changing Climate is the natural state on Earth. VITAMIN C AND HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE By Mrs Vera West

Again, the usual disclaimer for these sorts of articles, that this is not medical advice in any way, but journalistic reporting on news sources, for health problems see a qualified practitioner etc. etc. That said, there are reports in the literature that vitamin C lowers blood pressure and has benefits to the cardiovascular system, claims made since at least 1954 when Noble Prize winner biochemist Linus Pauling first began to make his claims about the health benefits of vitamin C.

“Our research suggests a modest blood pressure lowering effect with vitamin C supplementation, but before we can recommend supplements as a treatment for high blood pressure, we really need more research to understand the implications of taking them,” says Edgar “Pete” R. Miller III, M.D., Ph.D., an associate professor in the division of general internal medicine at the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine and leader of the study published in the American Journal of Clinical Nutrition. Miller and his colleagues reviewed and analyzed data from 29 randomized, controlled, previously published clinical trials that reported systolic and/or diastolic blood pressure values and also compared vitamin C intake to a placebo. What they found is that taking an average of 500 milligrams of vitamin C daily — about five times the recommended daily requirement — reduced blood pressure by 3.84 millimeters of mercury in the short term. Among those diagnosed with hypertension, the drop was nearly 5 millimeters of mercury. By comparison, Miller says, patients who take blood pressure medication such as ACE inhibitors or diuretics (so-called “water pills”) can expect a roughly 10 millimeter of mercury reduction in blood pressure. Five hundred milligrams of vitamin C is the amount in about six cups of orange juice. The recommended daily intake of vitamin C for adults is 90 milligrams.”

There are other informative discussions of the benefits of vitamin C published online. The reductions may not be enough for many people, so don't contemplate going of any medication without medical advice that you can
