THOUGHTS OF THE WEEK:

“It is not difficult for the housewife to have a pretty good understanding of the farmer and his work. For both he and she specialise in the service of the growth and care of living things. You know about children; how each is different from the other, what small alterations of this or that will help or hinder straight growth, how you and they grow together—on different planes—in understanding.

It is very much the same with the farmer. He knows such things about plants and animals. The soil, and how it varies from field to field; of what it will grow and what it will not; of weeds and their curious habits; of animals, their pedigrees and personal peculiarities; of sowing, reaping, hedging, thatching and all the work that goes on around a farm. The real farmer has an immense store of such observation and practice. It is this which links him to the land. This link is being broken, in favour of quite another idea. For there are two irreconcilable ideas in conflict: — “The first of these is that the world we live in is an organism, and that men and animals have intricate relationships with the earth, not amorphous but specific and infinitely varied, which can only be disregarded at the 'peril' of both men and that earth they live on. The second and antithetic idea is that the world is merely raw material for a factory, and that the nearer agriculture approximates to Mr. Ford's conveyor-belt principles, the better we shall be.”

PRIMARY PRINCIPLES By David Smith

The quote from Sir Samuel Wadham (*On Target*, Vol. 55, No. 43) is a statement of the primary importance of agriculture and farming to nations and peoples as a whole. Whilst I take the point he is making about farming being a biological activity rather than industrial activity, I believe it was given the term primary industry to show its primacy over all other forms of industry, primary meaning first in importance or original, and also, that which all other forms of industry rely on and are derived from.

To be a viable nation state requires first and foremost that we be able to independently sustain ourselves with the necessities of life, food and clothing. This is the reason so many men were told in 1939-45, you cannot go to war, you are an essential industry for the war effort here at home. This included those from both primary and secondary industries. Essential; of primary importance once again.

During a drought in the Howard years of Government when I understand we had 240,000 farmers, former leaders of the Nationals Doug Anthony and John Anderson advocated paying indebted farmers to leave the land, thus transferring the asset of the farm (plus all monies already paid to banks as interest), to the banks, then giving a payout to the farmer from taxpayers to leave the land.” We don’t need 240,000 farmers, half that many in today’s modern “scientific” farming scene would be better.” Well today we are being told the same lie, except the only buyers will be China and big corporate interests, whose main concern lie in profits and or feeding their own people, not the nurture of the soil and the feeding and clothing of Australians as their primary function. "New Zealand's government is coming under increasing political pressure to raise welfare payments, echoing a similar debate in Australia. The surging cost of living has exposed inequalities in New Zealand at a time when the local economy is doing well. Growth rates are well above Australia's and the OECD average. The Kiwi economy is close to full employment, with unemployment rates at an 11-year low of 3.9 per cent. Yet more are being left behind, with surging numbers of people sleeping rough and applying for hardship grants. Figures from the

Ministry of Social Development reveal the dark side of New Zealand's have-and-have-not society. This winter, 29,000 emergency housing grants were made - doubling last year's tally - at a cost of NZ\$41 million (\$38 million)."

“It would be nice if the “facts” being thrown around in the debate over the Cashless Debit Card were peer-reviewed, or even just evidence-based.

Instead, there are anecdotes. And it's these that are being used to justify the government's decision to spend A\$128.8 million over four years continuing the existing trial of the cashless debit card in five sites in Western Australia, Queensland and South Australia and extending it to Cape York and all of the Northern Territory. The extension will lift the number of people on the card from 11,000 to 33,000. Most will be Indigenous people - its disproportionate targeting has already attracted the attention of the National Congress of Australia's First Peoples and the Human Rights Commission. The cashless card was recommended to Prime Minister Tony Abbott in a report from mining billionaire Andrew Forrest in 2014.

The “Indue” Cashless Debit Card trials underway since 2016 direct 80% of each payment to the card (Forrest asked for 100%) where it can only be spent on things such as food, clothes, health items and hygiene products. When leaders in the East Kimberley who initially agreed to the card withdrew their support, the government continued with the trial anyway. Its success has not been established. ***
