KOREA AND REALITIES

"United Nations" Chatter or Realistic National Action?

At a time when most official heads are high in the international clouds it is refreshing to find one voice raised realistically against the dangerous flirtations by our public men with UNO and the equally sickening fawning on this Communist inspired body by most of the daily press. We are indebted to "The Bulletin" of July 12 for the following article: —

The one-afternoon debate on the Korean situation in Canberra was not inspiring. The gist of all speeches, from that of Mr. Menzies downwards, hinged round the Prime Minister's resolution: —

That this House, having before it the Charter of the United Nations and the recent resolution of the Security Council in relation to Korea, approves of the action taken by the Government in placing at the disposal of the United Nations the forces indicated in the statement of the Prime Minister.

This resolution received the formal support of the whole House, though it was a sullen and muttering support on the "Labor" side, highlighted by outbursts from Messrs. Ward and Calwell, who appeared to have been dragged to the altar to witness the sacrifice of their cardinal political principle that everything a non-"Labor" Government does must be wrong. Much of the lack of patriotic fire was because Australia purports to be acting through U.N.O., whereas the fight which is now being waged in Korea is really part of a fight between an Asiatic barbarism, led from Moscow, and the British-speaking peoples, who can expect very little help from anybody else in the present or any foreseeable struggle.

Only Talk at U.N.O.

The only other nations, which would be capable of supporting them, are either disorganised by internal strife or captive in the hands of the victors of the last war. U.N.O. has been unable so far to secure among its major member-nations sufficient agreement to enable a peace-treaty to be made with Germany as a whole and Japan, or to use its strength, which is supposed to be a sovereign deterrent against Soviet attack on the democracies, to persuade Russia to allow its allies a hand in determining the fate of Eastern Europe, whose people are now bound hand and foot to Stalin's chariot-wheel.

One inescapable fact is that if the United States and/or members of the British Commonwealth had not acted in Korea there would have been nothing save talk and provocative and futile resolutions from most

of the rest of U.N.O. Another is that whatever U.N.O. and its strange Security Council did, both the United States and the British Commonwealth were bound to act or else get out of Asia altogether. To allow the North Koreans with their Chinese-Communist war-training and their abundance of Moscow-made weapons to overrun South Korea would have been to lose face altogether with the Asiatics and to create a situation in Japan which would ultimately have had disastrous results in our international relations.

Fighting For Ourselves

Korea, in the Japanese outlook, is "a dagger pointed at the heart of Japan," and one of the reasons why the Japanese have accepted occupation by the Allies with docility and given a co-operation greater than expected lies in their fear of being left as helpless prey for the Russians. From them they know they could expect no more mercy as a nation than their hundreds of thousands of soldiery who fell into the hands of the Kremlin as the result of a Manchurian victory in which the Red Army scarcely fired a shot, except at executions.

The prime urge which is driving the American, British, Australian, Canadian, New Zealand and Netherlands Governments—the only ones which have so far contributed, or taken steps to contribute, immediate practical assistance in support of the South Koreans—is not lip-service to the alleged "democratic principles" and aspirations for peace of the U.N.O. nations, but a grim realisation that the few civilised countries of the world which remain are fighting for everything which means anything to them. They are fighting for Western progress, Western freedom, and Western culture. They are fighting to hold back a wave of barbarism such as the world has never seen since the invading hordes of Asia put out the lights of Rome and set the world's civilisation back a thousand years. And it is scarcely in question that they would be able to fight better if this view were put frankly and if the war were divorced from U.N.O., one of whose most powerful members is our open enemy, as well as an organiser and provider of munitions in North Korea's aggression.

Dumbarton Hoax

If it can be got into the heads of the citizens of Western nations that they are fighting for themselves and for their homes they will certainly fight much better than if they believe they are fighting merely for the "principles of the Atlantic Charter," and that they are being "placed at the disposal" of the Security Council.

One of these days historians will make a closer study of U.N.O. and find room for astonishment in the discovery that its foundation was built on principles which strangely suit Communist plans and ambitions. "Support Dumbarton Oaks!" was

OUR POLICY

Socialist Policies

Following the announcement that the Federal bureaucracy increased by 1,116 during May, Mr. Fadden attempted to justify the increases by using arguments very similar to those advanced in the past by the Labor Party.

In a letter to the Melbourne press on July 13, Mr. Eric D. Butler, Campaign Director of the Victorian League of Rights, commented as follows on the subject of the Federal bureaucracy:

"Mr. Fadden's attempt to justify the steady expansion of the Federal public service, an expansion which he trenchantly criticised when an Opposition Member merely directs attention to the fact that, in spite of pre-election promises, the present Government is pursuing a Socialist policy of rapidly increasing the scope of the Federal Government's activities and is encroaching upon fields of activity which genuine anti-Socialists believe should not be the province of the Federal Government.

"There are many who loosely criticise the too-rapid growth of the Federal public service without having the courage or the logic to point out that this growth can only be curtailed by reducing Government activities in those fields where the individual can best look after his own interests.

Mr. Fadden has no hope of reducing taxes, preventing inflation, or curtailing the growth of the Federal bureaucracy while Mr. Casey and his growing team of planners continue their grandiose schemes of 'National Development.'"

War and Depression

If it was not for war, or the threat of war, adherence to orthodox financial rules would, in the U.S.A. and all other highly industrialised countries, have resulted in a major depression.

The New York Herald Tribune of December 10, 1947, quoted Dr. Slichter, Harvard economist and a member of the United States Committee for Economic Development, as having said:

"Without the cold war the demand for goods by the Government would be many millions of dollars less than now. He added that a severe American depression was 'quite difficult to conceive so long as we are enjoying the benefits of a cold war.'"

Correct, Mr. Calwell

"I was astonished recently to find just how blatant certain representatives of the Indonesian Government are on the subject of Communism. On the third of this month I saw a report in a newspaper to the effect that Dr. Hatta, who is the Prime Minister of Indonesia, told his Parliament, in closed session, that there were no big obstacles in the way of Indonesian recognition of the Indo-Chinese Viet-minh leader, Ho Chi-minh, who is a rebel against the authority the Government of his country and a Communist puppet. Ho Chi-minh has not overthrown the lawful government of his country, yet the Indonesian Government is thinking of recognising him, and Dr. Hatta

is reported to have said that recognition depended on whether it would be useful to Ho Chi-minh and, at the same time, bring no difficulties to Indonesia. This opportunistic attitude on the part of the rulers of Indonesia indicates that whatever assistance Australia may give to that country may ultimately benefit the Communists who may take over Indonesia in the future just as the aid which America poured into Nationalist China went to the Communist forces and was used to expel all traces of association with the western world from that country. I am not as optimistic as are the Minister and those who think with him that in giving aid to these countries, Australia will be casting its bread upon the waters and it will return a thousand fold."

Jewish Influence in Britain

G. F. Green, publisher of the new edition of "The International Jew" (published first by Henry Ford, Sr.) in his intimate letter from London reveals that Dr. Fuchs, who stole the atom and hydrogen bomb secrets and gave them to Stalin while working with our Atomic Commission, is a full-blooded Jew. Here's what Green says about it: "There was a time when the Fuchs case would have thrown down a government, but it made brief 'news' in the press and did not become a major party issue. Why the soft pedal? The Tory Party and the 'national' press could easily have roused the nation on this one issue. There are many thousands of Jews and other aliens tucked away in protected jobs, wielding great influence in Britain. What has happened to the boasted 'purge' of Communists and fellow travellers in high places? The answers: Fuchs and his like were introduced into Britain and into their jobs by the Chamberlain Tory Administration. They advanced in power and profit during the wartime coalition under Churchill; protected always by the 'intellectual-internationalists' of the Labour and Liberal Parties . . . never did the press raise any doubts! Since 1945, many more thousands have been rushed into jobs. The political, economic, scientific—in fact, the entire social structure of Britain is drenched in Judaic-internationalism. An occasional scandal gets top-heavy and 'leaks' . . . but it serves only to provide cynical opportunity for pious declaration and 'patriotic' assurances by the Party bosses. The facts are suppressed, and a supine public dozes again—convinced that high treason is 'an isolated case.'"

"A Very Raw Deal"

Speaking in the Federal Parliament on June 14, Mr. W. S. Kent Hughes (Liberal, Victoria) said that the Federal Government

was "running a racket" on the States. He also said that after examining the Federal Budget, he considered that the Commonwealth was running a "first-class financial slander."

Mr. Kent Hughes added that the States had been getting "a very raw deal" ever since the introduction of uniform taxation.

After this very outspoken attack against the crushing of local government by centralised control of financial policy, Mr. Kent Hughes unfortunately did not urge that this control be destroyed, but contented himself with the suggestion that a "fairer" financial arrangement between the States and the Commonwealth be worked out.

The only democratic arrangement is one, which will ensure that the States have genuine financial sovereignty and the power to curb the centralising tendencies of the Federal Government.

Professor Lattimore

. . . Those who feel mystified about the McCarthy-Lattimore affair would do well to consult the *Record* of March 30, containing the Wisconsin Senator's long speech. In some passages (*Record*, p. 4448) McCarthy quotes freely from Lattimore's books on Asia (*The Situation in Asia*, *The Solution in Asia and Manchuria: Cradle of Conflict*) to show the Professor's views on China and Asia. These emphasise his long-held convictions that Soviet Russia has been fated to win all Asiatics to its side, that this is not Red Imperialism, that Russia is "creative" (while Western nations are not) and has irresistible dynamism, and that there is not and has not been anything we can do about it save submit to Russian victory. A very recognisable "line."

One newspaper, the *Chicago Tribune*, took advantage of this searching analysis in the *Congressional Record*. In an inimitable editorial (April 6) entitled "Lattimore's Vision of Destiny," the *Tribune* quotes copiously from the Professor's books, including a veritable Lattimore gem: "To be progressive in politics means to be on the side of that which is going up and against that which is going down." The *Tribune* winds up: "Senator McCarthy suggested that this last statement explains Mr. Lattimore. By his every account, Soviet Russia and Communism are bound to triumph. It is historically inevitable—the Marxian view. So, said the Senator, Mr. Lattimore has chosen his side. If the investigating committee finds that Mr. Lattimore is not what Senator McCarthy says he is, will it kindly tell the American people just what he is?"

This statement is of considerable interest, as the accounts of the McCarthy-Lattimore affair in the Australian Press have failed to provide the essential background, which is evidently disclosed in Professor Lattimore's books. Few, of course, are more useful to the Communists and other One-Worlders than professorial "intellectuals" who have the ear of Ministers, and follow the One-World line while apparently not recognising themselves as dupes of secret agents. We have the type in Australia.

Behind "Politics"

By H. R. Purchase

The immediate reaction to reading this excellent book, at any rate as far as your reviewer is concerned, is surprise, probably due to conceit, that someone other than a Social Crediter should have so clear a picture of the forces of evil at work today. The author with a rare insight, must have collected his facts and reached his conclusions along different lines, in a different school, to the readers of this periodical. That those conclusions coincide so accurately with our own is for that reason all the more valuable.

Apart from the book's literary excellence, it is also well thought out.

Each chapter exhibits a rise in tempo that grips the reader and helps considerably in following the logical and clear sequence of facts and argument. Whoever is able to do so, should try and read this book in the original. An English translation is most desirable, particularly as the highly idiomatic German may be difficult to follow. One wonders whether any publisher in this country among established publishing firms would dare to bring it out. The author does not hesitate in naming the evildoers, particularly Kuhn, Loeb and Co., or in calling a Jew a Jew.

Except for some philosophical asides, there is nothing vague about the book. Specific instances are given to drive home facts and points. Each chapter is packed with the facts and enlightening comment on facts.

The title of the book derives from a holiday the author spent in Spain. He seems to infer that the politically cleaner air of Spain helped him to clarify his ideas. He stresses the regeneration of that country under the Franco regime, a regeneration he considers profound and important in a world otherwise controlled by Zionist High Finance. Spain's isolation and her rising culture is being carefully hidden for obvious reasons from the rest of the world.

The terrible experiences of the civil war have made the Spaniards resolved never again to allow a repetition of it. In consequence, Spain is developing a political synthesis arising from the firm conviction that the civil war was a war against nihilism and that this was fostered by Politics and Speculation on a grand scale. Both are seen as overgrown monsters hostile to human culture. Politicians prepared the ground and, when ready, Russian G.P.U. agents took over the task of plunging Spain into war. The Spanish "incident" was a practical experiment in revolution and has become the standard example to follow in all countries that Communist Russia wants to overthrow. The author draws attention to what appears to be generally overlooked, namely, that a remarkable number of Communist commanders of the "International Brigades" are now in ministerial seats of power.

Only a few of the interesting facts contained in the book can be referred to here. For instance the author explains how the U.S.A. found it necessary to engineer a war—the 1914 instalment particularly—to get rid of European guardianship. Europe had to be plunged into chaos. He mentions the Jewish advisers of Wilson and Roosevelt. He traces the connection between the G.P.U. and Wall Street, a connection which became obvious when Vishinski was let loose on the world. Vishinski is described

as the Russian Torquemada whose hands are steeped in blood. His entry in U.N.O. represented the identification of World politics with the Russian secret police heads. U.N.O. is a most convenient platform for Communist propaganda.

Vishinski's famous accusation of G-men, i.e., Byrnes and Dulles, as the arch enemies of "peace," i.e., of the U.S.S.R. is mentioned. It is — probably correctly — suggested that this was done, so as not to be forced to name the real enemies. Whom did he not want to name? The author reminds his readers that the Russian delegation was allowed to slip into the U.S.A. without the usual formalities and in all secrecy. The Russians did not speak English and their hosts are not known to speak Russian. The hosts were connected with Wall Street, and all had a common language, Hebrew.

Considerable space is given to the banking house of Kahn, Loeb and Co., its composition, its activities, and its rise to power. The Rockefeller group controlled oil and other conservative trusts and industries. The Morgan group was fleecing the public by manipulation of railroad shares and other daring enterprises. At a moment when Morgans were heavily involved in some doubtful speculation and had heavy financial commitments on the side of the Allies, Jacob Schiff, then head of Kuhn Loeb and Co., asked the President for permission to finance Germany. This threat caught Morgan and Co. off balance and forced that group, as it was intended to do, to combine with Kuhn, Loeb and Co., the latter, as a financial house, automatically gaining control of this colossal concentration of financial and industrial power, now greater than the Rockefeller group. The Morgan-Kuhn Loeb group, which by then included the copper kings, Guggenheim, Kahn and Schiff and the Warburg family and the Rothschilds, could also count on a number of immensely wealthy friends, mainly related by marriage such as, i.e., Bernard Baruch, Marshall Fields.

There are many interesting facts adduced as to the entry of the U.S.A. into the war in 1917, the activities of Barndi, how the Morgan group, controlling as they did the main supplies of copper, did all they could to prolong the war. It is specifically mentioned that apart from monetary considerations and political concessions the Allies had to pay a "special price" for the U.S.A. entry into the war, viz., the Balfour Declaration. The close connection between Puritanism, especially the American kind, and Jewish High Finance helped considerably to bring about this step towards the establishment of a Jewish centre of power in Palestine, part of the plans for world domination by Kuhn Loeb and Co. The latter aim is what the mass of Jews and the world are taught to call "the Kingdom of God." In this connection the author

THE WELFARE STATE

The Federal Government's proposal to provide "free" milk for all school children up to the age of twelve years is further evidence of the manner in which a Government elected to resist Socialism is pursuing policies, which have the effect of weakening the individual's spirit of independence. It was bad enough for the Victorian State Government to launch a scheme of "free" milk for children; but for the Federal Government to launch a similar scheme providing the finance and having the States do the administrative work, is a thousand times worse. It is a further step in the direction of centralised control of the individual.

Once it is agreed that it is the function of the government to provide "free" milk for school children, why not proceed further and request that the Government also provide "free" lunches for school children? And "free" clothing? Surely no more subtle way could be devised of conditioning young minds to accept the Socialist idea of complete State control, than policies, which suggest to children that they should look to the Government for their well being, and not to their parents.

The philosophy underlying the Welfare State policies of the present Federal Government is essentially evil and anti-Christian. It conceives of Governments taking more and more control of policies, which should be the responsibility of the individual. Genuine democracy is impossible unless there are responsible electors. Electors can only become responsible when they are permitted freedom of choice. It is the exercising of choice, which develops the individual more than anything else. But modern Governments sap the initiative of the individual when they take his money from him by compulsory taxation and then give him portion of it back in the shape of "free" milk and other "benefits." The Welfare State is a "softening up" process, which effectively paves the way for the complete totalitarian State—irrespective of whether this State is labelled Communist or Fascist.

The present Federal Government cannot fight the rising tide of totalitarianism until it renounces power; until its policies are based on the principle that it is not the function of the Government to provide the individual with security from the cradle to the grave, but to remove all artificial barriers—political, economic, and financial—which prevent the individual from providing himself with his own security.

Mass Bribery

The experiment in mass bribery in preparation for the election, which it is hoped, will finally eliminate "Britain," proceeds on a scale commensurate with the issues involved.

Any simpleton can see that the combined taxable capacity of the country, the credit-making facilities of the Bank of "England," and the millions of dollars from Wall Street camouflaged as "Marshall Aid," etc., are being poured into what the Americans call the pork barrel, that is to say, the pig bucket. "Full employment?" Why not? Where one man sufficed, use four. And if a fifth comes along, just put him on the pay roll. In any case, *drive in the fundamental idea that a much better living and lots of loot can be had through politics and Trades Unionism than by doing a little work; and the supply is inexhaustible.*

Communist Conspiracy in U.S.A.

Under large headlines, the Melbourne "Herald" of July 18 publishes a Washington report dealing with a report issued by the special Senate inquiry committee set up to investigate Senator McCarthy's charges concerning Communist infiltration in the U.S.A. State Department. Dominated by Democrats, it was not surprising that this committee issued a whitewashing report, which dismissed Republican Senator McCarthy's charges in most abusive terms.

It is significant that Republican Senator Lodge filed a minority report which says that the four-months investigation "must be set down as superficial and inconclusive." Although the committee reported that there was no truth in Senator McCarthy's allegation "that the Amerasia magazine secret documents case would provide a key to the espionage ring in the State Department," we have just received from the U.S.A. a report which states that Louis Budenz, former editor of the leading American Communist journal, has backed Senator McCarthy in his charges concerning the "Amerasia case." Budenz, now a Catholic Professor, says: "The Lattimore and Amerasia cases are both interlocked and cannot be separated. If fully investigated, the cases will provide one of the greatest scandals that American political history has ever witnessed."

Budenz also says that Senator Lattimore was always regarded by the Communists as one of their best agents. We recently quoted some of Senator Lattimore's own writings which reveal him as one who believes that the Communists are destined to win in the Far East, and that his policy is always to be on the winning side. It is interesting to note that the international newsagencies never make this type of information available to the "capitalist" press in this and other countries.

As Senator Millard Tydings is reported as having helped write the report dismissing Senator McCarthy's charges, the following item from the *Washington Newsletter* is of particular interest:

"Most Americans are not aware of the fact that Tydings is the son-in-law of Joe Davies, the Jew pal of Joe Stalin, who wrote the book 'Mission to Moscow.' Later the story was reduced to a motion picture scenario and a film was released by the same title by the Jew film corporation Warner Bros. Objective observers considered it the most brazen and dishonest piece of pro-Stalin propaganda ever to come out of Hollywood. Evidently Davies is keeping a careful watch over his son-in-law, Millard Tydings, who is rolling out the whitewash barrel every 15 minutes in his attempt to protect Lattimore, Acheson and other noted and notorious personalities connected with our State Department and our government in general."

Further Evidence

The following is a further item from the *Washington Newsletter*, which provides further frightening evidence of how deeply rooted the Communist conspiracy is in America's National Capital:

"Washington has witnessed recently the most brazen co-operation with Communist treason ever to be observed in the conduct of a so-called conventional newspaper. The *Washington Post*, the only exclusively morning newspaper in the Nation's Capital, owned by the Jew, Eugene Meyer, will be

remembered as the newspaper, which participated in the conspiracy to frame-up 33 patriots in the so-called Seditious Trial. gives true historical appreciations of the Reformation, the rise of the U.S.A., Jewish migrations and similar phenomena.

The most interesting revelation of the whole book, however, relates to the financing of Hitler by the intervention of the Warburgs. These revelations are based on a book describing three meetings with Hitler at which finance for the Nazis was negotiated. The author is stated to be Sidney Warburg, who is, on circumstantial evidence, no other than James P. Warburg, son of Paul M. Warburg, of Kuhn Loeb and Co. The psychological urge under which Warburg was labouring and which made these disclosures necessary to his own conscience are discussed at length. Practically the whole edition was immediately bought up by a Jewish lawyer for the Warburg interests. What books had been sold were searched for by Hitler's secret police. Two copies reached the Austrian Government. Dollfus's murder prevented any use being made of these copies. One copy reached Switzerland, where a pamphlet dealing with the revelations was published. Warburgs helped Hitler because of his anti-Jewish attitude. History shows that Jewish persecution has always in the long run benefited Zionism. It was Hitler's task to attack France, the only Allied country to benefit from the financial clauses of the Treaty of Versailles, to start Jewish pogroms, and to bring about chaos in Europe. On one occasion a credit for Hitler was opened in 15 million dollars, on another for 10 million dollars. After all, organised disruption is part of the plan of Kuhn Loeb and Co.

Discussing the psychological background of the Jews and of the leading Zionists in particular, the author puts forward an interesting theory, which, even if it can be disputed on one point, commands attention and is in accord with known facts. In the course of the evolution of man there must have been a period in which instinct and intelligence became recognised in the minds of men as separate and distinct, whereas up to that period they had been perceived as one entity. This represented a step forward in evolution. Similarly it was the mission of the Jews to lead human consciousness

out of the mysticism of ancient Egypt and to teach obedience to the Law. Unfortunately the Jews have become entangled in the Law and cannot appreciate the further step, the raising of the Spirit into human consciousness. This process was initiated by the Greeks, among whom Homer gave it its first expression, and perfected and fulfilled by Christ. This preoccupation with the Law makes the Jew pre-eminently a people to foster and inhabit a rigidly controlled State. It is their ideal and has been so for 4,000 years. Their development in this respect ceased during that period. Instead of helping man to reach greater heights, their efforts have been to bind him down to the stage reached in the time of Moses. They have put all their strength into prolonging the stage then reached, and in doing so have hindered man's transmutation on to a higher plane, now overdue. Culture and History have therefore passed them by. This theory accounts for the Jews' complete failure to understand Christianity and their active hostility to any attempt to develop the Spirit. It also accounts for the efforts to establish "the Kingdom of God," a World State ruled by the Jewish Law, and governed by Kuhn Loeb and Co.

A most interesting book.

Cancer and Chemical Fertilisers

By J. I. RODALE.

We are faced with figures which show that from Pearl Harbour to V-J Day, 294,476 American soldiers and sailors were killed, but that during the same period 607,193 Americans died of cancer.

The medical profession is confident that one of these days they will come up with a cure. But suppose cancer is different and does not respond to man's attempt at curing it? Isn't it time that experiments in prevention are attempted? It is the belief of many physicians that the quality of our food has a great deal to do with the incidence of cancer.

I would like to mention the work of the late Dr. Frederick L. Hoffman, who was connected with the Prudential Insurance Company of America and with the Biochemical Research Foundation of the Franklin Institute of Philadelphia. He was a medical man of high repute who travelled all over the world studying cancer to see if he could obtain a clue to its causation. He devoted his life to it. In 1915 The Prudential Press published his book of 826 pages, entitled "The Mortality from Cancer Throughout the World." In 1937 The Williams and Wilkins Company, conservative medical publishers of Baltimore, Md., published his 767-page book called

"Cancer and Diet," in which he quotes much evidence and the work of many physicians who hold that diet is an important element in cancer.

Chemicals Suspect

Very early in the book Dr. Hoffman becomes very suspicious of commercial fertilisers. I am going to quote from his work:

"The food supply for this population (alluding to urban communities) is therefore naturally becoming more and more artificial and modified by a wide range of processes, some of which unquestionably react injuriously on the human organism.

"There is another factor involved to which hardly any attention has been called and that is the nature of the food supply itself which is being altered as the result of alterations in the nature of the soil in which the food is raised. This applies particularly to the composition of the mineral constituents of the soil which to an increasing extent are being modified by the addition of artificial fertilisers which also are becoming more and more chemical and artificial in contrast to the use of natural manures in the earlier days, when the soil retained most of its original fertility and growth producing capacity.

"In other words, any one of the principal food products consumed at the present time does not by any means represent the same natural mineral composition of, say, 50 years ago . . ."

Dr. Max Gerson, of New York City, a cancer specialist, who seems to be curing

some cancer cases by a special diet, had this to say at a hearing in Washington relating to Bill No. S 1875 held on July 1, 2 and 3, 1946, to authorise the Government to sponsor cancer research, which was not passed:

"The fundamental damage starts with the use of artificial fertiliser for vegetables and fruits as well as for fodder. Thus the chemically transformed vegetarian and meat nourishment, increasing through generations, transforms the organs and functions of the human body in the wrong direction.

"Another basic defect lies in the waste of excrements of the cities. Instead of returning the natural manure to the fruit-bearing soil, it is led into the rivers, killing underwater life. The natural cycles are interrupted and mankind has to suffer dearly for the violation. Life in forest and wilderness should teach us the lesson.

"But we can regain the lost defence and healing power if we return as close as possible to the laws of nature as they are created."

Inadequate Diet

According to Dr. Alexander Brunschwig, of the University of Chicago, in the current national bulletin of the American Society for the Control of Cancer, there is experimental evidence to suggest that in animals, at least, inadequate diets may serve as adjuvant to the action of certain cancer-producing compounds.

An illustration of this point is the recent work of Kinoshita, the Japanese pathologist, working at the Memorial Hospital, New York, who has shown that when rats are fed an adequate, well-balanced diet, the ingestion of cancer-producing substance known as "butter-yellow" is innocuous. However, when the rats are maintained upon an inadequate diet, especially lacking in vitamins, the ingestion of this chemical causes inflammatory changes in the liver, followed by cancer of this organ.

When the Nazis marched into Austria, they drove out one of the world's greatest cancer authorities—Dr. Ernst Freund. Dr. Freund's researches—carried on for years—are based on the theory that "cancer is caused, not by infection or irritation, but by false digestive processes."

Dr. John R. Davidson, of Winnipeg, Manitoba, during his entire professional life,

and he is now over 75, specialised in cancer work.

Davidson was convinced that cancer was caused by changes within the body resulting from improper eating. "Cancer is a nutritional deficiency disease," he declared.

Dr. Arthur L. Wallace, a practising physician for 45 years in Nashua, New Hampshire, appeared before the State Agricultural Advisory Board at Concord, New Hampshire, on August 31, 1947, and said, "that if foodstuffs contained more nutrition, people would not be so susceptible to diseases such as cancer, heart ailments and other organic disorders.

"There appears to me to be too much seeking after disease-carrying germs these days, and then search for wonder drugs to kill them off. It would be more beneficial if we corrected the nutritional deficiencies of the earth, and made people so healthy that they would not be susceptible to these same germs." He stated, "Nutritional deficiency in the soil is the chief cause of increased diseases among people."

Sir Arbuthnot Lane, a famous English surgeon, has said: "Long surgical experience has proved to me conclusively that there is something radically and fundamentally wrong with the civilised mode of life, and I believe that unless the present dietetic and health customs of the white nations are reorganised social decay and race deterioration are inevitable."

The late Dr. Alexis Carrel, in his classic, "Man the Unknown," was aware of the dangers of using artificial fertilisers. In this book he says:—

"Mass production has modified the composition of wheat, eggs, milk, fruit, and butter, although these articles have retained their familiar appearance. Chemical fertilisers, by increasing the abundance of the crops without replacing all the exhausted elements of the soil, have indirectly contributed to change the nutritive value of cereal grains and of vegetables." Dr. James Asa Shield, at a convention at Miami, Florida, of the Southern Medical Association, attacked the use of chemical fertilisers in no uncertain terms. Let us quote from the Associated Press despatch which was sent across the wires of the country and which was printed in dozens of newspapers: "Dr. James Asa Shield, Assistant Professor of Neuropsychiatry of the Medical College of Virginia, said in an address before the Southern Medical Association convention here recently that food produced from soil fertilised with chemicals has caused an increase of degenerative diseases throughout the United States.

"Shield charged that agriculture's attempt to correct soil exhaustion with chemicals has not been successful.

Chinese Diet

Dr. Shield said one degenerative disease, multiple sclerosis, is virtually unknown in

a prominent Communist slogan in 1944. The strange body came into existence when the whole world seemed to be fazed by Communist propaganda and when, as it has since proved, some leading advocates of one of its principal organisations were agents of Soviet Russia. One of them, Mr. Hiss, Mr. Roosevelt's chief councillor at Yalta, is now to serve several years in gaol for perjury only because the Statute of Limitations barred his trial in the United States for treason as a Russian spy and agent, acting in the very heart of the Allied High Command.

Destroying Western Standards

With the help of such agents the Communists succeeded in persuading the world that Litvinov's doctrine that "peace is indivisible" provides the only formula for universal salvation and tranquility. Accepting this, the more powerful nations on the Western side weakened themselves both physically and morally by forming associations with, and making themselves party to, Governments not of their own standards of stability and integrity. Also, they presented Moscow with a clear-cut basis for its propaganda of world domination.

Among Western nations the new doctrine upon which U.N.O. has been built has served Russia in another way in undermining the confidence of people in their own national systems and in their pride in their own flag, and also in their belief in the need to provide strong defence for themselves. Nowhere has this been more evident than in the British Empire, where Socialism, so akin to international Communism in its beliefs and primary objectives, has sacrificed national safety and the ideal of patriotism to the theory that any form of defence is an invitation to aggression.

Drop The Sham

In Australia, within the last few weeks, we have had the spectacle of leaders of "Labor," who yesterday bitterly opposed the sending of Australian troops to Malaya to defend this country's interests against Communism, meekly agreeing to a Government resolution that we should fight in Korea because orders have been issued by a divided and polyglot "world body."

It is true that we must fight in Korea, as must every civilised nation, which values its future safety. But it is not true that we are fighting there merely "at the disposal of "U.N.O." We are beginning to fight for ourselves as Australian and British subjects, and because every advance of armed Communism adds to the danger, which overhangs us. It would be healthy if all shams were dropped and it were made clear to every citizen of the English-speaking world that what is actually being fought for in Korea is his home and his life. Russia has never acknowledged inter-rationalism as its guiding principle to its own people. At home its appeal is always made to the patriotism of "the sons of the Russian fatherland," admittedly bent on the control of the world. Its devotion to U.N.O. principles has been kept bottled for export to intoxicate soft-shelled academic brains like those of Dr. Evatt.

the Orient, where natural manures and plant refuse are used as fertilisers.

"He said the death rate from the disease in the United States is almost as high as the infantile paralysis death rate.

"Inorganic chemical fertilisers 'at times disturb the chemical balance of the soil and in turn affect the health of the animals that feed on the crops,' the doctor reported.

"Despite deficiencies in vitamins, proteins and fats in the Chinese diet, they have no sclerosis of their nerves, their blood vessels, blockage of their veins or hypertension, he said.

"He said several European countries that use chemical fertilisers have a high incidence of sclerosis and other degenerative diseases."

One of the greatest nutritionists of our time, Dr. E. V. McCollum, of John Hopkins University, recently said: "When it comes to getting out of the soil, and into the plant, elements which may be there already, but which the plant cannot now secure, the advocates of what is called the 'organic school of soil improvement' have a good many persuasive arguments to present for their side of the case. Organic ferment may well stir up and release trace elements and other elements which commercial fertilisers alone can never provide."

The American Journal of Digestive Diseases, in its June, 1948, issue, referring to a book by N. Philip Norman, M.D., and James Rorty, called *Tomorrow's Food*, said:

"A careful study of the English authors who recommended natural compost for fertilising purposes, particularly McCarrison and Howard, and of the experimental work of Maynard, Albrecht, Brody and others in this country, leaves one convinced of several facts. One fact is that until proper soil fertilisation is practised, we shall not be able to obtain from food (nor from artificial vitamins) the strongest-known impetus to health."

There is overwhelming evidence that there exists some relationship between the food intake of the body and its welfare and health. This stands to reason. The body is dependent basically for its functioning and subsistence on the nourishment that is furnished to it. If we do not eat, we die. If the sustenance is inferior, or lacking in necessary elements, malfunctioning must result and does—as is shown in the archives of medicine.

Such diseases as pellagra, beriberi, scurvy and others have been traced to dietary deficiencies. When the deficit is mended spectacular cures have been accomplished.

previous Government. It is claimed that the woolgrowers need a stabilising fund to help them if and when prices fall. What arrogance it is for the Government to set itself up to say that the wool growers, who received low prices from 1929 to 1939, and who pay their full share of taxes, are now receiving too much income and that the Government is fitted to help them manage their own financial affairs.

If the Government perseveres with its compulsory wool levy scheme, it is very probable that Mr. McEwen, Deputy Leader of the Federal Country Party, will be held personally responsible by irate woolgrowers. No doubt the Labor Party feels that the scheme will destroy the Government's popularity in the rural areas. Some of the Liberals, whom it is said will be contesting every Federal Electorate at the next elections, no doubt have similar ideas.

Our advice to the woolgrowers is to oppose the wool levy scheme lock, stock and barrel. It is the "thin edge of the wedge" to get centralised control of the wool industry.

The Constant Drip

Mr. Fadden's devastating official statement in Parliament that prices are rising at "the alarming rate of ten to twelve *per cent per annum*" is the first authoritative confirmation we have seen of an estimate we have made before. Taking the rise as eleven *per cent per annum*, this is equivalent to a depreciation of the purchasing power of money at the rate of ten *per cent*; or we might say that it represents a *negative* rate of interest of ten *per cent*. Money invested in Government Bonds at 3¼ percent, thus loses 6 percent *per annum*; and £100 banked in current account is worth merely £90 in twelve months time.

The only answer the Government has to this appalling situation is "more production." Without going into the technical reasons why it is so, it is quite obvious that increased production does not restore the purchasing power of money. We have already much greater production than we have ever had before—and much higher prices. In America, where production both in volume and by man-hour is at an all-time high, prices also are at an all-time high. Moreover, "production" is one of those nonsense words, which quite obscure the problem, because it covers everything from the production of munitions, which impoverish the community, to the production of children, which are an unrealisable asset. What matters is the *ratio* between the production of goods of service to individuals, and the productions of goods (including public works) of no use, or of potential use only, to individuals.

Jewish Traitors

The latest "American" to be charged as a Communist agent is Julius Rosenberg. Mr. J. Edgar Hoover, Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, described Rosenberg as "another important link in the Soviet espionage apparatus."

Recently, Mr. Harry Gold and David Greenglass have also been charged with having collaborated with Dr. Fuchs. No doubt it is merely a coincidence that the majority of Communist agents are Jews!
