Communism Is Jewish Dr. Levy's Courageous Letter

From time to time we are asked why we devote so much space to dealing with the "Jewish Problem." A complete reply to this question will be found in the following letter (July, 1920) by the well-known Jewish writer, Dr. Oscar Levy, in reply to Mr. G. Pitt-Rivers, who had forwarded to him before publication his brochure, "The World Significance of the Russian Revolution":

"Dear Mr. Pitt-Rivers: When you first handed me your M.S. on *The World* Significance of the Russian Revolution, you expressed a doubt about the propriety of its title. After a perusal of your work, I can assure you, with the best of consciences, that your misgivings were entirely without foundation. No better title than The World Significance of the Russian Revolution could have been chosen, for no event in any age will finally have more significance for our world than this one. We are still too near to see clearly this Revolution, this portentous event, which was certainly one of the most intimate and therefore least obvious, aims of the world-conflagration, hidden as it was at first by the fire and smoke of national enthusiasms and patriotic antagonisms.

"It was certainly very plucky of you to try and throw some light upon an event which necessarily must still be enveloped in mist and mystery, and I was even somewhat anxious lest your audacity in treating such a dangerous subject would end in failure, or what is nearly the same, in ephemeral success. No age is so voracious of its printed offspring as ours. There was thus some reason to fear lest you had offered to this modern Kronos only another mouthful of his accustomed nourishment for his immediate consumption.

"You rightly recognise that there is an ideology behind it (the Russian Revolution), and you clearly diagnose it as an ancient ideology. There is nothing new under the sun; it is even nothing new that this sun rises in the East . . .

"For Bolshevism is a religion and a faith.

ing upon our Age. For the question of the Jews and their influence on the world past and present, cuts to the root of all things, and should be discussed by every honest thinker, however bristling with difficulties it is, however, complex the subject as well as the individuals of this Race may be.

"For the Jews, as you are aware, are a sensitive community, and thus very suspicious of any Gentile who tries to approach them with a critical mind. They are always inclined — and that on account of their terrible experiences — to denounce anyone who is not with them as against them, as tainted with 'medieval' prejudice, as intolerant Antagonist of their Faith and of their Race.

"Nor would I deny that there is some evidence, some prima facie evidence of this antagonistic attitude in your pamphlet. You point out, and with fine indignation, the great danger that springs from the prevalence of Jews in finance and industry, and from the preponderance of Jews in rebellion and revolution. You reveal, and with great fervour, the connection between the Collectivism of the immensely rich international Finance — the democracy of cash values, as you call it — and the inter-national Collectivism of Karl Marx and Trotsky — the Democracy of any by decoy cries And all this evil and misery, the economic and political, you trace back to one source, to one fons et origo malorum— the Jews.

Jewish Influence in Europe

"Now other Jews may vilify and crucify you for these outspoken views of yours; I myself shall abstain from joining the chorus of condemnation! I shall try to understand your opinions and your feelings, and having once understood them ... I can defend you from the unjust attacks of my often too impetuous Race. But first of all, I have to say this: There is scarcely an event in modern Europe that cannot be traced back to the Jews. Take the Great War that appears to have come to an end, ask yourself what were its causes and its reasons: you will find them nationalism. You will at once answer that nationalism has nothing to do with the Jews, who as you have proved to us, are the inventors of the international idea. But no less than Bolshevist Ecstasy and Financial Tyranny can

National Bigotry (if I may call it so) be finally followed back to a Jewish source "The great question, however, is whether the Jews are conscious or unconscious ones, but please do not think that I wish to exonerate them on that account. . . . A conscious evildoer has my respect, for he knows at least what is good; an unconscious one well he needs the charity of Christ — a charity which is not mine — to be forgiven for not knowing what he is doing. But there is in my firm conviction not the slightest doubt that these revolutionary Jews do not know what they are doing;

American Pressure to Destroy Wool Auctions

In the following letter to the Melbourne "Age" of November 10, Mr. P. R. Rogers, of Mount Widderin, Skipton, Victoria, makes some excellent points concerning the American proposal to modify the present method of selling Australian wool by open auction:

of selling Australian wool by open auction: I read your leading article Wool for Joint Defence Needs (30/10) with much interest, especially the concluding paragraph, which emphasised that in Australia, as in America, importance is attached to free markets and just rewards to enterprise and skill, and that any wool plan to accommodate America's wool needs must not depart from this principle.

With regard to stock-piling by the U.S.A., for defence purposes, however, it is interesting to note the statement made by Mr. Alan Grant, president of Messrs. C. T. Wilson & Co., importers, New York, to the sub-committee appointed by Congress.

Mr. Grant said last month: "The fact that the United States was short of rubber was the Government's own fault; it could have bought all the rubber it wanted for stockpiling at 16 c. a lb. last November. Now it has to pay 55 c. simply because world demand is so great and Russia is buying huge quantities."

This statement could be applied equally well to wool.

The U.S.A. knew two years ago that it would have to stockpile wool for defence purposes. J.O. had 1,000,000 bales then, which it would have gladly sold at reasonable prices.

The U.S.A. held off buying wool last year at the Australian auction because it thought the price was too dear.

Now that the price has more than doubled, because world demand is 20 per cent, more than production, the U.S. Government is asking the Australian woolgrower to pay for its mistake.

The Australian Primary Producers' Union has very properly protested against any system to circumvent or break down auction in the open market.

The woolgrowers of Australia, owing to the imposition of a sectional tax of 20 per cent, are naturally suspicious of any further Government interference with the great wool industry, and especially with any proposal to interfere with auctions in any way in time of peace.

The U.S.A. has three-quarters of the world's gold buried at Fort Knox.

It is the wealthiest nation in the world today, and can afford to pay for the wool it requires for defence purposes in the open market, just as it bought rubber, tin, lead, zinc and other commodities in the world's open markets.

Truth from Palestine

Mrs. Mark Ethridge is the wife of the diplomat. She went to the Near East with her husband. She had believed what she had read in the paper about Palestine. Slanting the "News"

Those responsible for the "news" appearing in the daily newspapers must indeed believe that there are no limits to the gullibility of their readers. Recently the press published a fantastic story, which undoubtedly had as its major purpose a further attack upon Franco's Spain. This story alleged that Martin Bormann, the escaped Nazi leader, was conducting a vast Nazi "underground" organisation, "The Spider," from "a monastery in Southern Spain." This story recalls the press stories of 1946, that atomic bombs were being manufactured secretly in Spain. So convincingly was this story told that many who should have known better believed it.

The controllers of the press may claim that their anti-Franco lies stems from their opposition to all forms of totalitarianism. But it is easy to see that the controllers of the "capitalist" press consistently attack those who are really fighting Communists. Note the press campaign against Chiang Kai Shek.

Treachery in Belgium

An "intelligence digest," which is widely circulated, discusses in its October issue the recent crisis in Belgium, stating *inter alia* that the Belgian police are badly informed about "those undesirables who were the hard core of anti-Leopold action. *Internal security* is very badly organised.

"The Anger of the American **People''**

Speaking in the Defence Debate on September 12, Mr. Churchill said that there were two factors in the present international situation, which we in this country could not calculate. They were "the designs of the autocracy of the Kremlin and the anger of the people of the United States at the treatment they were receiving and the burdens they had to bear."

The average Britisher who gets his information from a Press and Radio fed by internationally controlled newsagencies is quite ready to agree with his political leaders that the ways of the enigmatic men of the Kremlin are unfathomable (although their design for World Conquest is outlined with brutal honesty in the major works of Lenin and Stalin) but he must feel rather bewildered, if he feels anything at all, that his "American cousins" should still be in the grip of a great wrath, for although he has been allowed a glimpse, now and again, of passing moods of gloom and despondency among the hard-pressed G.I.'s in Korea, and of their feelings of annovance at having to fight a lone battle for freedom for several weeks without outside help, the British reader had been given to understand that once "our boys" and "boys" from the other "United Nations" rallied in sufficient numbers to the white-and-blue colours of Mr. Trygve Lie, once the Communists "had been taught their lesson," all the initial bitterness of the G.I.'s, and their folks at home, would be forgotten.

Mr. Churchill's statement is the first official intimation that neither the arrival of British ground troops, nor the prospect of improvement in the military situation, has stilled this anger, which apparently is growing, and may have repercussions with which both the politicians in Washington and Westminster will have to reckon.

The expectation of official America (mirrored in the reports of Washington correspondents during the first phase of the Korean war) that "Korea" would switch the attention of the American public from the backstage activities of key officials of the State Department (Foreign Office), has not been fulfilled. The widespread malaise engendered by increasingly scandalous disclosures, and the growing number of sudden deaths which accompanied them, has, it seems, been changed into blazing indignation as the public is coming to see that the responsibility for the defeats in Korea rests with the New Deal politicians who surrounded President Roosevelt and are now commonly known as the Men of Yalta.

That large sections of the American public have learnt that particular lesson quickly, and are in a dangerously receptive mood for more instruction of the same nature, we may judge from an article entitled The Korean Crisis and American Opinion-written by Mr. Denys Smith in the September issue of The National and English Review: "The admiration for the way in which the (U.S.) administration has rushed to save the country from the raging torrent is tempered by the reflection that after all it may have been this same Administration which pushed it in. The American people do not take kindly to defeats. Fortunately, defeats have not led to defeatism, but to a

determination to reverse them and to search for scapegoats. Among the leading scapegoats are "the highly vulnerable" Mr. Johnson, Minister of Defence, and Mr. Acheson, Minister of Foreign Affairs. Mr. Denys Smith judges that Mr. Johnson, at least, is safe, and refers to President Truman's assertion that as long as he remained in the White House both Ministers would stay at their posts "if they wished.'

Since Mr. Denys Smith composed his article-presumably some time during the latter part of August — things have apparently moved quickly, for by the middle of September Mr. Johnson "expressed his wish" to be relieved of his post; his resignation was accepted and General Marshall was appointed as his successor.

The choice of the gentleman who has given his name to the European Aid Programme might indicate that the eleventh hour has struck, and that the number of political agents in whom the White House Inner Circle-known in Washington as the "Palace Guard" — can place full confidence, is restricted to a small group of men who have all, at one time or another, assisted the consolidation of the "Soviet" World Empire. The peculiar part played by General Marshall when he, as head of the U.S. Mission to Peking in 1946, recommended to the Chinese Generalissimo a Nationalist-Communist Coalition, renders him at least as "vulnerable" as many of his colleagues who during the last two years have suddenly retired from public life.

General Marshall's Mission to China is now commonly regarded as one of the chief milestones on the road leading from Yalta to Korea. Mr. Denys Smith, in the article mentioned above, writes:

"In the background is the accusation that the Korean Communist invasion is but the culminating point of a long series of errors in (U.S.) Far Eastern Policy; it is a symptom of a condition which the State Department had done nothing to cure and apparently had even failed to recognize. There was the Yalta agreement which gave Russia a favourable strategic position on the Asian mainland at the expense of China; there was the effort to force Generalissimo Chiang to accept a coalition with the Communists; there was the refusal to follow the advice of General Wedemyer and give enough military assistance and advice at both the command and supply levels to enable the Nationalist forces to defeat the Communists.

"Then, having created a situation in which Korea was endangered, the State Department shut its eyes to the danger . . . pressed forward with an economic aid programme and opposed giving the Korean army tion, and in the secretariat of the United Nations Organisation.

Should this growing realization be extended to the real dangers that beset the U.S.A. and ourselves, the world will owe a debt of gratitude to the small band of fighting editors of the patriotic periodicals, to the men of the Nationalist "underground," who, against the heaviest possible odds, and constantly threatened by the agents of the Anti-Defamation League of the B'nai B'rith, have carried forward what may be described as the Dearborn Independent tradition in American journalism.

Addressing various levels of American readers (often in a language which must appear both crude and superficial to the European reader, who is apt to forget that a fastidious and subtle approach would be lost on the average politically immature American) such people as Gerald L. K Smith in his Cross and the Flag, Mrs. Van Hyning in Women's Voice, Mr. McCinley in his Common Sense have with vigour and persistence told the story of the Plot against Humanity which has now entered upon its final phase, a story related with greater detachment, and deeper perception and erudition by Major Robert H. Williams in his Intelligence Digest, by Mr. Hart in his Economic Council Letter, and by Miss Lonigan and her capable colleagues in Human Events.

To all of these it must have seemed like an emergence into daylight when on May 27 Col. McCormack's paper, the Chicago Daily Tribune, carried an article by Mr. Walter Trohan, who, in simple languagebut without using the epithet "Jew"-told the identical story of America being governed by a Secret Administration headed by Zionists like Lehman, Morgenthau and Frankfurter which they for years had been attempting to "get over" to the American public. Mr. Trohan's article which has been widely re-printed throughout the States revealed the connection between Wall Street High Finance and the Roosevelt circle of "advisers" on the one hand, an between the New-Dealers of the Communist International on the other. Attention was drawn to the fact that Mr. Alger Hiss, of Yalta, San Francisco, and U.N.O who was convicted of perjury early this year with the implication that he was part of the pre-war Communist apparatus in Washington, was the guest during the critical times of his trial, of Senator Leh-man's niece, Mrs. Buttenwieser, whose husband recently gave up his directorship in Kuhn, Loeb and Co. to become U.S. Deputy High Commissioner in Germany. *

The harm done to their cause by the publication of the article must have appeared great to the leaders of American Jewry who at once set in motion the machinery of their Anti-Defamation League. Yielding to the pressure of this nation-wide, vicious "smearbund," Col. McCormack was force to proffer his apologies for the

weapons needed to repel attack.

That this "background accusation" should receive such attention in a journal devoted to the interests of official British Conservatism is perhaps the best indication of the Korean incident, so far from allaying the suspicions of the American public has in fact quickened them and that the anger to which Mr. Churchill refers, may hasten the growing realization that the real enemies of the U.S.A., and the world, have their most effective agents in the White House, the Departments of the U.S. administraappearance of the "anti-semitic" article.

* The U.S. High Commissioner, whom Mr. Buttenwieser "advises" is Mr. John McCloy, former Direct of the World Bank. Mr. McCloy is the brother-in-law of Ambassador Douglas, both having married daughters of Mr. Zinssner. Mr. Douglas is advised the U.S. Embassy by Mr. Warburg, of the Kuhn Loeb and Co. family. Mr. Adenauer, the Chancellor of the West German Republic is married to a cousin of the Zinssner sisters. The Allied High Commissioner has recently lifted its ban on export of West German heavy industries to Soviet Germany "in the interest of inter-zonal trade."

Mr. Menzies Opposes Price Subsidies.

Speaking in the Federal Parliament on November 14, the Prime Minister, Mr. Menzies, attacked the suggestion that price subsidies were a solution to the inflation problem. Economics have never been Mr. Menzies' strong point, the result being that he merely utters like a parrot the dishonest arguments of the economic "experts." These "experts" have been so discredited by events over the past twenty years, that it is indeed remarkable that any sane individual should place any reliance whatever upon their opinions.

In his comments upon price subsidies, Mr. Menzies said: "The postwar expectation of an early end of inflation and decline in export prices has not been realised." Who expected an end of inflation after the war? Apparently Mr. Menzies did, thus revealing his utter ignorance of the fact that, so long as present financial rules are pursued, progressive inflation is inevitable. We have repeatedly drawn attention to the fact that present methods of credit expansion, necessary to prevent the economic system from collapsing into another depression, are inherently inflationary.

Mr. Menzies confirms our contention concerning present financial rules being inflationary when he says: "It seems likely that inflationary conditions in major overseas countries, whatever their form of Government, will be more pronounced in future." Now one of the major overseas countries is the U.S.A., where there is adequate and efficient production, one of the ingredients persistently claimed by Mr. Menzies to be necessary for a successful solution of the inflation menace. Why, then, do other countries also experience inflation? And, if this inflation is to become more "pronounced" in the future, does this mean that it is inevitable that the total result of modern power production is not a lower cost of living, but exactly the opposite? If Mr. Menzies now subscribes to this inevitability theory, and it appears that he does, were his pre-election promises "to put shillings back into the pound" blatant political dishonesty?

Mr. Fadden's Pre-Election Promises

Now let us examine some of the criticisms that were levelled at the Chifley Government on the ground that the £1 lacked purchasing power during its regime. One of those criticisms was that taxation was too high. The Treasurer (Mr. Fadden), who was a pleasant chap in those days, but who has no reason to smile now because he has read his policy speech over again and knows that what he promised is just not going to happen, had this to say in his policy speech at the general election—

The Country and Liberal parties will institute a balanced plan of taxation, loans and wise utilization of bank resources. This will increase production, protect the people's savings against inflation, maintain the real value of wages, and give Australians a pound's worth of purchases for every pound spent. If the Socialists are defeated, therefore, rates of taxation, both direct and indirect, can and will be steadily reduced. In short, our policy is a progressive reduction of taxation on individuals and the community in general, commensurate with national economic and financial policy.

Having made that statement he let his head go and now he has announced that in a budget which provides for an expenditure of £738,000,000 he intends to give back £1,500,000 to the people in direct reductions of tax, and will collect £10,000,000 extra on sales tax, which he will obtain by raising up to 33-1/3 percent the rate of that tax on items used by women and on other commodities.

"Jobs for the Boys"

It must, of course, now be evident even to the non-technical, that the feature of genuine private enterprise, which is so disliked both by International Finance and Socialism (they are really only different aspects of the same motive) is its stark efficiency considered in relation to its various objectives. This definition should be grasped, because the ostensible objective of nationalised or cartelised activity is rarely its real purpose. For instance, cheap, comfortable, safe and rapid transport is quite a minor factor in British Railways. "Full Employment," the political power of the railway Trades Unions, "Jobs for the Boys" with luxurious junketing to inspect overseas systems which are pronounced solemnly to be interesting but not superior to "our" own, all come before transport.

There is nothing new in all this; the transition from a transport tool to a financial counter, and then to a political organisation has been repeated in dozens of countries, and always (bearing in mind the progress of the industrial arts, which is completely independent of administrative systems) with a steady fall in the achievement of satisfaction to the original objective of the undertaking, the consumer.

Whatever the truth of the matter, Mr. Menzies' repudiation of the only known method of expanding credit without inflation, the stabilisation or reduction of prices by consumer subsidies, is a clear warning of the further economic devastation threatening the individual. If Mr. Menzies cannot, or will not, take steps to protect the individual against this devastation, he should immediately be replaced by someone who is not afraid to challenge the "experts" and the interests they serve.

(Continued from page 1) that they are more unconscious sinners than voluntary evildoers.

"I am glad this is not an original observation of mine, but that you yourself have a strong foreboding about the Jews being the victims of their own theories and principles. On page 39 of your pamphlet you write: 'It may be that the Jews have always been instrumental in bringing about the events that they most heartily disapprove of; that maybe is the curse of the Wandering Jew. If I had not the honour, as well as the pleasure of knowing you personally, if I were not strongly aware of your passionate desire for light and your intense loathing of unfairness, this sentence, and this sentence alone, which tells the truth, will absolve you in my eyes from the odious charge of being a vulgar anti-Semite.

"No, you are not vulgar, you are a very enlightened critic of our Race. For there is an anti-Semitism, I hope and trust, which does the Jews more justice than any blind philo-Semitism, than does that merely sentimental 'Let-them-all-come Liberalism,' which in itself is nothing but the Semitic Ideology over again. And thus you can be just to the Jews without being 'romantic' about them.

"You have noticed with alarm that the Jewish elements provide the driving forces for both Communism and capitalism for the material as well as the spiritual ruin of this world.

"But then you have at the same time the profound suspicion that the reason for all this extraordinary behaviour may be the intense Idealism of the Jew. In this you are perfectly right From Moses to Marx, from Isaiah to Eisner, in practice and in theory, in idealism and in materialism, in philosophy and in politics, they are today what they have always been; passionately devoted to their aims and to their purposes, and ready, nay, eager, to shed their last drop of blood for the realisation of their visions.

" 'But these visions are all wrong,' you will reply . . . 'Look where you have led the world to. Think, that they have now had a fair trial of 3,000 years' standing. How much longer are you going to recommend them to us and to inflict them upon us? And how do you propose to get us out of the morass into which you have launched us, if you do change the path upon which you have led the world so disastrously astray?'

"Anti-Semitism" Justified

"To this question I have only one answer to give, and it is this: 'You are right.' This reproach of yours, which — 1 feel it for certain — is at the bottom of your anti-Semitism, is only too well justified, and upon this common ground I am quite willing to shake hands with you and defend you against any accusation of promoting Race Hatred: If you are an anti-Semite, I, the Semite, am an anti-Semite, too, and a much more fervent one than even you are . . . We (Jews) have erred, my friend, we have most grievously erred. And if there was truth in our error 3,000, 2,000, nay, 100 years ago, there is now nothing but falseness and madness, a madness that will produce an even greater misery and an even wider anarchy, I confess it to you, openly and sincerely, and with a sorrow, whose depth and pain an ancient Psalmist, and only he, could moan into this burning universe of ours . . . We who have posed as the saviours of the world, we who have even boasted of having given it 'the' Saviour, we are today nothing else but the world's seducers, its destroyers, its incen-diaries, its executioners . . . We who have promised to lead you to a new Heaven, we have finally succeeded in landing you in a new Hell . . . There has been no progress, least of all moral progress . . . And it is just our morality, which has prohibited all real progress, and—what is worse—which even stands in the way of every future and natural reconstruction in this ruined world of ours . . . I look at this world, and I shudder at its ghastliness; I shudder all the more as I know the spiritual author of all this ghastliness . . .

"But its authors themselves, unconscious in this as in all they are doing, know nothing yet of this startling revelation. While Europe is aflame, while its victims scream, while its dogs howl in the conflagration, and while its very smoke descends in darker and even darker shades upon our Continent, the Jews, or at least that part of them and by no means the most unworthy ones, endeavour to escape from the burning building, and wish to retire from Europe into Asia, from the sombre scene of our disaster into the sunny corner of their Palestine. Their eyes are closed to the miseries, their ears are deaf to the moanings, their heart is hardened to the anarchy of Europe; they only feel their own sorrows, they only bewail their own fate, they only sigh under their own burdens.

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Gardening Without Digging

When I wrote the booklet "Gardening Without Digging" I little thought it would create, in a matter of months, such widespread enthusiasm. Queries and congratulations are pouring in from every corner of the land and my garden has been visited by enthusiastic gardeners all eager to view the system at first-hand. Leading gardening experts are surprised at the results obtained, for without digging and without the use of artificial fertilizers, insecticides or poison sprays I have been awarded a certificate of special merit by the Ministry of Agriculture, dozens of prizes at horti-cultural shows and the highest marks for the best cultivated garden in the district.

It was close study of health when I was in my forties, which led me to the "no digging" system. At that time my health broke down and my studies revealed the simple truth that health is primarily de-pendent on the food we eat. Most ailments are caused by acidity and the body can soon be rid of this condition if more natural foods, such as fruit and vegetables, are taken in correct proportions so as to neutralize the acidity. A suitable diet soon restored my health and I am now, at 68, as fit as I have ever been in my life.

Not for a number of years did I realize that a similar treatment must be called upon to rid the garden of disease, but eventually I decided to go right over to nature, even to the extent of not digging.

The results far exceeded my hopes, for in place of the indifferent crops I had produced with the aid of costly artificial fertilizers, I was rewarded by strong, healthy plants and labour-saving of at least 40 per cent.

My system is, briefly, to cover the hard, undug soil in autumn with compost at the rate of a good pailful to the square yard. This is less than is required for the more normal method of gardening and it will give a fertility that will grow any kind of crop. Seeds are sown in the spring on the surface and covered with compost. In Gardening Without Digging I have compiled a complete sowing guide for all types of seed with details of when and how to sow, amount

disappear from the garden entirely. Artificial fertilizers, on the other hand, dis-courage earthworms, and a condition of acidity is built up which results in poor crops, pests and disease.

A most interesting demonstration was carried out at the Royal Agricultural Show at York in July last. Here I took two plots of equal size, two feet apart, and removed $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches of turf from each plot. One was dug and composted in the normal way and the other was left undug with an equal amount of compost applied on the surface. Both plots were sown with the same seed at the same time.

Comparison of the crops was really re-markable. The *Daily Mail* wrote that the undug crops were 50 percent better and more forward than the others, while the News-Chronicle stated that pests had left the plants alone on the undug section, whereas beans and cabbages on the other strip were severely affected by fly and caterpillar.

Since I started gardening without digging I have never had a crop fail and all my produce has been of exceptionally high quality. I have had carrots $1\frac{1}{2}$ lb. in weight, long beet 4 lb., onions $\frac{3}{4}$ lb., tomatoes, grown in the open, $\frac{1}{2}$ lb., broad beans $13\frac{1}{2}$ in., and runner beans 14 in. long.

These received no attention or feeding after sowing apart from thinning out and staking the tomatoes. But it should not be thought that I am influenced by size and weight only. Indeed, I put quality first, and the food I have grown by the no-digging methods has been of a better flavour than any other.

Many newcomers to the system have written for further information, and here are a few typical questions and answers:

Q. ----I have been using compost, 90 per cent organic, with the addition of potash, nitrogen and phosphates. What would you advise?

A. —Ripe compost needs no additions to produce crops of the highest quality.

Q. —I have no compost and you advise in your booklet to apply compost around fruit trees and then cover with sawdust. Could I use sawdust alone?

post and then with sawdust. Always apply the sawdust last.

Q. —What amount of sawdust can I use in my compost heap?

A. —Use 10 percent or, if horse manure is included, this can be increased to 20 per cent. Always damp the sawdust right through before putting it into the heap.

Q. —How would you deal with weeds such as dandelions, docks, etc.?

A. —Last season I took over a field, which was one mass of weeds, including thistles and docks. I put down a line for a row of peas, dug up all the deep-rooted weeds and pulled up the others, and buried them on top of the weeds in the row. The peas were then set in the weeds and covered with compost, which was made firm. Practically every weed was choked by the compost and the result was an excellent row of peas. When pulling taprooted weeds care should, of course, be taken not to break the roots, as this would tend to make them grow more prolific.

Q. —My soil is very light. How would your system apply to this?

A. —Under no circumstances should light soil be dug. Apply compost to the surface in autumn, roll with a light garden roller, let it stand the winter and sow seeds in the compost in the spring. It will be found that this treatment will give body to the soil.

Q. —Could your system be extended to arable farming?

A. —I have one-third of an acre of wheat sown on my system. On one part I used seed bought from a local farmer, and then I have a strip sown with compost-grown seed and treated with compost. The seed was sown broadcast and harrowed in, without ploughing. Although both plots look well, the more vigorous growth of the second plot is very apparent. Last season a neighbouring farmer took my advice and sowed a field of wheat without ploughing He had a fine crop.

Q. —What would you do about such weeds as ground-elder, bramble, bracken, and bindweed?

A. —The ground will have to be cleared of these. Covering them with compost would increase their vigour.

of compost to apply and subsequent treatment.

Success of the method is due to worms being attracted by the compost. These do the "digging" far better than the spade and provide, by their casts, all the chemicals, which the plants need for true growth. Further, the casts are alkaline, so it is only natural that wireworms, slugs and other pests, which like acid conditions, soon

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A. —Yes. Put a 3-inch layer in autumn around all fruit trees except raspberries, where only $\frac{1}{2}$ in. should be applied, as these do not respond so readily to sawdust treatment.

Q. —Can your system be applied to flowers?

A. —I know of no flowers, which do not respond, in the open, to mulching with com-

To summarize, here are my four main rules:

1. Do not disturb the soil. Nature prefers co-operation and she will show her appreciation by better returns.

2. Do not use chemicals or artificial fertilizers.

3. Use ripe compost. An activator, provided it is herbal, may be used in the making of the heap to accelerate decomposition and obviate turning.

4. Buy only compost-grown seed or better still, save your own.

Strip Grazing in New Zealand

During a recent lecture tour of Victoria, Mr. H. J. Geddes, M.Agr.Sc, lecturer in animal husbandry at Sydney University, gave some interesting information on the rapid growth of strip grazing in New Zealand over recent years. The electric fence is widely used for this purpose.

Each paddock was strip grazed by progressively uncovering them in narrow strips or "breaks" to the early-calved cows. This system of rationing gave more effective control over the use of the feed than the oldfashioned method of putting the cows on for, say, half an hour or an hour each day.

It had the added advantage that the cows obtained clean feed each day. The area or size of break allowed them each day could be readily decided by trial and error — that was by cutting off a narrow strip, putting the cows on, and observing the extent to which they succeeded in cleaning it up in the day.

One should adjust the size of "break" so that they were just leaving some feed on at the end of the day. It had been shown by careful measurement of the feed produced by the best dairy pastures that they had a potential capacity of 600 to 700 lb. butter fat to the acre—no one had yet reached this figure because cows trampled down, soiled and thereafter refused to eat a considerable proportion of the feed in the normal grazing pastures.

the normal grazing pastures. This method of strip grazing had been widely adopted within the space of a few years in New Zealand, and the more progressive farmers had even gone so far as to use it in the grazing of their pastures right throughout the year.

Windbreaks May Be 10 Percent of Farm Area

A well-designed system of windbreaks may occupy up to 10 percent of the farm area, but it will more than pay for the space it occupies.

This is the emphatic opinion of senior forester B. Farrell, of the New South Wales Forestry Commission, in discussing windbreaks on the Murrumbidgee Irrigation Area.

In drought years on the dry area, a windbreak could mean the difference between a fair crop and a complete failure. depth a few inches greater than the roots.

If the hole was deeper and extended to the subsoil, the original which was replaced should be in the proportion of two parts of topsoil to one of subsoil. Drainage was essential, he said.

If water poured into the hole remained there for 24 hours, artificial drainage was necessary.

If the species was well suited to the locality, however, the job of planting was a simple one. All that was required was the loosening with a spade or mattock of the soil to the required depth.

In dry areas, and particularly in heavy soils, advance cultivation and fallowing of the soil, in order to conserve moisture, would increase the likelihood of full survival of the planting, Mr. Farrell added.

Fourteen varieties of trees are being tried out by the Murrumbidgee Irrigation Area Extension Service in woodlot experiments on Mr. Bill Elder's farm at Lakeley's holding at Yenda.

Good Husbandry Essential

Omitting the last three exceptional seasons, wheat yields in New South Wales have shown no average increase in spite of tens of thousands of tons of artificial manures and thousands of acres of new wheat land brought under the plough. Although many new high-yielding varieties were bred and introduced by plant-breeders, the average yield stayed under 14 bushels per acre.

The same applies to dairy-production; in fact, on the upper North Coast of N.S.W., production per cow tends to decline.

Average wool production per sheep also has shown no rise, although studmasters have greatly increased the clip from individual stud animals.

But to this gloomy picture there is a bright side, and that is that some properties —wool, wheat or dairy—are showing great production increases. The answer is that the dominant factor in agricultural production remains what it always has been, good husbandry; no amount of science will ever take the place of good farming practices. Scientists have never claimed that it would, but far too many farmers believe it will, forgetting that the ideal is a mixture of science and good farming.

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Board Control Upheld

Under the heading, "Law Court Reports," the "Sydney Morning Herald" of October 31, 1950, reports the interesting case of Mr. Robert Woods, potato grower, who ap-pealed against a Potato Board prosecution for having sold potatoes privately. Mr. Justice Owen, Full Court, in "That delivering judgment, said, potatoes vest in the Board, possibly as soon as they are dug, and certainly as soon as bagged. Woods lost his case. This decision means that Boards, or any other similar type of organisation sanctioned by State Governments, can compulsorily deprive the individual of his production and dictate how, when, where, and at what price it can be sold. British citizens fought for centuries to defeat this type of totalitarianism. Clearly the battle must be taken up again.

Points in favour of windbreaks, particularly in dry areas, included the reduction of evaporation and transpiration by up to 30 percent, shelter for stock and protection against wind and water erosion.

Windbreaks helped to reduce fuel consumption, improve the appearance and value of a farm and make living and working conditions more pleasant in summer and winter, Mr. Farrell continued.

Small trees, although needing more protection for the first two or three years, were easier to handle.

If the species selected was suited to the locality and soil, and if thrifty small plants were used, little site preparation was needed. A hole must be dug, however, to a

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The Anger of the American People

One of the interesting results of this Jewish "victory" was the admission by an exuberant Jew, Mr. Phineas J. Biron, in the *B'nai B'rith Messenger* for June 15, that "as a matter of fact we were told by a reliable source that the Chicago Anti-Defamation League office did have an arrangement with the Tribune, which permitted it to 'censor' the Tribune's anti-semitic mail before publication."

This statement, which is certain to be quoted and requoted in the "anti-semitic," patriotic press long after Mr. Trohan's article and Col. McCormack's apology for it, will have been forgotten, lends additional interest to Intelligence-officer Major Williams' brilliant exposures† of the activities of the Anti-Defamation League, an organisation which at the moment acts as a Jewish Private Gestapo and could easily be transposed on to the Secret Political Police of a "Soviet" America.

The Korean War "broke out" when the repercussions of the Chicago disclosures were beginning to be felt in wider circles and the public uneasiness at the neverending exposures of Communist-Jewish traitors in governmental key positions continued to grow. 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wards. A New York Zionist, Mr. Mark Leva occupies the key position of Assistant Secretary of State to Mr. Acheson. A New York Jewess, Mrs. Anna Rosenberg, is special consultant on man-power problems to the National Security Resources Board while an Act conferring sweeping powers of conscription on the President translates into the realm of Law the Prepare-for-War Plan urged by Mr. Bernard Baruch ever since the end of the last war. It is an open secret that every position in U.N.O. of any consequence is held by a co-racialist of Mr. Bernard Baruch.

At the same time, the disclosures concerning Atomic "leaks" from governmental bureaux continue to come to light while the fact that every fresh person convicted is the bearer of a Jewish name lends itself to further elaboration of the by now almost threadbare theme that Communism is a Jewish conspiracy guided and controlled by the leaders of World Judaism. In Congress, Mr. John E. Rankin goes so far as to maintain that none of the persons convicted as transmitters of Atomic secrets are White Christians and is duly taken to task for his "anti-Semitism" by the World Zionist Press, which includes the London Jewish Chronicle. It is to this latter journal that we turn for the latest, and perhaps most significant comment on that new and incalculable factor of the political international situationthe "anger of the American people." (Issue of September 8, 1950).

"The many Jewish names mentioned recently in connection with the arrest of Communist spies and propagandists in the U.S.A. has apparently caused much anxiety among American Jews. Last week one of the liveliest Jewish newspapers of the Middle West The Intermountain Jewish News, of Denver, published an interview by its editor, Mr. Robert Gamzey with Mr. Louis Levand, publisher of the Wichita Beacon, of Kansas Mr. Levand, who is described as the dean of Western publishers and a good friend of the Jews, is reported to have said that American Jews have been 'irreparably damaged' by the handful of 'so-called Jews' whose arrests in Atom Spy cases were universally publicised.

. . Mr. Levand emphasised that the combination of the Korean War, the American reversals, and battle casualties, and the recurrence of Jewish sounding names in spy cases, have already resulted in a setback to Jewish public relations as far as Kansas and the Middle West is concerned."

And the setback is, apparently not confined to the Middle West, for the New York report is deemed sufficiently important by the editor of the Jewish Chronicle to call for editorial comment. The leader-article called "American Jewry" contains the following passage:

"It is deplorable . . . that this anti-Semitic campaign can be conducted so venomously in the United States. The great Republic of the West is everywhere regarded as the most powerful protagonist in the struggle to maintain freedom and democracy in the world, while American Jewry is incomparably the largest and most influential Jewry of the Diaspora. There would thus appear to be something almost paradoxical in the persistence of anti-Semitism in such an environment."

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It will be instructive to see how the leaders of American (and World) Jewry propose to solve the problem presented by this paradox and it will be even more interesting to learn how the American public, now thoroughly alerted to the danger presented by the enemies in their midst, will re-act to further attempts to solve it. -B.J., The Social Crediter. October 28.
