## Communist Strategy Unchanged By Moscow Purges

### New Tactics to Deal with Current Situation

Anyone who has made himself reasonably familiar with basic Communist theory has no trouble in understanding that the recent purges in Russia simply mean that there is to be a change in tactics by the Communist leaders, but that the strategy remains fixed. Mr. Khrushchev and his associates claim that they are adhering to the principles of Leninism. But they obviously believe that the tactics of the Stalin era are not suitable for the current situation. Khrushchev and his associates are following the example of Stalin who, in the twenties, purged the Trotsky group because he felt that their tactics were not suitable for the current situation.

Press comment has failed completely to deal with the realities of the change in Communist tactics. A typical press headline stated that "Stalin's Men Lose Battle for Power". No mention is made of the fact that Khrushchev and his associates were Stalin's men just as much as Molotov and his associates. Misleading comment in the world's press serves the cause of the Communist conspirators by creating the impression that it is possible to conduct reasonable negotiations with Mr. Khrushchev; that the Communist and non-Communist world can perhaps live peacefully side by side. Superficial commentators suggest that the nature of Communism is changing, and quote the recent dangerous comment by the disastrous Mr. Dulles, who has suggested that Communism is "evolving" towards more "liberal" policies.

As Mr. Khrushchev has said time and time again that his tactics are designed to further principles of Leninism, it is astonishing how few public commentators have bothered to study these principles. If they have studied them, they studiously refrain from telling the public anything about them. They consistently present Soviet Russia as a military threat while suppressing the fact that Communism in

an international conspiracy, seeking world domination primarily through the techniques of subversion and ideological warfare, and that Soviet Russia is a base from which highly-trained personnel are working to assist revolutionary activities in every other country.

One of the principles of Leninism is that "Revolution is impossible without a nationwide crisis (affecting both the exploited and the exploiters)". Mr. Khrushchev and Co. must therefore go on preparing for general revolution, although their current tactics concerning "peaceful co-existence" and support for parliamentary elections in non-Communist countries, may obscure this fact. The Communist theory maintains that developing crises are inherent in the capitalist system. Any attempt to deal with the "contradictions" in the capitalist system merely leads further along the road to Socialism. Khrushchev no doubt had this in mind when he said that the Communists were confident they could reach their objectives through the parliamentary system.

Now while events do appear to confirm the Communist theory, they only do so while present financial and economic poli-

cies are accepted as axiomatic. It is these policies, which produce the crises, not the capital system of production. So long as these policies are accepted as axiomatic, so long will disastrous political policies appear to be "inevitable". Mr. Khrushchev and his advisers understand this, even if Western politicians don't. The new Communists tactics should spur all those who understand the reality of the situation to intensify their efforts to advance an understanding of the truth, which alone can make us free.

### OUR POLICY

1. The support of all policies rooted in the Christian philosophy of freedom and based upon the Moral Law.
2. The preservation of Australia's sovereignty as a part of the British Empire, and the exposure of all internal and external groups, which attack that sovereignty.
3. The preservation and extension of genuine local government.
4. The preservation and strengthening of all Constitutional safeguards for the purpose of protecting fundamental individual rights.
5. The encouragement of all activities designed to bring Governments under more effective control by the electors.
6. The preservation and extension of genuine free, competitive enterprise and private ownership, and opposition to all Monopoly, whether it be "private" or State.
7. The support of a financial policy, which will (a) permit free enterprise to make available to all individuals an increasing standard of living and greater leisure for cultural pursuits, (b) result in no further increase to the community's indebtedness and the sound business practice of gradually reducing existing debt. Recognising that the basis of any sound economy is agriculture, the encouragement of agricultural policies which will ensure the preservation and building up of soil fertility by organic farming and gardening; and the prevention of soil erosion and the protection of forests and watersheds.

## Tree Trade' Plan is Blow at Australia and New Zealand

In "CANDOUR" of June 28, A. K. Chesterton quotes a statement by the President of the British Board of Trade, Sir David Eccles, which illustrates the accuracy of the report of our British correspondent, Mary H. Cray, in the last "NEW TIMES", on the dangers of the move for a "United Europe".

The statement quoted in "CANDOUR" was carried in the early editions of two national newspapers in England but quickly dropped when it was realised that it "gave the game away". The statement was as follows:

"At this particular moment Commonwealth countries are producing more and more food and they are asking Britain to take more. We have had long negotiations with Australia and New Zealand in the last few weeks.

"But we have had to resist because we feel that we must leave the present situation unchanged until we come into the free trade area."

## Baruch - A Learned Elder of Zion

Statesmen, service chiefs, diplomats and businessmen from all parts of the world have testified at one time or another during the past thirty years to the fact that Mr. Bernard Baruch is one of the most powerful men in the world. Sir Winston Churchill, the late President Roosevelt, Sir Anthony Eden, Mr. Molotov, and a host of other powerful men have acknowledged Mr. Baruch's supremacy and have, as President Eisenhower once put it, "sat at his feet".

Readers of the "NEW TIMES" will be interested (but not at all surprised) to learn that the Learned Elder has added a

new name to his list of callers—Colonel David Stirling of the idealistic but dangerous Capricorn Africa Society. This society which includes a number of idealistic white people, is destined to play a big part in breaking down the races of Africa into a cultureless work-force . . . easy prey for the usurers.

Colonel Stirling says: "Baruch is a man of wisdom. It is crazy not to take advantage of him..."

Whether Colonel Stirling will "take advantage" of Mr. Baruch or whether the wily old fox who has reigned supreme on the tricky U.S. stock exchange for close on fifty years, will take advantage of Colonel Stirling, we leave to our readers.

Mr. Baruch's place among the Elders we quote here a statement he made in May 1954, at the City College New York, on the subject of inflation:

"We will have to pay some price of adjustment for the inflationary neglects of the past. How heavy that price may be will depend mainly on two things—on our success in subordinating to the higher national interest this battle for selfish advantage now raging among the various segments of our economy and upon our skill in adjusting to the changed conditions of supply and demand all over the world."

Mr. Baruch's elevation of "the higher national interest" to such an important role is very similar to the wording of the "Protocols" (Chapt. X, paragraphs 13 and 15) where the President of a country is advised to appeal over the heads of representatives "to the people"; it is explained that the President should nullify any passion for politics that develops among representatives by "a stirring appeal and a reference to the majority of the whole people". This, of course, is exactly what is happening in the United States now to counter demands for tax reductions and cuts in government spending.

## U.S. Blocks Spanish Aid for Hungarians

The well-informed conservative broadcaster, Fulton Lewis, has told his American audience that the U.S. Government blocked an attempt by Spain to assist the Hungarian people in their heroic revolt against Communism last year. Fulton Lewis says that at the height of the fighting the Hungarian underground, despairing of U.S. aid, appealed to Franco for weapons. Spain immediately prepared to fly badly needed anti-tank guns to Hungary; and the West German Government even agreed to allow the Spanish planes to land and refuel secretly on German soil. However, says Fulton Lewis, the U.S. State Department heard of the plan and immediately put heavy pressure on both Western Germany and on Spain to prevent the arms shipment?

## Bank of England Approves

The British Chancellor of the Exchequer announced in the House of Commons on April 9th that a Committee would be set up "to inquire into the working of the monetary and credit system and to make recommendations".

Before making this announcement the Chancellor apparently called upon his masters to seek their advice, as this additional extract from his speech makes clear:

"I have now decided, after consultation with the Bank of England and with its full agreement, that the stage has been reached when an inquiry should prove useful and constructive..."

## Secret Meeting of Bankers and Planners

In a recent issue of the "NEW TIMES" we drew attention to the secret meeting of bankers, economic experts and planners held in February this year at St. Simon Island, off the coast of Georgia. We are now in possession of the names of the sixty-odd gentlemen from the U.S., England and Europe who attended the conference. While the exact purpose of the meeting is not yet clear, the general trend of discussion was obviously of a One-World nature and carefully controlled by the International usurers. Robert H. ## *Inflation For Ever!*

*Writing in the Melbourne "Sun" of June 18, Mr. Douglas Wilkie, who can usually be relied upon to relay the latest "line" of the real framers of the world's policies, confirms the warnings we have been making on inflation ever since the Second World War finished in 1945. We have consistently maintained that another major depression was extremely unlikely; that a more insidious threat to the individual was the policy of "controlled inflation". Even many monetary reformers have failed to grasp the real significance of the change of tactics by the policy makers, with the result that they continue to talk about a situation, which, in the main, no longer exists.*

*In his article Mr. Wilkie informs us about "a new school of American economists, led by Professor Sumner Slichter, of Harvard", whose theory concerning inflation "will soon find its way into every corner of the capitalist West, from Canberra to Kalamazoo". And what does Professor Slichter teach? "Their argument, in brief, is that in modern conditions creeping inflation is inevitable. Given full employment and an expanding output, plus the benefits of modern economic organisation, inflation can, and must, be lived with indefinitely. The same Keynesian controls that can be used to prevent mass unemployment can also prevent inflation accelerating to a gallop; but these very controls help to make a creep inevitable."*

*There is, of course, nothing new about Professor Slichter's theory as presented by Mr. Wilkie. Professor Sir Douglas Copland has been openly telling Australians in recent years that a "degree" of inflation is the "price" they should be prepared to pay for "national development". But it does appear that Western politicians from now on are expected to accept inflation as another economic axiom. Their role will be to compete with one another in trying to persuade the electors that their party can control inflation better than the other parties. It is probably true that Mr. Menzies and his colleagues sincerely believed that they could implement their famous 1949 promise to "put the shillings back in the pound", but it is now clear that most of them have been successfully conditioned to accept inflation as "inevitable". President Eisenhower is reported to be resigning himself to the same view. The serious inflation in the U.S.A. completely answers the fallacious argument that increased production reduces prices.*

*As pointed out by C. H. Douglas over 30 years ago, inflation is inevitable while a policy of "full employment" is imposed within the rules of "sound finance". So long as there is a stubborn refusal by responsible men to consider a change in the purposes for which the present economic and financial systems are being used, inflation and other evils must continue to undermine Western societies and enable the real Communist conspiracy to develop unchecked. The claim that inflation is "inevitable" is, of course, a claim that the progressive robbery of the individual is inevitable. The Christian Church should be asked to concern itself about the morality of a teaching, which openly states that a medium of change must progressively lose its "value in spite of progressive efficiency in production methods".*

## BACK TO REALITY

By **Gustave Thibon**

This book, by one of the most original and provocative thinkers in France today, has been described by Mr. John Mitchell, founder of the Christian Campaign for Freedom, as representing "a rebirth of Christian thought in France, the importance of which it would be difficult to exaggerate."

Thibon's appeal is for realism in social and political thinking. In particular, his chapter "Christianity and The Democratic Mystique", provides some excellent examples of realistic thinking. He shows just how ridiculous it is to believe that freedom can be won by the mere recruiting of political power. In his Foreword Thibon writes, "I am relentlessly opposed to the law of numbers and the power of the masses." He points out that the abstraction of the political vote is not a genuine substitute for economic independence. Food is much more important to a starving man than the "right" to place a mark on a ballot paper.

Thibon warns that not only freedom itself, but the taste for freedom, is dying. "The age of organisers and technocrats has begun. The human person, deprived of every living attachment, is not longer a member of an organism but a cog in a machine, a figure in a particular set of statistics. He has become an isolated slave amid a multitude of slaves.

"But the worst danger of all is that in losing his external freedoms man is losing the sense of freedom and even the taste for it. Slavery, it has been rightly said, is so degrading to men that it even brings them to like it . . ."

The author obviously agrees with the view of the late C. H. Douglas that individual integrity is the only thing, which can save the world. He writes: "Instead of trying to baptise the unbaptisable, it would perhaps be better for us Christians to try to realise fully the logical consequences of our baptism and our Christianity. It is not our task to attract impurities but to make ourselves pure. The thing that is important is not to dally with caricatures but to show to the world the true image of Christ; not to compromise with false ideas but always more and more to distinguish our own from them."

We can recommend this book, without necessarily agreeing with all points made by the author, to those engaged in the Christian Campaign for freedom. Price 21/-, post free.

## 1957 OFFENSIVE IS MAKING PROGRESS

### Activities to be Further Intensified

Speaking at "The New Times" Annual Dinner in September 1955, Mr. Eric Butler predicted that the Social Credit Movement was on the eve of a new and more fundamental advance. Events have confirmed this conviction, and those who have never wavered in their faith that no real progress could be made in the struggle against the forces of the anti-Christ unless Social Credit was correctly presented as the policy of the Christian philosophy, have demonstrated that their faith was well-founded.

During last year a tremendous amount of groundwork was done: training classes were held in Melbourne, the Christian Campaign for Freedom was expanded, and several important public meetings were held. One of the main results of this work was the recruitment of a number of very capable new supporters. Many older supporters also feel that they have improved their capacity to be effective as the result of the study courses.

Early this year it was felt that there were sufficient competent supporters to undertake a major re-organisation as a prelude to the most intensive campaigning in the movement's history. Following a special address by Mr. Eric Butler to Melbourne supporters, the Social Credit Action Group was reconstructed on a Secretariat basis. "The New Times" was reduced to eight pages in order to ensure that supporters' contributions went into campaigning activities instead of some being used to subsidise their journal. Under the guidance of the Social Credit Action Group Secretariat a personal canvass of all present supporters in the metropolitan area was undertaken and is now nearly completed. This canvass is proving of immense value in more ways than one. While the first canvass has been

primarily for the purpose of organising a regular flow of financial support which the Directors of the Secretariat can rely upon, it has also been used to inform readers personally of what is being done and to enlist their support for various activities such as house meetings and the distribution of special campaigning literature.

There is now more cohesion in the movement in Melbourne than there has ever been. The 1957 offensive is making progress, but an immediate intensification of activities is planned. It is not merely sufficient to recruit and train an army; it must engage the enemy. Plans have been prepared for a special tactical offensive, which is designed to consolidate the work of the past few years and further our general strategy. This tactical offensive will, in the first stage, be directed towards influencing the next Federal elections, in the normal course of events now approximately eighteen months away.

Every reader of this paper will shortly receive a supply of brochures to launch this campaign in their own area. Melbourne supporters should avail themselves of the opportunity to hear Mr. Eric Butler on the 19th of this month at the Temple Court meeting advertised in this Supplement.

### Plan for the Annual Dinner —NOW

It is confidently anticipated that this year's Annual Dinner, to be held on Friday, September 20, will reflect the new upsurge of activity and interest over the past twelve months. ### Christianity and Freedom

This important book provides refreshing evidence of vigorous thinking by a group of Christian leaders concerned with the question of whether Christianity and Freedom are inseparable. It is based upon a series of papers read to the Centre Intellectuals Francais by outstanding Christian intellectuals like Gustave Thibon and Daniel-Rops. The Conclusion is by His Eminence Cardinal Feltin of Paris, who states that as a Christian Bishop he must choose freedom. "Freedom lies at the very heart of Christianity . . . Social laws and technical processes are indispensable, but they should not result in making man an anonymous cog in a smoothly running machine."

Some of the most valuable material in this book is presented by Professor Daniel-Rops, under the heading "Towards A Christian Society." This eminent French Christian warns that "it is all too clear that we are traversing now one of those ages in which freedom is in full retreat, that a whole combination of forces exist which seems intent on making for its ruin, and that unless humanity is on its guard it may find itself tomorrow in a state of servitude in comparison with which that known by antiquity was nothing."

Daniel-Rops leaves no doubt that he opposes that perverted view of Christianity, which rejects any suggestion that the Christian Churches should concern themselves about political, economic and financial issues. It is certain that unless the Churches speak with authority against all policies, which infringe upon genuine individual freedom, totalitarianism will continue its forward march.

After briefly outlining the release of the individual from hard, brutalising labor, Professor Daniel-Rops states that we now have "a chance unique in all history" to provide genuine freedom. "Liberation by the machine must become a living freedom, organic and truly human."

This valuable book should be in the armoury of every militant Christian determined, in the words of Daniel-Rops, to ensure that the Churches insist, "the whole system of the economy must be directed in the interests of man."

## Large Number of Meetings Already Addressed This Year

Although Mr. Eric Butler has addressed a large number of meetings during the first half of 1957, he anticipates addressing an even greater number during the second half. He has visited many parts of Victoria, and, during his recent visit to the Mildura-Red Cliffs area, took the opportunity of visiting Renmark and Berri in South Australia. Two small public meetings were held, one at Red Cliffs and one at Berri. But, as elsewhere, Mr. Butler did invaluable personal contact work, particularly amongst the clergy. The way has been prepared for a further visit by Mr. Butler at a later date.

His last visit to the Wimmera area was most encouraging, with public meetings held at Horsham (a number of supporters from other Wimmera centres attended this meeting), Nhill and Yanac. Yanac was a new centre for Mr. Butler, and over 50 people attended to hear him. Mr. Butler plans to revisit the Wimmera shortly and has plans to cover a bigger number of centres with both meetings and personal interviews.

There was only a small attendance at his meeting at Colac, in the Western District, but the local paper carried an excellent report of Mr. Butler's address. Mr. Butler addressed a meeting of supporters from the northeast at Wangaratta several months ago. Several very active enthusiasts are doing good work in this centre.

Apart from addressing public meetings Mr. Butler has also attended numbers of house meetings and addressed the Euroa Rotary Club. Following the report of this address in the local paper, Mr. Butler has been engaged in a controversy with a local resident through the columns of the paper. This has created considerable interest. Limitations on space preclude us from reporting all Mr. Butler's activities.

# Questionnaire Basis of New Campaign

## Can Electors "Draw the Line"?

In publishing the article, "Tax Tyranny and Dishonesty," in our issue of June 14, we stated that this was the first "shot" in an expansion of our campaigning. The object of the article was "to ascertain if there is in our society a point where a substantial and determined body of people 'will draw the line' at sacrificing their rights and liberties, and, if so, where it is."

The following questionnaire, concerning constitutional rights and functions, is now being widely circulated in order to take the matter a step further:

It should be made clear that the rights of the individual are in no way dependent on what a majority or a minority of people decide. Men and women may have their rights denied and grossly interfered with by bad men; but the fact that they have rights is as inherent in the Universe as that they should be born and have life.

The object of this questionnaire is twofold:

- (1) To determine if there is in our society a line below which they will emphatically refuse the State power to encroach, and if so, where it is.
- (2) To concentrate attention upon this vital issue.

### Natural Right—

1. Are people born into this world with a right to develop and live their lives free from all man-made restraints except those, which are necessary to protect other people's freedom?

### Constitutional Rights—

The conception that people have Constitutional rights is based on society giving an affirmative answer to the above question.

## An Introduction To Social Credit

After dealing simply but comprehensively with the Social Credit A — B theorem in the chapter on Economics, Dr. Monahan points out that the emphasis in Social Credit has passed from purely technical considerations to the subject of credit control and policy. This leads naturally to an examination of the policy of Social Credit and the Christian philosophy from which it stems, as compared with the various totalitarian policies based upon an anti-Christian philosophy.

Dr. Monahan's book is well produced, has a comprehensive index, and contains two appendices: one giving Douglas's analysis of the financing of a long-term production cycle in order to present a simple and convenient formal proof of the Social Credit theorem, and the other outlining the reasons for the establishment of the Social Credit Secretariat.

## The Chosen People Theory

"In our own country the Chosen People theory has in fact been carried to the point of superstition — a superstition immensely advantageous to the Jews — which consists in interpreting the passage of Scripture containing the promise made to Abraham, 'I will bless them that bless thee, and curse them that curseth thee,' as meaning that favour shown to the Jews — who form merely a fraction of the seed of Abraham — brings with it peculiar blessings. In reality it would be easier to show by history that countries and rulers who have protected the Jews have frequently met with disaster. France banished the Jews in 1394 and again in 1615, and did not readmit them in large numbers till 1715-19, so that they were absent throughout the most glorious period in French history — the Grand Siecle of Louis XIV — whilst their return coincided with the Regency, from which moment the monarchy of France may be said to have declined.

"England likewise banished the Jews in 1290, and in was during the three and half centuries they remained in exile that she was known as 'Merrie England.' The fact that their return in force in 1664 was followed by the Great Plague and the year after by the Great Fire of London would not appear to indicate that the Jews necessarily bring good fortune to the land that protects them. The truth is, of course, that kindness to any portion of the human race brings its own reward in the form of moral improvement in the individual or nation that performs it, but no more benefit attaches to philanthropy when exercised toward the Jew than towards the Chinaman."

### FINANCING "NATIONAL" COMMUNISM

Students of international finance will recall how after the German-Jewish financial groups in New York had financed the smashing up of Imperialist Russia and the rise of the Communists, they fed credits into Russia via their agents in London, Paris and Hamburg, thus circumventing the policy of the American Republican Administration, which refused to recognise the Communists in Russia. The same technique is to be used again, this time to enable dollar credits to be passed to the "National" Communists in Poland.

There is a Congressional ban against American credits for Communist countries. But it has been suggested that this ban can be overcome by granting credits to West Germany on the condition that the West German Government would make similar credits available to the Polish Communists.

## Bees as Herbalists

Careful observation of the flower choice of bees has convinced me that they are knowledgeable herbalists. All the flowers, which herbalists know are rich in medicinal properties, seem to be the first choice of bees. The cultivated (and somewhat unnatural) bedding plants of the garden are visited infrequently except by the bumblebees. When first leaving the hive, the bees feast themselves upon willow blossom, which, apart from being rich in minerals, is also a gentle purge, ideal pollen for the hive after the long semi-fasting of winter. Apple and pear blossom, rich in nerve tonic properties is their next choice, followed by holly. How the bees crowd the holly trees, which is one of the supreme herbs for building body structure. (I never before realized the rich honey scent possessed by holly trees until the love of the bees for holly led me to consider the flowers more carefully.) Wild raspberry, the great herb of the female body and of birth, is their following choice, and from there they mass upon the blackberry blossom, lime, and wild rose, all nerve tonic and blood-enriching, so that the honey which will feed the hive through the forthcoming winter is charged with health-giving properties. (How sad - indeed cruel — to deprive the bees at any time of a sufficiency of their perfect food, so knowledgeably gathered, and substitute lifeless, nerve-enervating white sugar for the hives!) From wild rose the bees go to the aromatic flowers in the garden — rosemary, lavender, sage, thyme. Then the poppy is a great love of the bees, indeed my Iceland poppies this year dropped their heads under the weight of the bees crowding into their beautiful frail-cupped flower. I love the bitter, heavy scent of poppies, and I know what a wonderful plant it is in giving relief to pain and have used it much. I have never seen bees upon onion flowers unless they appeared in low health. The first year of a new hive of bees in my garden, the onion flowers were visited so keenly by the hive inmates that, the following year, I planted onions close to the hives especially for the bees; but by then they had been so restored to health from the good living in the unspoilt forest land around Abbots Well in the New Forest, that they almost ignored the onion flowers, and the only ones which I saw there seemed heavy-winged, drowsy bees, obviously in low health.

The heather and ivy feast are then sought by the bees to fill the hives before the winter fast begins. Then, well fed on the medicinally rich flowers, which they have selected with inherent skill (and, I hope, not poisoned by atomic radiations or chemical sprays on plants, or blown on to them from farm crops so treated), they will survive the hardest of winters and emerge

## THE BATTLE: CHEMICALS VERSUS FOOD

Usher L. Burdick, an exceptional and intelligent member of the American Congress, has recently drawn the attention of the U.S. House of Representatives to the danger of brainwashing (as outlined by Beria in the Red textbook on psycho politics). Congressman Burdick is now attempting to awaken wider public and congressional interest in the danger of white bread and chemical additives in foodstuffs. The following are taken from recent statements he has made in Washington:

Under the present law food-manufacturing concerns may use harmful additives and contaminants and push the food out to the unsuspecting public.

People read the propaganda ads. of the manufacturers and gulp this food with avidity. Suppose a person finds he has been poisoned. He has recourse to the courts for damages, but being the plaintiff, the burden is on him to show by a preponderance of the evidence that the food is poisonous. This amendment will mean that the burden is on the manufacturers to prove that the ingredients they have injected into food are not harmful, deleterious or poisonous to those who use the food. As the law stands now, a man cannot say anything until he is poisoned, and if he gets a real dose of the food his early demise may end the proceedings. The manufacturer sits by complacently and says nothing, while the poisoned food complainant, with his battery of lawyers, is compelled firstly to describe the additives and compounds used, and secondly, to show that those additives are harmful, deleterious and poisonous to those who use the product. This gives the food adulterant free rein to go ahead with his concoction, and take chances on what will happen. If the complainant dies of the effects of the food, so much the better for the manufacturer or processor. If he doesn't die, he probably will be dead before he gets through with his court proceedings.

Dr. William Coda Martin, in his preface to the book "Our Daily Poison", says:

"Now that the U.S. Public Health Service has confirmed the fact that all foods available today in the markets contain a residue of DDT . . . it is important that the consumer be aware of the dangers to his health when he eats these contaminated foods. It is now believed that the greater number of hepatitis cases may be caused by DDT sprayed on the leaves of green vegetables."

### OUR DOCTORED BREAD

In Mickenden's book "Our Daily Poison", Chapter 10 treats of "Your Doctored Daily Bread". Everybody has assumed for centuries that bread is "the staff of life". However, says Mickenden, "its deterioration from a staff to the bruised reed it is today makes a sad story of human weakness . . . ignorance and . . . greed".

A grain of wheat or "berry" is built up of three layers. The outermost layer is a tough skin formed of cellulose fibres containing mineral matter. This is discarded before the grain is ground. The middle layer is built up of small cells containing pigment, which give bran its brown colour. The inner layer is built up of larger cells, divided into two parts: the kernel and the germ. The kernel, the larger part, consists of carbohydrates (starch, cellulose and sugar), some small mineral matter, proteins, a trace of fat and moisture. Percentage wise, the kernel is poor in fat and minerals. The germ, the embryo of a new plant, is the richest part of the grain, as it contains high contents of fat, mineral and protein. It is high in vitamin content.

White flour and white bread is produced from the kernel. Both the outer coat, with its high minerals and roughage, and the germ, with its rich store of nutriment, are discarded. The poorest part of the berry thus goes into human consumption, the richest part into cattle and hog feed.

The germ of wheat, being rich in fat, turns rancid rather quickly when it is released from its protective coverings. Therefore, it must be used quickly to prevent spoilage.

Under modern methods of grinding with heavy steel rollers the germ is flattened on the sieve in the form of flat flakes and it adheres to the sieve. All that passes through the sieve is white flour. Professor Carlson, of the University of Chicago, calls this "a tragedy", or as Mickenden says,

"an impoverished mockery of what nature intended this basic food to be".

This is only a part of the shockingly incredible story. Having already discarded the richest part of the wheat berry milling industry then decided that the white flour provided by this modern milling method was not yet white enough; so they said it must be bleached by the use of a chemical known as nitrogen trichloride or by its trade name, AGENE. This bleaching agent was used extensively for 25 years in both the United States and Great Britain until Sir Edward Mellanby, a British scientist, suddenly discovered that when this bleached flour was fed to dogs it produced "running fits" or "canine hysteria". This led to a pronouncement by Dr. Paul B. Dunbar, the Commissioner of the Food and Drug Administration that outlawed nitrogen trichloride as a "maturing agent".

Undaunted, the milling industry then turned to a new "maturing" or "bleaching" substance known as chlorine dioxide, but as Mickenden says, "no one has yet discovered that this chemical will cause dogs' tails to fall off".

Proper aging of wheat for milling requires time—several months at least. Storage would be expensive. So the millers went to the use of these chemicals to speed up the aging process and thereby cut down their storage costs. Bleaching was purely incidental. The use of these chemicals seems therefore not to have been in response to popular demand, but was stimulated by a profit motive.

Then the bakers began to enter the act. They began to doctor the bread made from doctored flour by adding synthetic chemical "softness". These were not added in the interest of the consumer, but to make it appear that the bread was fresh.

## Spiders

Spiders, though not generally popular, are true friends of man. Some scientists believe that human life could not exist without them.

For a spider's entire life is devoted to snaring and devouring insects which might otherwise multiply and desolate the earth.

It has been estimated that each year the spiders in England and Wales destroy insects more than equal in weight to the entire human population of that area.

in good health to the willow-blossom feast in the springtime!

I should like to add one observation which is not exactly herbal, and that is, that bees seem to know how to use wholewheat flour and show a need for it, possibly for the making of pollen bread. When I have put out whole-wheat flour for the several bees have come regularly to the flour, hovering close above it and with a purposeful fanning of their wings have gently winnowed away the light-weight bran and then pushed the cleansed flour into their pollen bags. Commenting on this to a Surrey beekeeper, I was told by him that in former days pea flour was often put out for hungry bees when there was a shortage of pollen. —By Juliette" De Bairacii Levy in "The Albert Howard Press Sheet."

## HOW RED IS THE AMERICAN GOVERNMENT?
