INSIDIOUS CAMPAIGN AGAINST THE BRITISH CROWN

Daily Press Suppresses Real Issues

"The essential soul of a nation is in its character, its culture and tradition. The King is the natural embodiment of Honours and Sanctions —of Culture and Tradition and, as such, is naturally the Supreme Commander of the Armed Forces. So that our problem seems to resolve itself into a real understanding and restoration of the functions we have allowed to decay."—C. H. Douglas, in "Realistic Constitutionalism" (1947).

The most important, and sinister, aspect of the worldwide controversy concerning the Queen and her Court is not the criticism by Lord Altrincham in his obscure journal. Much of Lord Altrincham's criticism is personally insulting to the Queen, while the rest of it merely reflects the present widespread ignorance concerning the true purpose of the Crown in the British Constitution. But the manner in which this criticism was widely publicised throughout the world, and used to promote a controversy the main result of which has been to undermine still further the whole institution of the British Crown, is clear evidence to us of the activities of those semi-secret forces working not only for the destruction of the material strength of the British world, but also for the elimination of British culture.

Immediately the daily press used Lord Altrincham's criticism to promote a public controversy concerning the Queen and her activities, the Victorian League of Rights sent a cable to the Queen, pledging loyalty to the British Crown and deploring the fact that worldwide controversy was unfortunately obscuring the important fact that the Crown was a vital part of the constitutional heritage of British people everywhere. The text of the League's cable together with further comment on the true purpose of the Monarchy was issued to the Melbourne press. But while the press had plenty of space to publicise the profound observations of American papers who referred to the Queen as "Liz" and urged her "to stay as sweet as you are", and to report the views of people who obviously felt that the Queen's main purpose in life was to look

glamorous and to open as many bazaars as possible, there was no space to draw attention to the fundamental aspects of the Crown. The statement from the League of Rights was completely suppressed.

There are many sincere people, who while fully aware of the fact no stable society is possible without constitutional checks and balances which protect the individual against the abuse of power, believe that a Republican form of Government is superior to a Constitutional Monarchy. Now if the controversy were an open and honest one on the merits of a Constitutional Monarchy as opposed to Republicanism, the real issues could not be ignored. Such a controversy would inevitably direct attention to the Queen's power of veto and other aspects of the Crown's constitutional functions, which, as C. H. Douglas pointed out, "we have allowed to decay." The "man in the street" — some of them sixteen years of age! — whom the press has been questioning on the subject of whether the Queen is going to the races too often, would be hard put to it to answer one question of, for example, the Bill of Rights. If, of course, he accepts the "democratic" view that Parliament should be "supreme", he could hardly be expected to understand that the Bill of Rights was designed to provide the individual with a mechanism through which he could appeal to the Crown to force the reconsideration of laws passed by Parliament. The campaign to "modernise" the Monarchy will not help the individual gain any understanding of the heritage, which his forefathers struggled so hard to build up. Even most of those who believe they have

been supporting the Queen in the current controversy are unconsciously aiding the insidious undermining of the Monarchy as an institution. They accept uncritically the view that the Monarchy should be "democratic", ignorant of the truth that the great

OUR POLICY

1. The support of all policies rooted in the Christian philosophy of freedom and based upon the Moral Law.
2. The preservation of Australia's sovereignty as a part of the British Empire, and the exposure of all internal and external groups, which attack that sovereignty.
3. The preservation and extension of genuine local government.
4. The preservation and strengthening of all Constitutional safeguards for the purpose of protecting fundamental individual rights.
5. The encouragement of all activities designed to bring Governments under more effective control by the electors.
6. The preservation and extension of genuine free, competitive enterprise and private ownership, and opposition to all Monopoly, whether it be "private" or State.
7. The support of a financial policy which will (a) permit free enterprise to make available to all individuals an increasing standard of living and greater leisure for cultural pursuits, (b) result in no further increase to the community's indebtedness and the sound business practice of gradually reducing existing debt. Recognising that the basis of any sound economy is agriculture, the encouragement of agricultural policies, which will ensure the preservation and building up of soil fertility by organic farming and gardening; and the prevention of soil erosion and the protection of forests and watersheds.

virtue of an hereditary Monarchy is the fact that it is free from sectional factions struggling for power. The Monarchy should be an impartial unsectional, undying representative of what Douglas has described as "the essential soul" of the nation.

Real loyalty to the Crown means much more than cheering the Queen like a film star; it means loyalty to all those values and traditions, which the Crown represents. These values and traditions are under worldwide attack today. Those directing and encouraging this attack are not coming into the open with a direct attack upon the British Crown. But slowly but surely they are doing just what that arch-internationalist, Arnold Toynbee, predicted over twenty years ago: While "denying with our lips what we are doing with our hands", they are breaking down local sovereignties preparation for the creation of the World State. The disease is now so deeply-rooted that even Ministers of the Crown, who have taken the Oath of Allegiance, are betraying their oaths by their support of various schemes which reduce the sovereignty of the British world.

If the British world and British values are to survive, it is essential that there be a re-birth of understanding of the real significance of the British Crown. This is not a question of mere sentimental theorising; it goes right to the core of the struggle by the whole British world to survive in a world, which is increasingly being given over to gangsterism.

GENERAL MACARTHUR ON HIGH TAXATION

That great American soldier General Douglas MacArthur has stepped into the fight against taxation. The General who has had personal experience of Communist subversion in various forms, apparently understands the idea of enslavement by taxation as laid down by Karl Marx.

Speaking in New York to shareholders of the firm of Sperry Rand, of which he is board chairman, General MacArthur said:

"The present tax structure is probably adequate to socialise the United States. The budget is but the guesswork of a small group of individuals, temporarily gathered in Washington, whose previous training and experience has little to do with the nation's need."

"Draw the Line" Campaign Gathers Momentum

Reports from all parts of Australia show that supporters are helping the "Draw the Line" campaign to gain momentum. But only a few have as yet actually taken action. The majority are letting the few down unless they also realise that faith without works means death.

Those who used the suggested letter, or a similar one, that we published two issues ago, have had considerable success in getting their local papers to publish, it. We thank all those who have sent in copies of their local papers containing their letters. And we urge all those who have not done so to copy out this letter, or draft one of their own, and forward to the local paper. There are hundreds of local papers throughout Australia, which will readily publish letters, particularly if related to taxation.

Many have taken supplies of the leaflet, "Satan in Politics", and are distributing in their localities. Most actionists report an encouraging response. Those who have approached the clergy discover that there is a minority keenly interested. We again urge supporters to lose no opportunity of approaching the clergy along the lines we have suggested.

Together with this issue of "The New Times" we are forwarding our basic "Draw The Line Campaign Brochure". Adequate supplies of these are now available for use. We suggest that supporters concentrate on getting these into the hands of all responsible members of the community. Make certain that your local clergy receive copies.

Other suitable campaign leaflets are in the course of preparation. They will deal with different aspects of the subject. Once the campaign has made sufficient progress, a start can be made to contact Members of Parliament.

Mr. Butler is rapidly increasing the number of meetings per week he is addressing on the campaign. Businessmen's clubs and Rotary Clubs are requesting his services.

An intensive country and interstate speaking campaign is planned for after the Annual Dinner and Seminar. Details of these campaigns will be published later.

Experimental Canvass Makes History

On last Sunday morning, August 18, thirteen Melbourne supporters assembled at the home of a supporter in the Melbourne middle-class suburb of Camberwell, had a cup of tea, listened to a last-minute briefing by Mr. Eric Butler, Director of the League of Rights, then proceeded to discover in a house-to-house canvass, just how many people were really interested in doing something to curb the growing power of Governments, to reduce taxation, to uphold constitutional safeguards of the individual's rights, and to insist that it was time "to draw the line" against any further encroachments by Governments upon the independence of the individual.

No one knew before this canvass how many people in a typical middle-class suburb were prepared to concern themselves about "drawing the line". Nearly 300 interviews demonstrated that there is still a responsible minority of electors prepared to concern themselves. It also demonstrated that we must approach people on an individual basis. The canvassers

learned the most effective way to approach people. Much other valuable information was obtained. The final results of this historic canvass are now being fully evaluated in order that the next one can be even more effective.

The thirteen who pioneered one of the most important developments in the history of our movement demonstrated that 25 competent canvassers, prepared to devote three hours of time on a Sunday morning, could speak personally to 1000 electors, leave those who required it suitable literature, and take the names and addresses of the responsible minority prepared to follow the matter up. We have discovered by practical experiment one of the keys essential for our development in the critical days ahead. All that is required are more supporters to help with the further canvasses already being planned. The experience of the pioneers will make it easy for all those who have the will to follow the inspiring lead they have given.

Those who, for very good reasons, cannot "take the field" physically, can do their best by supplying the necessary financial "ammunition". Every supporter can play a part in a war, which we must fight to the finish.

An Introduction To Social Credit

By Bryan W. Monahan

This excellent book is specially recommended to those who desire a clearly written, but authoritative introduction to the subject of Social Credit. Dr. Bryan Monahan is Chairman of the Social Credit Secretariat, a body established by the late Major C. H. Douglas.

Social Credit concerns much more than monetary reform, which was one of the reasons why Major Douglas established the Social Credit Secretariat. Dr. Monahan writes: "Social Credit is a way of looking at things a point of view that seems to bring every branch of knowledge into a new and more clear perspective. Equally all knowledge is relevant to Social Credit."

"An Introduction To Social Credit" is divided into four parts: Physics, Economics, Politics and Metaphysics. The chapter on physics shows how increasing leisure and security for every individual are physically possible. The author writes: "Clearly, only either leisure or 'unemployment' outside production can dispose of the 'unemployment problem'. The problems of economic and politics are absolutely conditioned by the physical realities described: short of sabotage or cataclysm, the progress of the situation is inexorable..."

After dealing simply but comprehensively with the Social Credit A — B theorem in the chapter on Economics, Dr. Monahan points out that the emphasis in Social Credit has passed from purely technical considerations to the subject of credit control and policy. This leads naturally to an examination of the policy of Social Credit and the Christian philosophy from which it stems, as compared with the various totalitarian policies based upon an anti-Christian philosophy.

Dr. Monahan's book is well produced, has a comprehensive index and contains two appendices: one giving Douglas's analysis of the financing of a long-term production cycle in order to present a simple and convenient formal proof of the Social Credit theorem, and the other outlining the reasons for the establishment of the Social Credit Secretariat.

"The International Idea"

"... there is a perfectly straightforward and practical explanation for this propaganda for internationalism, and for practical purposes one does not really need to look further. Hardly a day passes without a leading article in 'The Times', or other papers of the same type of interest, remarking, as though it were axiomatic, that the world is one economic unit, and that no adjustment of the present discontent can be expected which does not proceed from international agreement.

"... the simplest explanation of this is that if you only make a subject large enough and involve a sufficiently large number of people in the solution of it, you can rest assured you will never get a solution. A democracy of a thousand voters can be personally approached and convinced on any subject within a reasonable period of time, but if you enlarge the franchise to include everyone over twenty-one in a population of 45 millions you can be reasonably sure that any general conclusion at which it will arrive, it will arrive at twenty-five years after that conclusion ceases to be true. If you can superimpose upon that by means of a controlled Press, Broadcasting, and other devices of a similar nature, something that you call 'public opinion' (because it is the only opinion which is articulate), you have a perfect mechanism for a continuous dictatorship, and moreover, it is the form of dictatorship which is fundamentally desired by the collectivist mentality — a dictatorship which has power without responsibility.

"There is, however, another explanation almost equally obvious, and probably equally true, and that is that local sovereignty, particularly as it extends to finance, is a barrier to the supremacy of international finance. A Jewish financier, expressing his contempt for Gentile mentality, once remarked that the secret of the inability of the Gentile to shake himself free from the dominance of finance resided in the fact that the Gentile was incapable of distinguishing between numbers and things. I should be inclined to go further than that, and say that the mentality, which is attracted by the Internationalist idea, is incapable of distinguishing between numbers, things, and individuals. It is a type of mentality, which is fostered and ultimately becomes inseparable from people who deal with nothing but figures, and is, in my opinion, the reason why the banker in particular is fundamentally unsuited for the position of re-organiser of the world. No banker, as such, has any knowledge of large undertakings. He thinks he has, because he deals with large figures, and he mistakes the dealing with large figures as being equivalent to dealing with large numbers of things and people

"... this is the idea which is at the root of the International idea, where it is held sincerely. It is that you can obtain an elaborate series of statistics regarding the populations of the world and put a committee down at Geneva, or elsewhere, to legislate for them on the basis of statistics

"The danger to the world of this idea is instant and practical. There is a world movement definitely conscious of its aims, counting amongst its adherents many persons placed by social position, prestige, and other conditions, in what would seem to be a most impressive relation to politics and organisation, which is consciously working for just exactly this purpose. With it, or behind it, however you like to regard the matter, are all those forces whose ends are best served by the subjection of the individual to the group. While it will certainly fail, its backing makes a conflict certain."

Queensland Supporter Calls for Opposition to Fluoridation

We have received the following statement from Mr. J. E. Harding, Hon. Secretary of the Rockhampton Monetary Reform League:

It is clear that the interests behind the attempt to place sodium fluoride in the water supplies of the cities of the world are determined to make an all-out attempt in Australia. This, no doubt, is directly connected with the discoveries of huge bauxite deposits in Queensland, and the certainty of Australia becoming a great manufacturer of aluminium.

Any Social Crediter, who has read up the evidence for and against fluoridation, will realise the menace of this thing to the principles of Christianity and freedom and to the physical health of humanity. There is little doubt that it is an attempt to condition the minds of the people, so that there will be no real opposition to the plans of those who seek to make humanity, slaves in a world State.

The evidence indicates that Social Crediters everywhere, instinctively realise this, and take the initiative in opposing fluoridation. I would urge all Social Crediters to study the evidence for and against fluoridation and to do everything in their power to expose and defeat any attempt to fluoridate public water supplies.

Visiting professors are urging local authorities to fluoridate drinking water without referring the matter to the electors, on the grounds that the people are not competent to be judge of the question. If this is permitted, it will be used as a precedent to deprive the individual of all his rights, and make him an abject slave.

Newspaper reports state that the New South Wales Government is to be asked to enact legislation by which the Sydney water supply can be fluoridated. It is vital that Social Crediters in Sydney and throughout Australia go into action at once to ensure that this attempt is defeated. Sydney will be the vital testing ground. If the campaigners succeed in fluoridating Sydney water supplies, they may well succeed throughout Australia. On the other hand, if we can defeat them in Sydney, we shall have won a major victory.

I would suggest that our line of action should be, (1) a request to the Premier of New South Wales not to enact any legislation to authorise or permit fluoridation until the evidence for and against has been carefully examined and the case proved beyond doubt, (2) that the Premier be requested to ensure that

the wish of the people shall be sought by referendum, before any water supply is fluoridated and (3) that in the event of the Premier not agreeing to these requests, then action be directed to arouse the people to demand a referendum.

I trust that Social Crediters everywhere will take action at once on this vital question.

Dr. Evatt and the Jews

Before making his recent trip overseas, during which he visited Israel, Dr. H. V. Evatt felt it necessary to address a Zionist meeting in Melbourne. It was on this occasion that he expressed the view that basic resources of the world should be placed under international control. Shortly after his return to Australia we see Dr. Evatt making another address—or was it a report? —to another Melbourne meeting of Jews, this time organised by the Jewish Council to Combat Fascism and Anti-Semitism.

Supporters of this journal who were at the meeting report that Dr. Evatt had a very large audience, which loudly applauded his claim that Israel was the "bastion of democracy" in the Middle East, and that the basic raw materials of the world should be placed under international control. Dr. Evatt also apparently felt it necessary to stress the fact that his party was a socialist Party. This appeared to please the audience immensely.

As Dr. Evatt is highly regarded by both the Zionists and the Communists, what is his special role in the international scheme of things? This is one question, which Dr. Evatt's political opponents will not ask. They know that it is difficult to stand up to the "anti-Semitic smear".

Mr. Manning of the "Democratic Labor Party"

Mr. Alan Manning, President of the N.S.W. Branch of the Democratic Labor Party, has recently favoured the Sydney "Daily Mirror" with an outline of what his party stands for. The most interesting point in Mr. Manning's article, which the Melbourne "News Weekly" republished in its issue of August 14, was the reference to Israel. Mr. Manning describes a discussion he had with a visitor from Israel and then goes on to say that the Democratic Labor Party must emulate Israel. The programme he outlines, including the Chifley Government's 1945 Banking Legislation, indicates that Mr. Manning knows as little about genuine democracy as his Israeli friends. At least he and Dr. Evatt have one thing in common: they both admire Israel.

Is Cancer Cure Being Suppressed Because of Economic Fears?

In April 1954, ten doctors of medicine from various parts of the United States spent five days at the Hoxsey Cancer Clinic at Dallas in Texas. They inspected the modern clinic with its up-to-the-minute equipment and laboratories and carefully examined and questioned twenty-one former cancer patients who were cured at the Hoxsey clinic after being pronounced "incurable" by their doctors.

After completing the examination these ten doctors who had come to Dallas expecting to find a "quack", sat down and wrote a careful report which all of them signed. The report which was issued at a special press conference, said:

"We, as a Committee, feel that the Hoxsey treatment is superior to such conventional methods of treatment as X-ray, radium and surgery. We are willing to use it in our office, in our practice on our own patients when at our discretion it is deemed necessary."

ATTACKS BEGIN

The Hoxsey treatment was not discovered by Harry Hoxsey himself, he inherited it from his father and grandfather. group of eminent American doctors formed a syndicate with the intention of using the Hoxsey treatment.

According to Hoxsey in his book "You Don't Have to Die", these doctors wanted him to turn his formula over to them and after a ten-year trial period he was to get 10% of any money earned by the cure. The syndicate was to keep the other 90%. When the young Hoxsey objected to this 'arrangement' the medical profession began its attacks on him in earnest.

TRAINED AS DOCTOR

Because he has never been trained in a medical school, Hoxsey himself is not allowed to treat cancer. COURT CASES

For the past thirty years Harry Hoxsey has been in and out of courtrooms, wasting precious time and money, instead of being left to improve his cure.

Everything possible has been done to run him out of the cancer "business" and his legal costs have run into astronomical figures.

Whenever Hoxsey is allowed to bring witnesses into court and proper case histories of cured patients, he wins. His opponents do not like this kind of trial and do everything possible to prevent facts about cures from reaching a jury. In May 1955, for instance, the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners tried to revoke the licences of doctors working at the Hoxsey clinic.

NEW ATTACK

Later in a similar case, Dr. Donald Watt, one of the Hoxsey doctors, appeared in court on his own. Dr. Watt won his case but to the amazement of observers, Judge Long OVERRULED THE JURY and ordered that Dr. Watt's medical licence be revoked for eighteen months.

Since then newspapers, magazines, radio and T.V. stations which refuse to mention favorable reports on Hoxsey, have been hammering their audiences with the "news" that the Hoxsey treatment has been found worthless by a court.

The smear against Hoxsey is unbelievably vicious: newspapers which attempt to print favorable mention of the treatment are warned off by threats that their big advertisers will withdraw advertising; Post Offices throughout the U.S. carry a large red sign saying that Hoxsey is a fraud.

Only recently Hoxsey was forced to relinquish ownership of his Dallas clinic. However the clinic is in the hands of Dr. Harry Taylor and Hoxsey, in a letter dated May 1, 1957, says, "I am certain the clinic will provide the high standard of care and treatment which has been its tradition." At the same time he is continuing the fight to have his treatment recognized.

The obstacles mentioned above are only a few of the many which Harry Hoxsey has had to negotiate in his heroic fight to cure and give new hope to cancer sufferers.
