Significance Of The U.S. Recession

The current economic recession in America, where there are now five million unemployed and Americans are being shocked by the sight of bread lines for the first time since the Great Depression, has worldwide implications. There is no real reason why the American economic situation should affect the peoples of other countries, as the American economy is practically self-sufficient. But the financial masters of the American economy have deliberately exploited the American economy and the American people in a worldwide drive to extend domination through dollar debts.

If it were not for enormous foreign "aid" programmes, imposed under the alleged necessity of containing["] Communism, huge expenditure on armaments, and big public works schemes, the American economy would either collapse in chaos or there would have to be a fundamental change in America's internal financial and economic policies resulting in a steady expansion of real freedom for the individual. There could be a big reduction in the hours of work necessary to provide required consumer goods and a dividend system, financed from the credits now being used for foreign give-away production, supplementing the wage system. But the controllers of policy are determined to prevent any such developments, which is one of the explanations why no real effort is made to undermine and eventually eliminate the Communist conspiracy.

The central problem confronting the controllers of financial policy in the U.S.A. is how to condition the American people to accept increasing totalitarianism when the economic facts clearly indicate that the American individual could have greater freedom and more economic independence. American productive capacity — the nation's real credit — is so enormous that in spite of the armament programme and foreign aid schemes there is a growing problem of how to dispose of "surplus" consumer production.

has conveniently released a report stating that Russia and China are using foreign aid programmes to expand Communism. Not one iota of evidence has been produced to show that the enormous flow of dollar production into any part of the world has halted the expansion of the real Communist conspiracy. But there is plenty of evidence to show how dollar aid is an instrument of dollar diplomacy. An intensification of dollar aid programmes simply means an intensification of the rate at which those accepting the aid go into dollar debt.

These dollar debts clearly can never be repaid for the simple reason that America would have to accept an enormous flow of goods which American tariffs are specifically designed to keep out. The ultimate result of the extension of the dollar aid programme is exploit the Americans and their production system to bring that portion of the world not under Communist control firmly under the domination of the international Money Power. Whether the present American recession was deliberately allowed to develop or whether it could not be avoided at present, it has provided the opportunity for further psychological preparation of the American people to

The problem is to be "solved" by a nation-wide campaign to "educate" the American people on the necessity of greater foreign aid programmes. In order to frighten the American people into accepting this programme, the International Co-operation Administration, which directs the foreign aid programme, submit passively to their allotted role in the development of the Big Idea — world domination.

Countries receiving dollar aid, irrespective of what form in which it is granted—including the private dollar investments which Mr. Macmillan urges for Australia—are also willing to co-operate in their own enslavement because they believe that only by the capital development made possible by dollar credits can economic recessions be avoided. So far from hampering the expansion of Communism, this pro-

Japan's Drive For Trade: A report from Tokyo states that Japan urgently requires to resume the huge trade she conducted with China before the war. The Japanese Prime Minister, Mr. Kishi, strongly favours an East-West summit conference, which he believes may relieve international tension and pave the way for Japanese trade with Red China. Japan is being driven towards trade with the Communist bloc primarily because the financial and economic policies of the Western nations preclude Japan from exporting sufficient to these countries to obtain necessary raw materials. This is one more example of how politics are dominated by unrealistic financial and economic policies. Western policy makers appear to be determined to do everything to defeat Communism except modify those policies, which help the Communists. the most.

Sm all-Scale And **Production:** Autom ation Mr. L. Landon Goodman, Industrial Specialist of the British Electrical Development Association and author of the Penguin book entitled Man and Auto*mation*, claims that the widespread belief that automation applied only to large-scale mass production was not well-based. There were certain strong indications that automation would be applied as much to small-scale production in the not too distant future. Examples of developments in this direction are given. Freed from artificial financial limitations, the size of production units necessary to supply the genuine requirements of individuals would automatically be governed by the natural laws governing association. All the evidence indicates that small and medium-sized industries would be the norm in a realistic social structure.

Hire Purchase Debt Grows: The latest published figures show that Australians will soon owe £300.000,000 on retail hire-purchase agreements. The rapid growth of the hire-purchase system is one of the irrefutable proofs that under present financial rules industry generates prices at a faster rate than it distributes purchasing power to liquidate these prices. Most of the discussions on hire purchase ignore the fundamental fact that it is one of the methods used to ensure that consumers can obtain goods, which have been produced. Capital expansion, both private and public, is another method of trying to increase consumer purchasing power. The rapid growth of public and private debt is helping to undermine the structure of Western Civilization. But under present financial and economic policies the rate of debt must progressively expand in order to prevent a major economic breakdown. This is known as "sound finance"!

New Zealand Report On Fluoridation: Advocates of fluoridation are extensively quoting the New Zealand Report in order to further their totalitarian policy. Dr. Leo Spira, one of the world's leading authorities on fluoridation, has commented as follows on the New Zealand Report: "Over a period of many years I have come across a good many statements by those advocating the addition of fluorine to public water supplies. I assure you, however, that never, I repeat, never, have I seen anything as irresponsible, as inaccurate, and as many misleading statements made as were those in the present (commission's) investigation."

In the January issue of *Housewives Today* the following comment is made on the New Zealand Report:

"We have read this report and find it a somewhat blatant example of an enquiry which was NOT impartial. The burden of presenting scientific criticism of the proposal in the interests of public health was thrown entirely upon self-selected private citizens, while those representing public health departments and Government controlled institutions confined themselves to the presentation of promotional material which was not subjected to criticism by the *Commission*"

Baron Von Krupp And The Jews: We hold no brief for either the past or present activities of Baron Von Krupp, but it is necessary to point out that the opposition to Krupp's visit to Australia by the Jewish Council to Combat Fascism and Anti-Semitism is designed primarily to keep the rank and file of Jews in Australia in continued fear and to continue propagating the myth concerning the six million Jews who were allegedly murdered in Germany. The Jewish leaders have never organised any opposition to Communists coming to Australia, while they strongly support the Zionist aggression, which drove nearly one million Arabs from their homes in Palestine. Jewish leaders never lose an opportunity to use terror propaganda against their own people in order that they can be used to further their totalitarian policies.

Segregation In Texas: In West Texas there is a city called Odessa. It is an oil town, perhaps with a population of 50,000 people. This west Texas oil city school board, on August 10, 1955, gave its Negro high school students a choice of attending Odessa High School or Blackshear High School for Negroes. In two years no Negro has chosen the white school. The district had 13,000 white students and 496 Negro students enrolled last year. This shows beyond a shadow of doubt that good solid American Christian Negro people do not want to integrate, but want to

stay with their own race and kind, just as the white people of America do not want to integrate. If it were not for Zionists and communists stirring up the trouble, there would be no race problem and no Negroes wanting to attend schools for whites.

Freedom of Choice Is God's Purpose: The following excellent letter by a correspondent calling himself "Diviner" was published in *The Advertiser,* Adelaide, on February 11, under the heading, "Bondage To Fear":

"Although not always agreeing with the conclusions of the writers, I have for 20 years found your Saturday editorials stimulating and profitable. In the one, 'Bondage To Fear' (1/2/58), you acknowledge that God meant man for freedom. Were this not so He would not have implanted man's urge to rise from the bondage of the purely functional, full-time activity of providing his material needs.

"It is conceivable that in the not very distant future most of man's needed goods could be provided by no more human effort than the pressing of switches for an hour or two a week. But even if this were to happen five years from now, it should be joyfully anticipated—not feared.

"The consequences are pretty obvious. There is no freedom without freedom of choice. So, many people would learn forgotten arts and crafts; sports for physical fitness would be more popular; keen thinkers would contribute to the evolution of religion, and so on.

"As would be expected, however, the forces of darkness seek to thwart God's purpose, and in the confusion we hear of man's bondage to the machine —the liberating agent! This perverted psychic force is the enemy and to it we are in bondage."

Electoral Swing Against Macmillan Govern**ment:** If they continue with their present economic and financial policies, it is certain that the Macmillan Government is heading for the greatest electoral defeat ever suffered by British Conservative Government. The latest byelection revealed that the electoral swing against the Conservatives continues to grow rather than diminish. The Conservative candidate polled only about a quarter of the total votes polled in the Rochdale by-election. If the Conservatives are going to survive and prevent Mr. Anueran Bevan from becoming the next British Foreign Minister, they will need to modify drastically internal financial and economic policies and to take a strong stand for British sovereignty against the subversive activities of both Moscow and Wall Street.

Macmillan Supports World Government: On November 7 of last year the Earl of Gosford, Joint Parliamentary Under-Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, stated that the Macmillan Government "was fully in agreement with World Government". *World Affairs,* the journal of Federal Union, has also revealed that Mr. Macmillan is personally working against the sovereignty of the British peoples in favour of World Government:

"During the past twelve months there has been a decisive re-shaping of Britain's foreign policy and there can be no doubt that it is Harold Macmillan's guiding hand which is responsible. As yet there has been no complete adumbration of the new policy, but a number of statements by leading Ministers, including the Prime Minister himself, and certain acts of the Government all point in one direction. Britain is going to play an active part in establishing a world authority and whilst the road to that ultimate goal remains barred by Russian intransigence, the Government will attempt to give expression to the unity of the free world by giving more reality to Nato. In both cases the significant change in policy has been the realisation that only by surrendering certain aspects of national sovereignty can the international bodywhether the U.N. or Nato-properly carry out the functions consigned to it."

Mr. Macmillan has been reported as saying after his recent tour that he was surprised by the loyalty of the British and New Zealand people to the British Crown. Does this mean that he realises that this loyalty may be an obstacle to the subordination of the British nations into the World State?

Brotherhood and Morality

With "Brotherhood Week" designed for their purposes, some of our people are promoting what is probably the greatest sin of this generation in the name of brotherhood and Christianity.

Being unable or unwilling to see beneath their rhetoric, they promote programmes that would result in gradual disintegration of our culture and destruction of the race that produced it, according to the best evidence we have.

Elsewhere, from time to time, I have given reasons why integration of the races would be a calamity. The evidence and the reasons have not been answered. I think they cannot be.

Instead of considering the facts, those who support integration of whites and Negroes say that there are moral values that take precedence over biological facts and scientific argument. Beyond referring to the Golden Rule and asserting that segregation is un-Christian, they are vague about these moral values.

I do not deny that the race problem is a moral issue. On the contrary, I insist that it is a moral issue. To seek and accept the facts bearing on a problem is moral. To preach and promote conclusions and programmes on vital matters without seeking and evaluating the facts is immoral.

Intellectual dishonesty is really the fundamental immorality. Denial that the races are different is clearly intellectual dishonesty, no matter how you dress-up that denial in rhetoric.

In considering complex problems of human relations quoting the Golden Rule does not answer the question of what is the right or moral thing to do? The Golden Rule *raises* the question.

The answer is to be derived from the facts and the probable consequences. Impulsive action based on quick sympathy and goodness of heart, but ignoring the consequences, is neither wise nor moral. A loving but foolish mother might give unwholesome food to her child. A wise and loving mother would not.

"Do unto others as you would have them do to you" applies not only to the Negroes and white people. It applies also to our posterity. Does the Golden Rule call upon us to make racial hybrids of our posterity? Quite the contrary, in my judgment and, I expect, in yours.
