### THE RED MENACE EN THE NORTH

Current developments in Indonesia should be of the gravest concern to every Australian concerned about his nation's future. Communist influence in Indonesia has increased immeasurably and in the absence of any stronger opposition than that displayed up until the present; it can be expected to extend and to consolidate. One of the earliest Communist leaders described Indonesia as a bridge between Asia and Australia. That bridge is in process of passing under the control of the enemies of this country. This stark truth can no longer be disputed.

In tracing the progress of Communist development in Indonesia, it is essential to go back to just after the First World War when the Dollar Diplomats of Wall Street imposed the Washington Naval Agreement on both the British and the Japanese. C. H. Douglas's article. "The World After Washington," is essential reading for those who desire to understand the policies set in motion in the Pacific by the Washington Agreement. It was these policies, which were the start of the drive to end British—and other European influences—in the East and to pave the way for ultimate Communist expansion. The Japanese were the instruments to be used. Enough of the facts concerning Washington's pre-war policies concerning Japan have now been published to leave no doubt that Japan was manipulated into the second world war by the Roosevelt Administration, an Administration completely dominated by the Zionist financiers and the Communists.

The Japanese victories had a tremendous psychological impact right throughout Asia and prepared the way for the demand that the Europeans must go. The same forces, which brought Japan into war, ensured that it ended with the Communists well placed to take over China. The Korean War was ended on terms, which again were a tremendous blow to European prestige in Asia.

Right throughout the Pacific War the Roosevelt Administration worked to end all European control. The manner, in which the Dutch were prevented from reestablishing complete control in Indonesia after the Japanese defeat, has now been told. Although President Sukarno's pro-Communist record was known in Washington, he was aided in every possible way. Here in Australia Dr. Evatt as Attorney-General in the Chifley Government stood passively by and

allowed the Communist dominated waterside workers to take control of Australia's foreign policy and tie up Dutch ships.

Early this year Major General Charles A. Willoughby, former Chief of Intelligence for General Douglas MacArthur in the Far East, released a statement in which he stated that "Communist subversion in Washington induced the United States Government to champion Sukarno in his efforts to "liberate" the former Dutch republic, despite his previous role as one of Japan's chief wartime collaborators.... The United States fought the Pacific War precisely to stop Japanese expansion. Are they to capitulate to indirect infiltration to world Communism, aiming at the same strategic targets, that is, control of the Malay barrier."

General Willoughby went on to say that Sukarno had been in close touch with the Communist leaders in Indonesia. But this fact did not prevent the policy makers in Washington from giving Sukarno full support. When he visited America he was given very special treatment and there was no sign of opposition from the international financiers. Mr. Bernard Baruch, who is never backward in giving advice, certainly raised no objections. The only conclusion is that President Sukarno was acceptable to the most powerful men in the world.

In the past Australians have been able to take a detached view of the dollar diplomats helping the Communists in various parts of the world by breaking the British and other European forces, which retained Communist expansion. But the removal of the Dutch in Indonesia has now resulted in Communism on Australia's front door. Once the civil war in Indonesia has ended, it can be taken for granted that the

Dollar Aid For Communists: The American Secretary of State, Mr. John Foster Dulles, recently told a Senate Foreign Relations Committee that he strongly favoured continued dollar aid for both Communist Yugoslavia and Communist Poland. Mr. Dulles continues to support the myth that Yugoslavia was "zealously seeking to maintain its independence of Moscow."

However, Mr. Dulles did not reply entirely upon the alleged independence of Poland and Yugoslavia from Moscow to support his case for maintaining the present flow of dollar aid. In a prepared statement he warned that by cutting the Foreign Aid Bill there would be a further increase in American unemployment. He said that Foreign Aid was providing employment for 600,000 Americans who would lose their jobs if the programme were eliminated.

Mr. Dulles has now openly admitted what we have pointed out for years: dollar aid is one method by which American "surplus" production is exported. New dollar credits are made available for the big export drive. This is sheer robbery of the American individual, who if he had control of his own credit could obviously enjoy his present standard of living with greater leisure. But the controllers of financial policy have decreed that the American must be kept engaged in a programme of "full employment" making things which he does not require. And the dollar diplomats blatantly admit that it is preferable to give the "surplus" production to the Communists rather than modify American financial policies.

Apex Rejects Fluoridation: Although the daily press featured the decision of the recent National Convention of Apex Clubs to oppose the White Australia policy, it made little reference to the fact that the Convention rejected a motion advocating the use of fluorine in water supplies throughout Australia. It can be revealed that this result was primarily the result of activities of supporters of this journal and information supplied to delegates which again demonstrates that quality, not mere numbers, will defeat the enemies of freedom.

Attack On Immigration Policy: All those attacking Australia's present immigration policy, which is designed to preserve a homogeneous European nation, should be informed that they are supporting a Communist policy which was again given a high priority in the Communist programme agreed to at the recent Communist Party Congress.

Most of the "arguments" against the present immigration policy are based upon flabby sentimentalism. If, as the Apex Convention demanded, a quota of Asian migrants be allowed to come into Australia every year and be given full citizenship rights, it would not be long before there was a racial problem in Australia. A minority group possessing full voting rights, but without any real understanding of the British conception of Government and law, would automatically become the plaything of party politics.

Not one of the arguments used to break down the present immigration policy will stand a realistic examination. The parrot-cry that this policy is "anti-Christian" is an echo of the Communist philosophy that "all men are equal." Talk about "moral responsibility" is also false because it presumes that Asian countries are short of the material resources to improve their standards of living. These countries have greater resources than Australia.

The majority of Asians have never heard of the White Australia policy. The suggestion that this policy is offensive to educated Asians is just as nonsensical as to suggest that the claims of some Asians to be superior to Europeans are offensive to Australians.

School Board At Little Rock Requests Integration End: The latest news from Little Rock has been suppressed by the very press, which gave such a distorted and false picture of what has been happening in this American centre where integration was imposed at the point of the bayonet. At last the very school board that launched integration has decided that it will not work. It has asked a U.S. district court to end integration.

Citing incidents that happen "almost daily," the school board said: "The existing pupil unrest, teacher unrest and parent unrest... make it difficult... to maintain a satisfactory education programme."

The Little Rock school board has painfully discovered what other schools have discovered in the past. But the drive for integration will still go on. The Zionists and Communists will see to this.

**Dr. Evatt On The Hursey Case**: In a Meet-the-Press session in Melbourne on April 13, Dr. Evatt left no doubt that he is not concerned about the rights of the Hurseys in Hobart who are denied work on the waterfront because they refuse to pay a political levy to help finance Dr. Evatt's party. If the Hurseys were Communists there is no doubt that Dr. Evatt and people like Mr. Brian Fitzpatrick, of the Civil Liberties Movement, would be conducting nation-wide agitation.

Bernard Baruch Opposes Tax Reductions: Mr. Bernard Baruch, Zionist international financier, has publicly entered the controversy in America concerning what action should be taken to end the

the recession. Mr. Baruch is strongly opposed to any substantial tax reductions, which would immediately increase the purchasing power of the individual. When a man of Mr. Baruch's influence publicly states that tax reductions are not the best way in which to help increase the individual's money supply, it is proof positive that those who decide the financial policies of the West are just as Communistic in their outlook as the controllers of the Communist countries. Dr. Evatt And The Zionists: Dr. Evatt continues to maintain friendly relations with the Zionists. Last week he was the guest of honor at a reception given on the occasion of the tenth anniversary of the State of Israel by the Zionist Labor Organization of Australia. We again draw attention to the interesting fact that Dr. Evatt is highly regarded by both the Zionists and the Communists.

Cleric Urges Suicidal Policy: Those directing the international campaign to force another Summit Conference are being given powerful support by a large number of clergymen whose sincerity cannot be doubted, but who are completely divorced from reality. Pious platitudes are no substitute for a determination to face the truth about international power politics.

The Rev. A. Crichton Barr, speaking at Scots Church, Melbourne, on April 13, urged "America and Britain should explore with all sincerity and hopefulness Russia's new attitude to nuclear tests.... Cynicism and suspicion will get us nowhere. It is possible that Russia may be entirely sincere."

If Mr. Barr is in possession of any information suggesting that the Communist leaders have departed from their traditional doctrinal beliefs concerning Communism, we would suggest that he make it available as evidence that the Communist leaders may be sincere. But if he has no such evidence, he is engaging in mere wishful and dangerous thinking to suggest that the Communists have adopted a "new attitude" towards nuclear tests.

The Rev. Barr and his fellow clergymen should face the fact that Communism is a religion, not merely a set of economic theories. Every action taken by the Communists is a tactic designed to further a strategy, which never changes. Every Communist policy is firmly rooted in a specific philosophy. This philosophy, which postulates that the individual must be subordinated to the group, is accepted by people other than those who call themselves Communists. Some of them are Ministers of the Christian religion!

**Do 36 Jews Rule Jewish World?** Major Robert Williams, former American Counter Intelligence Officer, writes in the March issue of his *Intelligence Summary:* 

A single sentence near the end of a long, rambling column in the Los Angeles B'nai B'rith Messenger of October 25, 1957, is more thought provoking than many a book. The columnist, "Rabbi Charles W. Steckel, Ph.D., Temple Beth Israel, Sierra Madre, Calif." writes:

"According to Jewish tradition the universe, our world, survives because of the 36 righteous men (Lamed-Vovenic) who are hidden so that no one knows about them."

Rabbi Steckel added that he was "deeply convinced" that a certain Swedish Jew, Raoul Wallenberg, now dead, was one of them. Wallenberg may have been a Communist, as he was taken to the Soviet Union after the war and never was heard of again, till, ten years later, the Soviets said he had died in 1947.

Pope's Statement On "New Spring": There has been widespread speculation concerning the recent statement by His Holiness Pope Pius XII who said, "the springtime of history is not far off." Social Crediters, seeking an authoritative lead from the Christian Church on the question of purpose, will be particularly interested in the statement that "Man will be ever more free from material labor and from servile work." Unfortunately this statement was, from our point of view, qualified by the statement that "Automation is transforming the greater part of human labour into intellectual activity . . .. " If automation were designed to free men completely from industry, to provide them with leisure, intellectual activity would be outside industry. But freedom from physical labor does not mean real freedom if the individual is still compelled to become a narrow specialist in order to obtain a financial income. We still await an unqualified and clear statement from Church leaders on the true purpose of industry and production. However, the Pope's statement may indicate progress towards clarification of this question.

**Depression or Inflation?** Reports from the U.S.A. state that "There is more official worry over the chance that action taken by the Government may produce a

revival of active inflation, than there is fear that the downturn will result in spiralling deflation." This is further confirmation of the Social Credit analysis, which demonstrates that under present financial rules it is impossible to have credit expansion without inflation. And without expansion there is a slackening in industry and unemployment.

The present American recession undoubtedly has a purpose. One of the purposes is to try and persuade the American people that "controlled inflation" is preferable to recessions. There are, of course, other purposes, all designed to help drive the Americans towards the complete Slave State.

# Local Governments Challenge Federal Financial Monopoly

A conference of municipalities in the Deakin Federal Electorate has decided that all Victorian municipalities should be requested to take action on a Federal Electorate basis in order that candidates at the next Federal Elections may be asked to give written assurances that they will support the following policies:

The present balance of petrol tax monies now retained by Federal Government to be fully distributed to all States and Local Government on an equitable basis.

Payroll tax on Local Government to be abolished. Commonwealth to make ex gratia payments in lieu of rates on all Commonwealth properties.

Commonwealth to make direct grants, interest free, to Local Government via the States from loan and Central Credit funds. The Government to guarantee all loans permitted.

Local Government to seek representation at Loan Council.

Apart from representatives of municipalities at the conference, there was a large attendance of observers from ratepayer and progress associations who were given a chance to express themselves at the conclusion of the deliberations of the delegates. Several spoke strongly in support of the action initiated by the conference. One spokesman for a progress association said, "If we don't get results we should put our candidate in the field. Ratepayers were more concerned with what a candidate would do in his own town rather than what he would do at Canberra."

The conference also decided to send a report to Municipal Associations in other States, urging that they take similar action. The local press featured a report on the conference and Melbourne dailies also reported the resolutions carried. The A.B.C. was sufficiently interested to ask Cr. Eric Butler, one of the most forceful of the delegates at the conference, to make a statement for the A.B.C.'s news services. Already there has been a widespread reaction to the conference and it is possible that at a later date a State conference of all Victorian municipalities and ratepayers' organisations will be held. Cr. Butler supplied the conference with vital information concerning Federal Government finance.

If the action initiated by the Deakin conference can be repeated all over Australia, there is no doubt that the Federal Government, irrespective of its label, would be forced to capitulate. Supporters everywhere should immediately take this matter up with their Local Government representatives. We have obtained a supply of *The News*, Heidelberg, which featured a full report on the Deakin Conference, and these are available for supporters who can make use of them. demand for Dutch New Guinea will be taken up again stronger than ever. If the present Australian Government is to make a real contribution to the future security of this country, it will strongly oppose any suggestion of Dutch New Guinea passing under Indonesian control. It will reject any suggestion that the United Nations be allowed to influence the issue. It will in fact display a little of the backbone which has been sadly lacking up until now.

The internal position in Indonesia is not, as Mrs. R. G. Casey infers, merely an internal problem for the Indonesians to settle. It concerns the future of Australia and New Zealand. The policy makers in Washington allowed the Communists to win in China by maintaining that the struggle there was an internal issue to be solved by the Chinese themselves. We must not let history be repeated so much closer to home.
