THE DOUBLE-SPEAK OF DEAN RUSK

Upon his arrival in Australia last week, the American Secretary of State, Mr. Dean Rusk, told Australians that American foreign policy was designed to help protect Australia. Mr. Rusk may be capable of believing what he says, irrespective of whether his statements reflect reality or not. But thinking Australians would be much more assured by Mr. Rusk's statements if it were not for the fact that the American Secretary of State and his associates are openly working for the destruction of the British Commonwealth by attempting to force Britain into the European Common Market, and are supporting the Indonesian campaign on Dutch New Guinea. Support for this campaign is support for Communist strategy.

It is true, of course, that Mr. Rusk and his fellow policy-makers in the U.S.A. refuse to admit that they are assisting Communist strategy. Recently asked why he was supporting the Indonesians on the Dutch New Guinea issue, Mr. Rusk said that it was essential to support Dr. Soekarno in order to prevent Indonesia from being thrown into the arms of the Communists. Unless Mr. Rusk is an ignorant dupe of other people, he is engaging in a frightening example of double-speak. At the very time that he was explaining how Dr. Soekarno must be protected from the Communists, Indonesian representatives were on their way to Moscow to make further substantial purchases of Soviet military equipment, probably to be paid for by dollar credits supplied from the U.S.A. So far from accepting the view that he must be saved from the Communists Dr. Soekarno answered Mr. Rusk by shortly afterwards giving an address to an Indonesian Communist Party rally at which he praised the Communists in almost lyrical terms, particularly for their support on the West New Guinea issue.

We find it significant that Dr. Soekarno's address to the Communist rally did not receive any publicity in any Australian newspaper. The A.B.C. gave extensive extracts from Dr. Soekarno's address, and we would have thought that an address of such importance would have received headlines in the Australian press. But as most of the Australian press has been attempting to soften up Australian opinion to accept as "inevitable" the transfer of West New Guinea to the Indonesians, primarily because Mr. Rusk and his associates support this policy, it was no doubt considered embarrassing when Dr. Soekarno openly disclosed that so far from there being any risk of him being thrown into the arms, of the Communists, he was in fact arm in arm with the Communists already. As all honest students of the Indonesian situation have known of Dr. Soekarno's willingness to act as a tool of the Communists, it is impossible to believe that Mr. Rusk and his associates do not possess the truth about Soekarno.

Mr. Rusk has a long record in the art of double-speaking, a fact which Australians might carefully consider before they take at face value the recent promise that American policy makers will not tolerate aggression against Eastern New Guinea. In his last A.B.C. broadcast, Sir Raphael Cilento, the only commentator not afraid to present the truth, asked the question, "What constitutes aggression?" and pointedly recalled what has been happening in Laos. Mr. Rusk would claim to be a NATO ally of the Dutch and the Portuguese, but he has supported the policy of betraying the Portuguese in Africa—openly voting with the Soviet against Portugal on the Angola issue—and prevented the Dutch from flying reinforcements through the U.S.A. to help resist threatened Indonesian aggression against West New Guinea.

Mr. Rusk may claim that this action against the Dutch was necessary to prevent an increase of tension in the West New Guinea issue, but obviously it is all right for the Indonesians to obtain increased military assistance from Soviet Russia. The American Secretary of State has provided another example of double-speak with his urging of the resumption of talks between Indonesia and the Dutch. "We would regret it if this matter should break out into violence", said Mr. Rusk. But there has already been violence and the threat of violence, with the Indonesians acting as aggressors. What Mr. Rusk really means about no violence is that the Dutch should agree to get out of New Guinea and not resist the Indonesian demands. Mr. Rusk does not, of course, merely speak for himself when he supports Communist strategy, as he has done on several occasions; he speaks for the International Money Power, which has consistently used International Communism to create the situation in which the whole world can be driven towards complete Monopoly.

The British Commonwealth has been a barrier to world monopoly, and must therefore go. Mr. Rusk lost no time

N.Z. Prime Minister On New Guinea Issue: The New Zealand Prime Minister, Mr. Holyoake, clearly is rather old-fashioned. He has expressed his views on the West New Guinea issue in terms of principles. It is most refreshing to hear politicians talking in terms of principles in these advanced times when we are all urged to be "realists".

The New Zealand Prime Minister stated last week that his Government was very worried about the arms build-up in Indonesia, and that the people of West New Guinea should be given an opportunity to determine their own political future. He continued. "If we depart from that principle in this case, you never know what will happen elsewhere". As far as we can discover, the Queensland Liberal M.P., Mr. D. J. Killen, was the only member at Canberra to stress this principle of sovereignty and determination during the debates on the West New Guinea issue. It was significant that no Australian newspaper quoted Mr. Killen.

If it is conceded that Indonesia should be given West New Guinea today because it is "realistic" and "inevitable", then, as Mr. Holyoake suggests, the same concession may have to be made somewhere else tomorrow. It is the failure to enunciate and to support principle instead of cowardly expediency, which is permitting the enemies of Civilization one victory after another.

The New York "Times" Admission: The New York *Times* can always be relied upon to provide indications of the intentions of the world revolutionaries. The Melbourne *Herald* of May 4 quotes the following editorial comment from the New York *Times*: "The European economic community baulks at special privileges for the Commonwealth countries and the neutrals that would impair its Common Market or dilute its political goal. So does the United States".

Fluoridation Drive In Queensland: A recent Brisbane report states that the campaign to fluoridate water supplies in various parts of Queensland continues. A powerful campaign is under way in Townsville, where it is claimed that doctors and dentists are backing the campaign. By supporting the principle of mass dosing a whole community with a drug, the doctors are not only violating a fundamental medical ethic; they are actively participating in furthering the disease, which has all but destroyed the very basis of Civilization. Sir C. Stanton Hicks has recently directed attention to the treason of the medical profession on the fluoridation issue. But no one has even bothered to attempt to reply to him.

Queensland is supposed to be governed by a coalition Government of individuals who pay lip service to freedom and constitutional safeguards of individual rights. In fact they made an abortive attempt at one time to frame a State Bill of Rights. Queensland electors might suggest to their Government Members that they now have their

opportunity to show their sincerity on this question by taking action to prevent people from having mass medication imposed upon them.

Tito Is Agent Of International Communism: It was unfortunate that the R.S.L. in its first article on Communism repeated uncritically the widely accepted story that Tito broke with Moscow because he wanted to establish National Communism. Although the record does not reveal why Stalin attacked Tito, it is clear that Tito protested vigorously that he was a dedicated Marxist-Leninist and was loyal to the cause of International Communism.

If, as some authorities on Communism suggest, the "break" between Moscow and Tito was a deliberate dialectical move by the directors of International Communism to confuse and exploit the West, it has certainly paid big dividends to the Communist conspiracy everywhere. Huge dollar credits and other aid have been poured into Yugoslavia. And as an alleged neutral, Tito has been able to play an active role in all parts of the world aiding Communist strategy. It was not surprising therefore that the Soviet Foreign Minister, Mr. Gromyko, recently visited Tito, and that Tito sent Khrushchev a telegram of congratulations on his last birthday. The American policy makers, through the American Secretary of State, Mr. Dean Rusk, have been strenuously defending sending dollar aid to Tito, claiming that he is different from Castro.

But at the very time that Mr. Rusk was making his claims, there was direct evidence that Tito's representatives in the "United" Nations were most active on behalf of Cuba. The Assistant Secretary of State, Mr. Brooks Hays, has recently claimed that "Titoism" is a threat to International Communism, and that this justified the American Administration's policy of sending 135 jet fighter planes to Yugoslavia. Now if Mr. Hays had read what Khrushchev had to say about Yugoslavia, as reported in *Pravda* of October 19, 1961, he would have seen the Communist leader maintained that while "we have struggled and shall continue to struggle against the revisionists position" of the Communist leadership of Yugoslavia, "the Soviet Union stands for bringing together and consolidating all forces which are struggling against the imperialistic warmongers, for peace and friendship amongst the peoples".

On October 25 Tito responded by stating that there was no real split between Khrushchev and himself. The differences were "not so big". He then supported Khrushchev's demands on the Berlin issue.

Although we have long ceased to deny that there is plenty of stupidity in high places in the U.S.A. and other Western nations, it is impossible to believe that American dollar support for Tito is provided because the American Secretary of State and his assistant are merely stupid and do not understand the real role of Tito. All the evidence, and commonsense, points to a continuation

of that treachery which has handed victory after victory to the International Communist conspiracy.

Another Dialectical Move By Tito? It is significant that coinciding with the closer open association between Moscow and Tito, there should be mention of another book by Milovan Djilas, the former Vice-President of Yugoslavia, best known for his alleged exposure of Communism, *The New Class*, published in 1958. This book was avidly seized upon by Left-wing anti-Communist intellectuals, who uncritically accepted the story that Djilas had, at great personal risk, written this book while in prison and smuggled it out to the free world. As we pointed out at the time, *The New Class* is not an attack upon Communism: it is a plea for a more effective method of advancing Communism.

Now comes a book by Djilas entitled *Conversations With Stalin*. This book claims to reveal that Tito was proposing in 1948 to take over Albania by armed force, and that this plan first had the support of Stalin. The American publisher of the book has postponed the publication of the book, allegedly to prevent Djilas from being endangered by Tito at a time when Tito is negotiating with Moscow. All the evidence indicates another campaign to assist the psychological disarmament of the West.

More Evidence Of Roosevelt's Pro-Communism: The Roosevelt myth, still carefully nourished by the Liberal-Internationalists, has received a further shock with the publication of *The Cardinal Spellman Story*, by Father Robert I. Gannon, S.J. As Military Vicar during the war, Cardinal Spellman was intimately associated with Roosevelt. His diary reveals that one evening after they were sitting around in the White House, Roosevelt told Cardinal Spellman that the Pope was too worried about Communism, and went on to say, "Russia has need of protection. She has been invaded twice, you know. That is why we shall give her part of Poland and recompense Poland with a part of Germany." Cardinal Spellman's protest that it was "immoral to uproot people like that" had no effect upon Roosevelt.

Roosevelt made it clear that he took it as inevitable that Russia would take control of part of Europe. "The magnificent economic achievement" of the Soviet could not be overlooked. He hoped that in ten to twenty years European influences would bring the Russians to be less barbarian. He hoped finally that the Europeans would live well together with the Russians, that the Russians would get 40 percent of the capitalist regime and that the capitalists will retain only 60 percent of their system. Apparently he was repeating the opinion of the Communist leader Litvinoff.

One of the smears directed against the John Birch Society is that Robert Welch claimed that President Roosevelt was a card-carrying member of the Communist Party. The inference is that anyone who suggests that the American President could be a Communist is mentally unbalanced. There is no evidence that Roosevelt was a Communist, but even if he were, he could not have been

much more successful in aiding Communist strategy. There is one final thought we express: As Roosevelt was the darling of the international financial groups represented by his friend Bernard Baruch, and as these groups knew Roosevelt intimately, it is certain that Roosevelt's pro-Communist policies had their blessing.

Traitors Still Being Recruited: Truth is stranger than fiction, and much more alarming, concerning the Communist recruiting of traitors in the non-Communist countries. In his recently published book, *School For Spies*, former Czech Communist leader, J. Bernard Hutton, claims to present detailed information of the training of Communist spies in Russia and how they recruit traitors in the Western world. The latest case of a member of a Western nation providing the Communists with valuable military information, that of U.S. Air Force captain Joseph P. Kaufmann, sentenced to 20 years' hard labour for having provided East Germany with military secrets, provides a classic example of Hutton's claims.

TRAINING AN AUSTRALIAN COMMUNIST IN CZECHOSLOVAKIA

Czechoslovak Life is a typical example of the large number of beautifully produced pictorial magazines, which the Communists of every country use to flood the whole non-Communist world with their propaganda. These magazines are most appealing and are undoubtedly read and looked at by large numbers of people who are not Communists. There is little direct Communist propaganda. Most of the photos of people show them happy and laughing. All these magazines are produced in a number of different languages. *Czechoslovak Life* is published in English, French, Swedish and Italian.

There is much of interest for the educated and cultured in the January 1962, issue of *Czechoslovak Life*. But there is also a most significant article by Kevin Hartshorne, an Australian who has been in Czechoslovakia for two years studying economics and education. Mr. Hartshorne tells in his article of his experiences he had for two weeks on a collective farm. It is full of clever propaganda in favour of Socialism. If Mr. Hartshorne is to be believed, even the former private farmers are happier working on collective farms. But he makes no reference to the fact that Czech farmers were forced into collectivisation and received no compensation for their properties.

As Mr. Hartshorne will presumably return to Australia in the future, the question arises as to why he went to Czechoslovakia unless he proposes to become a well-equipped Australian Communist leader. It would be interesting to know who paid for his trip to Czechoslovakia and who is paying him while he studies in a Communist country. The answer is obvious. And the Communists do not invest money and effort on those whom they do not think will serve them faithfully. Kevin Hartshorne is being trained to be a traitor to his own country.

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after arriving at Canberra last week, to make it clear that American policy was strongly opposed to the granting of special terms for the sale of Australian produce in the European Common Market. This statement should remove any lingering doubts about the truth that the driving force for "integration" in Europe comes from the policy makers in the U.S.A.

Needless to say, Mr. Rusk does not openly admit his role in the persistent attack upon the British Commonwealth. In fact he has demonstrated his complete mastery of the art of double-speak with his statement that "We have full confidence that the Commonwealth will continue its constructive role in world affairs". Having closely studied Mr. Rusk's career, we have no confidence whatever in anything he says. If the British Commonwealth is to retain what independence it still possesses, it is high time that action was taken to make it clear to Mr. Rusk and the groups he represents, that the British peoples do not propose to accept policies of destruction. If this is done, the loudest cheers will come from those patriotic Americans who are also sick to death of being persistently betrayed by men who attempt to mask their treacherous policies by the use of double-speak.

INTEGRATION AND CRIME IN WASHINGTON

We republish without comment the following item from *The U.S. News & World Report* of April 2:

In Washington, where 54 percent of the population are Negroes, police records show that 87 percent of those arrested for robbery last year were Negroes, and 75 percent of the prisoners in Washington's correctional institutions are Negroes.

Racial hostility was described by one city official as a factor in Washington crime. This was said by Donald Clemmer, director of corrections.

Addressing a meeting of sociologists, Mr. Clemmer said that "Washington is not a syndicated, racket-type city" and that only a small number of crimes here are committed by professional criminals.

Noting the unusually high incidence of aggravated assaults here, he said amateur criminals are more likely to use unnecessary violence than the smooth-working professionals. He suggested that some of the pointless violence that marks Washington robberies could be traced to "Negro hostility toward whites".

This hostility, Mr. Clemmer observed, has grown out of a feeling of "new-found freedom" among Negro youths as a result of sociological changes due to federal-court rulings against segregation and to the emergence of many African areas as independent nations.

Mr. Clemmer predicted that Washington crime is likely to get worse, instead of better, until this hostility declines.

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U.N.O. And Australia's Aborigines: We have warned previously that Australia could not expect to remain immune to the revolutionary influences working through the "United" Nations, and that the Australian aborigines would be used as an instrument to attack Australia. In an A.B.C. talk on January 11, Sir Raphael Cilento, former top official with the "United" Nations, drew attention to this question, when he said that in 1951 it had been reported that there was to be an attack upon Australia's control of Eastern New Guinea. It was suggested that this attack should be made by seeking an enquiry into Australia's treatment of its own aborigines. If Australia refused an investigation, this would be used as an excuse for claiming that Australia was unfit to govern any other race.

Events are moving rapidly to Australia's North, and no sooner have the first steps been taken through the "United" Nations to hand control of West New Guinea to Indonesia, than the pressures on Eastern New Guinea will be intensified.
