THE RACE FACTOR IN THE WORLD REVOLUTION

C. H. Douglas once observed that sympathy for the underdog was being deliberately exploited to produce a world of permanent underdogs. Some of the early Socialists were genuine emancipationists, but when the promoters or world revolution took control of the Socialist movements, it soon became clear that the proletarians of the industrial world were to be used as a tool of destruction. They were inflamed against those who were more secure economically, and their hatred directed against the very foundations of traditional society. This is what the "class-struggle" is about: to destroy all those who alone can help their less fortunate fellows to rise.

The worldwide revolution has now reached the stage where the less advanced races of the world are being used as raw material to deliver another major blow to the Western Civilization already reeling on its foundations. The complete collapse of this Civilization would deprive the less advanced peoples of the world of their only hope of improving their lot. It is important at this critical time to remove the fog of carefully fostered emotionalism concerning the race issue, and to show how those promoting racial disorders everywhere are not interested in helping the underdog up the scale of Civilization, but only in using him for purposes which he does not understand.

A CLOSELY-KNIT STRATEGY

There is a close relationship between the mounting campaign against South Africa, the pressure being exerted on the Field Government in Southern Rhodesia, the sudden upsurge of violent "nationalism" in French-Canada, and the massed Negro activities now convulsing the United States of America. President John Kennedy may be completely ignorant of Communist strategy for using the American Negro for revolutionary purposes, but he must be judged guilty of ruthlessly exploiting the current Communist-inspired activities to force through one of the most far-reaching pieces of legislation ever presented in the U.S.A. This legislation, if passed, would not only drive a further wedge into the crumbling constitutional safeguards of State rights, but would seriously interfere with private property rights. And its total effect would be to intensify the revolutionary forces now operating openly in the U.S.A.

COMMUNISTS EXPLOIT NEGROES

Communist interest in the American Negro as an instrument of revolution was outlined clearly in the early twenties. In 1925 the Communist Party in the U.S.A. issued the following instructions to its members:

"The aim of our party in our work among the Negro masses is to create a powerful proletarian movement which will fight and lead the struggle of the Negro race against exploitation and oppression in every form and which will be a militant part of the revolutionary movement of the whole American working class, to strengthen the American revolutionary movement by bringing into it the . . . Negro workers and farmers in

the United States to broaden the struggle of the National minorities and colonial peoples of the entire world and thereby further the cause of the world revolution and the dictatorship of the proletariat."

In his book, *Color, Communism and Common Sense'* Mr. Manning Johnson, the Negro who spent ten years serving the Communist conspiracy in the U.S.A., reveals how the Communists work amongst the American Negroes. Johnson's story provides detailed evidence of how the Communists cynically prepared for the bitterness and chaos, which they knew would come out of any attempt at forced integration. Johnson's book was first published in 1958, and subsequent events in the U.S.A. have confirmed the author's warnings. Unfortunately Johnson was killed in a fatal accident before he could shed more light on what

was happening amongst American Negroes.

There is a wealth of carefully documented evidence showing that the influential National Association for the Advancement of Coloured Peoples is a Communist-front organisation dominated by men like its President, Arthur B. Spingarn, who are not even Negroes. The press of the world is carrying reports about developments in the U.S.A., which are just as untrue as much of the reporting from South Africa. When one Negro is shot this is featured in the world's press headlines, but there is little publicity given to the killing of whites by Negroes, the stabbing of police who merely attempt to keep law and order when rioting is provoked, and the terrorisation of the moderate Negroes who are opposed to agitation and forced integration.

The real purpose of the nation-wide campaign of agitation in the U.S.A. may be judged by the fact that in the Northern States, where there is no official segregation, but a great amount of what can only be described as natural segregation, the agitators are demanding that Negro parents who send their children to all-Negro schools must now be prepared to support their demands that their children be picked up in buses and distributed around amongst the all-white schools. The Negro parents are attempting to act as parents first, and Negroes second, by insisting that their children not be used as mere raw material to further an agitation campaign.

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WHAT IS THE STATE OF BRITAIN TODAY?

I must start this survey by disclaiming to have any special "inside" information concerning the famous Profumo case. Before I left London on June 15, I had, of course, heard most of the rumours, some of them so obviously absurd that one could only wonder whether the undoubted fact that there was immorality and perversion in high places, was being deliberately exaggerated as part of a campaign of psychological warfare against the British people. However, there is no doubt that a really deep probe into the state of the British nation at the top would reveal a most alarming state of affairs. While I have a very great respect for Lord Denning, I doubt whether his investigation will do much more than scratch the surface of the real rot.

I do not subscribe to the view that this real rot in Britain has been revealed by the disclosure that a Minister had had a sordid affair with a highly paid prostitute. A number of British Prime Ministers have been adulterers, and no one who is a realist about human nature will believe that Mr. Jack Profumo is the last British Minister who will be guilty of sexual looseness. Nevertheless, I found it a most healthy sign that the majority of British people, particularly the middle-class, have made it very clear that they expect high personal standards from those entrusted with high office. And, of course, the British people have been outraged by the fact that Profumo could stand up and lie in such a brazen fashion in the House of Commons.

PROFUMO CASE OBSCURES DEEPER ISSUES

Unfortunately, however, the Profumo case has obscured the fact that growing numbers of the British people, particularly those who have in the past supported the Conservative Party, were becoming outraged by the policies of the Macmillan Government long before the Profumo case became front-page news. Although the general consensus of opinion is that the Profumo case has finished Macmillan. I do not discount the possibility of this politician surviving as a result of a shrewdness, ruthlessness, and toughness without many parallels in British political history. Mr. Macmillan and his colleagues find it essential to deplore the dishonesty of Mr. Profumo, although it is significant that Mr. Ian Macleod has since referred to Mr. Profumo as a friend, but the same men have been guilty of the very dishonesty which Mr. Macmillan, that great actor, said had wounded him deeply. Those who know the real Harold Macmillan were not impressed with the tear-dabbing act in the House of Commons.

Even if it were proved that the former Minister for War had made available secret information to the famous Miss Keeler which then reached the Communists, his betrayal of his country's interests would pale into insignificance compared with the betrayal proposed by his leader, Harold Macmillan, on the Common Market issue. Macmillan not only proposed the complete betrayal of Britain, and the British Commonwealth, but he and his principal architects of betrayal, Edward Heath and Duncan Sandys, have persistently attempted to mislead the British peoples. There has been clever double-talk and, in some cases, downright lying. Sir Roy Welensky spoke the truth when he said that Macmillan and his colleagues were dishonest, and prepared to betray their own fellow-British in Africa.

When I was in Britain last year it was clear to me that

the majority of people were concerned about the farreaching implications of the Common Market. But this year I could see that, while the Common Market issue was no longer being as fiercely discussed and debated as last year, there had been a considerable deepening of opposition to the Government, primarily because of its betrayal of traditional Conservative policies. The attitude of rank and file Conservative Party supporters was made clear to me at a number of gatherings I addressed. After an address to a Conservative Party gathering — described by the local morning paper as a "blistering attack" upon the Conservative Government's policies - - I found that even amongst these more active Party supporters, the overwhelming majority agreed generally with what I had to say. The truth is that, in spite of the growing stimulus to the British economy by the more liberal credit policy of Mr. Reginald Maudling who took the place of Mr. Selwyn Lloyd as Chancellor of the Exchequer, and the widespread fear of Mr. Harold Wilson, the Conservative Government was still losing ground electorally before the Profumo affair exploded.

LABOR VICTORY NOT INEVITABLE

I do not subscribe to the general view that it is now inevitable that the Labor Party under Mr. Wilson will win the next British Elections. Much of the shift of electoral support to Labor is not because of any positive attitude towards Labor, but reluctant support by those who cannot bring themselves to vote for a Conservative Government pursuing anti-conservative policies. I heard many express the view that they were prepared to risk Harold Wilson's nationalisation threat rather than provide the present Government with any endorsement to destroy British sovereignty completely. If the Conservative Party can produce new leaders, men who have not been identified with the proposed Common Market betrayal, and who will make it clear that they stand for a strong, independent Britain and British Commonwealth. I have no doubt whatever that there would be a big shift in electoral support back to the Conservatives. This shift, and the fears stemming from the extremist statements by Mr. Wilson from time to time, could see a Conservative Government re-elected, even if only with a small majority. But the decisive question is whether the Conservative Party can purge itself in time.

THE ANTI-COMMON MARKET LEAGUE

Although some of my colleagues in Britain deplore what they consider to be the deficiencies of Mr. John Paul's Anti-Common Market League, I regard Mr. Paul and his League as one of the most significant and encouraging features of the British scene today. Whatever developments take place in the future, Mr. John Paul's movement has until now been the spearhead of opposition to the Common Market in Britain. In saying this I am not in any way decrying the vital contributions made by other organisations, groups, and individuals. In spite of the immediate drop in deep interest following the veto of de Gaulle to Britain's Common Market application, Mr. John Paul has maintained his vigorous organisation and continues to make an extremely valuable contribution to a battle, which is of the greatest concern to every other part of the British Commonwealth. While I am well aware that it can only be a smaller part of the real battle which has still to be fought. I have supported the proposal that a special effort be made at the next British elections, to defeat if possible at least one or two of the leading traitors. If first-class candidates can be found to stand to genuine Conservatives against men like Macmillan. Heath, Sandys and Thorneycroft, these candidates might well draw off sufficient Conservative support to inflict one or two casualties upon these leading traitors. This would be a lesson to others. I am well aware that a superficial examination of the big majorities gained by these traitors at the last elections might suggest that it is an impossible task to topple any one of them. But competent observers do not agree with this, pointing out that Edward Heath, for example, would now be vulnerable if a good Independent Conservative candidate stood against him.

THE ELECTORS' VETO

However, regular readers of this journal do not need to be told that I realise that the real battle must be fought around the question of whether individual electors can be encouraged to use their vote as a sanction to force the type of policy they require, or, to veto policies they oppose. The idea of the Electors' Veto was advanced by Mr. John Mitchell some years back when he was running the Christian Campaign for Freedom in Britain. The Veto principle was specifically applied in the famous Andover fluoridation battle, when over a period the ratepayers used their votes to dismiss sufficient Councillors to have fluoridation halted. Perhaps I should interrupt myself here to say that one of the reasons I have no hesitation in saying that there are still great moral reserves in the British people, and that they are still a major factor in the world drama, is the stubborn resistance to a totalitarian policy like fluoridation which the individual can see *directly* affects his freedom and rights. The British resistance, at the local level of politics, is a most encouraging sign of health. It is, for example, in marked contrast with the general attitude in Ireland, where there is widespread apathy concerning the Government's insistence that all the public water of the Republic will be fluoridated.

FORCES OF PERSISTENCE

Housewives Today, that excellent little monthly produced by Mrs. Beatrice Palmer, whose untiring work over years has been an inspiration to many in Britain, has issued in brochure form the articles on *The Uncommon Community* by Mrs. Elizabeth Dobbs. Mrs. Dobbs develops the principle of the Electors' Veto. I was pleased to be at a London Conference where this idea was considered as a practical line of action after I had reported on my mission to Britain and what had been done and accomplished to date. The result was the establishment of a group, under the direction of Mr. John Mitchell, to conduct some experimental fieldwork to see how far the Electors' Veto might be developed to practical national politics. Those who place their faith in the Big Battalions may at this stage dismiss this move as "unrealistic", etc. But the idea has the seeds of the organic development of something, which can change the course of British history. There are many stirrings in Britain today, and it was stimulating for me to be provided with first hand evidence of many of the most significant and hopeful developments.

The British Housewives continue their excellent work, while in the North that bonnie fighter, Mrs. Elizabeth Pattulo, leads the Scottish Housewives in their persistent work. Mr. Edward Holloway, whom I interviewed on tape just after his return from advising in Southern Rhodesia, continues his non-stop programme of lectures on the Commonwealth. I met dozens of other influential individuals, all working in different spheres, but I must make special mention of Mr. Derek Tozer, M.A., publisher of *Intelli*gence. Britain is far from finished when it can continue to produce men of the calibre of Derek Tozer. Penalised at Cambridge because of his activities, the father of a young family, possessing no financial reserves, he has battled away to establish single-handed his little monthly publication. After a period of issuing it in roneoed form, he has obtained sufficient increase in support to justify risking the outlay of a comparatively large sum to put in his own off-set printing press. He is expanding his work and influence, and has now started to introduce some of my books into Britain. I salute his courage and wish him well in the grim days ahead.

GREATER CONCERN ABOUT COMMUNISM

Many students of International Communism have felt for some time that the British were "soft" on this issue; that they were either too mentally weary following the war, or were so tolerant that they did not see the reality of the Communist challenge. But a big change is coming. In recent years several well-established organisations have started to deal with the Communist question. I met and conferred with members of these organisations and made arrangements for closer liaison. I was able to show that much of the material being produced was rather superficial. My advice was sought on some of the more subtle aspects. I was also invited to meet representatives of newer groups, which have come into existence to make a contribution. Lack of basic knowledge is the main problem these groups have to overcome. However, there is a growing upsurge of interest as a result of the Vassal and other cases, and now the Profumo case, which are causing attention to the question of subversion, sex per-

Continued from Page 3 version and blackmail in high places. All this has convinced me further of the great strength still left in the Britain of 1963.

"PURGE OURSELVES OF THIS ROT"

Two of the most enjoyable days of my campaign in Britain were spent in the North of England with a man I had met for the first time last year. He and his wife warmly welcomed Mrs. Butler and me into their home. He provided me with the opportunity of speaking to a group of leading businessmen at Newcastle. He had been shocked by the Common Market. And now came the Profumo case. This was the last straw. His family had supported the Conservative Party for as far back as he could remember. But he had reached the end. "Whatever comes out of this Profumo affair," he said, just before we left him, "let the full story be told. Never mind how bad it is. Let us purge ourselves of this rot which has been undermining us for so long." "Let us purge ourselves of this rot!" That is, I believe, the mood of the best of the British people today. And this is the mood, which could lead to the British people astonishing the world, as they did in 1940, and have done on other famous occasions. I still have great faith in my kith and kin of the British Isles.

EDITORIAL

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We are informed by mature students of the Communist conspiracy in the U.S.A. that the rapid intensification of the revolutionary programme in the U.S.A. suggests that this has been achieved primarily to fit in with Communist strategy throughout the rest of the world, and could indicate that the promoters of the worldwide conspiracy now believe they are rapidly approaching a new major phase in their strategy. If this is so, then we can anticipate more and more violence right around the world.

CASTRO AND QUEBEC

It is not without significance that Canada has become seriously affected by the sudden upsurge of "nationalism" in Quebec at a time when race is being more vigorously exploited in the U.S.A. Irrefutable evidence has been produced to show that Communists have been associated with the recent outbreaks of violence in Quebec. Not that all the separatists of French-Canada are Communists, or even Communist sympathisers. But the Communists are shrewdly exploiting many of the French-Canadian intellectuals, the same intellectuals who warmly supported Castro because they felt he was driving out their American economic masters. They want to do the same to the English-speaking people in Quebec. The Communists understand all this, and they follow the tactics laid down so long ago concerning the exploitation of people who feel they are being exploited by another race. It is hoped to drive a wedge between the French-Canadians and the English-Canadians. There is a wealth of evidence showing the relationship between Castro's Government and developments in Quebec. Tension is to be built up between the French and English-speaking Canadians. Early this year the Liberal Premier Lesage of Quebec made the ominous declaration that the Canadian Contederation might be facing its last hour.

It could be that the whole civilized world is facing its last hour. The promoters of world revolution are at present driving forward everywhere. The West is retreating steadily against the pressures being exerted everywhere by the generating and exploiting of racialism. The strategy has been so successful that those resisting it are the ones labelled as racists. Never before was clearer thinking necessary on the race and "colonial" questions. And never before was there a greater need for the dissemination of the facts we publish.
