EASTER REFLECTIONS: Fear is the absence of Faith. The fact that fear is so widespread today reflects the widespread lack of Faith. There has been over the years a progressive dilution of an understanding of that Faith upon which Christian Civilisation was established. Christ said that He had come that the individual might enjoy freedom and the life more abundant. Truth was the road to true freedom and He represented Truth. Truth could even survive physical death. But Christ also said that His Authority was derived from God the Father. Truth will not be discovered by counting heads in elections. The mob voted overwhelmingly against Christ whose Pharisaical enemies thought they had been victorious. But the Resurrection demonstrated that Truth, reflecting Authority, cannot be destroyed by the "majority vote", or any other type of vote.

Once again Truth is being challenged by the insistence that the counting of heads is the ultimate in deciding the fate of the individual. An old heresy, dressed in a new garment, has emerged in the form of what is known as "the Sovereignty of Parliament."

This means that once one set of politicians have manipulated enough confused and brainwashed electors to vote them in to office, they

are then free to do as they like for the next few years. Evolved in a climate of opinion created by the Christian Church, the British system of government was Trinitarian, one in which there was balance, the checks and balances ensuring that there was not an excessive centralisation of power. But over and beyond all this was the concept that the individual's rights and freedoms were derived from God, not from any human association irrespective of its name. The growth of English Common Law was rooted in the Christian concept that every individual, irrespective of position, was of value and should be treated accordingly.

The Common Law was not established counting heads. It evolved to uphold Absolutes. One of the early defenders of the Common Law, the great Edward Coke, warned that while an elected Parliament was essential for a society of free men, if parliament becomes all-powerful, then it could become another threat to the individual's God given rights. These matters should be pondered on at a time when secular humanists are attempting to tear the Federal Constitution from its Christian roots. Christian action is then required by men and women of that Faith which can overcome Death itself.

Let us call a spade a spade, shall we? Politicians, being politicians are all about staying in power, with their snouts rammed deep into the goodie-box.

Ethnics have votes, and politicians don't want to lose votes: so butter up the ethnics. Simple! Labor Star is the journal of the Australian Labor Party (Victorian Branch). Brother Paul Keating addressed the Victorian Branch of the Australian Fabian Society on 11th November last (1987).

This is an interesting comment by Paul Keating: it discloses just how convinced Fabians and Laborites think. It is madness, of course; the Governor-General of the day, Sir John Kerr, was certainly appointed to do a job, and he did that job. He wasn't Whitlam's whippersnapper.

We have insisted, repeatedly, in these pages, that the Governor-General acted constitutionally (there was no "Constitutional" crisis at all!) in dismissing a Government which could not govern, and referring the whole issue to the ultimate source of all political power, the Australian people. Whitlam and his gang were HURLED from office by outraged electors. The Fabians deny this: they are mad. We learn from Brother Keating that ... "At the heart of these principles has always been the Labor movement's base objective, namely the protection and enhancement of the living standards of ordinary Australians." Now, is that so?

The reality is that the living standards of ordinary Australians are steadily falling due to punitive taxation and inflation (which can be accurately described as a concealed taxation.)

We admit to being mystified by the claims by Messrs. Hawke and Keating that they have produced so many jobs; Mr. Keating says an increase of 14% in his Fabian Society address. Well, unemployment has been hovering around 8% for years - it is still around 8% - so where is that 14%? We recall the observation of Disraeli, viz.

"There are 3 kinds of lies; lies, damned lies, and statistics." Obviously what Lord Disraeli meant is that statistics can be "bent" to mean anything.

Well, what about ... "especially after the falls in stock markets around the world, economic security for current and future generations can only come from maintaining the momentum of change.... Change to what? Change to Fabian Socialist, One-World policies! Paul Keating described the loss of much of the traditional Labor vote in this address to the Victorian Branch of the Fabian Society on November 11th., 1987; meaning the loss of same at the Federal election in July, 1987. We wonder what the Fabian Brother is saying NOW, after the results of the N;S;W, State elections, and the two South Australian by-elections in Adelaide. All these showed massive swings against "Labor".

We don't really think that the issues of Mick Young, campaign funds, scams, etc. are really responsible for the present rejection of "Labor" at the polls. What about the Bill of Rights? What about the I,D, Card? What about the fringe benefits tax? Are the "traditional" Labor voters waking up that this Hawke-Keating mob don't represent them at all; and that they are hand-in-glove with the International Financiers and One-Worlders? Yes, we do think so.

Have increasing numbers of Australian electors woken up to the fact that our politicians are not representing the will of their electorates on such issues as Asian immigration? Yes, the increasing numbers of electors abstaining from voting altogether strongly suggest this. When something like 15% of electors refrain from voting, in spite of our utterly ridiculous compulsory voting (fines for not voting) - then we can be sure that apathy, apathy derived from loss of confidence in, and distrust of, politicians - is rife. Meaning ALL parties.

We are on the verge of the greatest opportunity for genuine advance the League has ever had. We are winning! The Enemy is being forced into errors of judgement which we can exploit. If we can get the Initiative and Referendum written into the Australian Constitution we shall have a powerful base, as never before, to launch massive counter-attacks against the political subversives, the One-Worlders, the International Finance Moguls. AND THEY KNOW IT.
