seven parties that won parliamentary seats, in an effort to find agreement after the May 6 elections produced an inconclusive vote.

CALLS FOR COW WIND RESEARCH TO 'GET A REALITY CHECK': Mount Isa MP and State Leader of Katter's Australian Party, Rob Katter, has called on the six Australian universities who have embarked on a research investigation dubbed the Livestock Methane Research Cluster to get a reality check.

The newly established research unit which also includes scientists from Canada and the CSIRO has been met with strong criticism from Mr. Katter who initially thought the article had been misplaced

from the comic section in the newspaper. "It's a cluster alright and this sort of research into stupidity will tarnish the good name Australians have for themselves on the international stage," Mr. Katter stated.

"We have Australians dying out there from diseases that can be cured given the necessary resources and when this sort of stupidity takes precedence it's enough to take the wind out of every decent Australian – and that will give the scientists something to measure," Mr. Katter said. "It's pretty clear this is simply heading towards the introduction of another tax and it's high time the ALP and LNP drew a line in the sand and supported Katter's Australian Party on its stance."

The research unit's prime objective states that it will measure and manage methane emissions from livestock. "If they truly want to come to a conclusion on how to manage mother nature then I suggest they write in their report that livestock must cease to reproduce which will save them all a hell of a lot of time and money which could be spent on researching something serious," Mr. Katter said.

A GENE FOR GENIUS? by Brian Simpson: Scientists believe they have found a single gene linked to intelligence, according to research published in *Nature Genetics* recently. The gene is called HMGA2 and has only a small measureable effect on IQ. Previously it was thought that many hundreds of genes contributed to intelligence and this I believe is still true given that the effects of HMGA2 are only small and that a brain requires many genes to function.

The genetic study was conducted by a network called ENIGMA, which, by pooling resources was able to study the relationship between 21,151 MRI brain scans and genetic data. The environmentalist position gets weaker by the day.

MONSANTO BUYS LEADING BEE RESEARCH FIRM AFTER 'BEE'...ING IMPLICATED IN COLONY COLLAPSE by Jonathan Benson (NaturalNews). Amid all the controversy over genetically-modified (GM) crops and their pesticides and herbicides decimating bee populations all around the world, biotechnology behemoth Monsanto has decided to buy out one of the major international firms devoted to studying and protecting bees. According to a company announcement, Beeologics handed over the reins to Monsanto back on September 28, 2011, which means the gene-manipulating giant will now be able to control the flow of information and products coming from Beeologics for colony collapse disorder (CCD).

Since 2007, Beeologics has been studying CCD, as well as Israeli Acute Paralysis Virus (IAPV), for the purpose of coming up with intervention-based ways to mitigate these conditions. And based on the way the company describes both CCD and IAPV on its website, Beeologics has largely taken the approach that intervention, rather than prevention, is the key to solving the global bee crisis.

Now that Beeologics is owned and controlled by Monsanto, the company is sure to completely avoid dealing with the true causes of CCD and IAPV as they pertain to Monsanto's crop technologies — GMOs and their chemical counterparts. So going into the future, it seems expected that Beeologics will come up with "scientific breakthroughs" that deny any link between CCD and GMO technologies, and instead blame mystery pathogens and other factors that require more chemicals to eliminate.

According to Anthony Gucciardi at *Activist Post*, Beeologics has also long had a cozy relationship with the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), which is convenient for Monsanto. The USDA, in fact, considers Beeologics to be one of the foremost bee research organizations in the world, as does the USDA's Agricultural Research Service (ARS), the mainstream media and "leading entomologists" worldwide, according to the company.

Monsanto to use Beeologics' 'biological tools' to develop more GMOs, crop chemicals: Beeologics' acquisition announcement explains that Monsanto plans to incorporate all the biological research that Beeologics has conducted over the years into its own programs for developing more GMO systems. Monsanto has also seized control of a key product that is currently in the Beeologics development pipeline that supposedly "help[s] protect bee health."

"Monsanto will use the base technology from Beeologics as a part of its continuing discovery and development pipeline," says the announcement. "Biological products will continue to play an increasingly important role in supporting the sustainability of many agricultural systems." To translate, it appears as though Monsanto plans to use even more chemical inputs to supposedly solve the bee collapse problem, even though it is these very inputs that are largely the cause of the bee collapse problem. Several recent studies, after all, have definitively linked crop pesticides and herbicides, as well as high fructose corn syrup, to CCD.

The future looks bleak for bees, in other words, as Monsanto appears poised to slowly gobble up all the competing companies and organizations that threaten its own GMO products, while pretending to care about the dwindling bee populations. And unless drastic action is taken to stop Monsanto in its continued quest to dominate global agriculture, the food supply as we know it will soon be a thing of the past. *Source:* http://www.beeologics.com/breaking_news.asp

ISRAEL: PRACTISING A CRUEL APARTHEID OR JUST DEFENDING ITSELF? by Joseph Jones: Political correctness has gone so far now that even Israel is criticised for "apartheid". Thus "Living Under the Cloud of Israel's Cruel Apartheid" *The Weekend Australian* 5-6- May 2012, p.13 takes the case of an Israeli citizen who is married to a Palestinian from the West Bank. FIRE SALE ON GM CANOLA SEEDS IN AUSTRALIA from Gene Ethics: "... and why the EU wants our GM-free variety. 'Farmers and shoppers reject Monsanto's herbicide tolerant genetically manipulated (GM) canola so emphatically that the company now gives away GM canola seed in a desperate bid for farmers to grow it. In N.S.W. the Monsanto promises to limit direct farmer losses to only \$10/tonne and in W.A. it offers a one for three freebie to sweeten its deal.

Read consumer affairs reporter Natasha Bit's report in *The Australian*, 23 April, 2012. "Monsanto props up weak GM crop price", by Natasha Bit. "Global grain buyers are marking down the price of Australia's genetically modified canola as the European market shuts the gate on GM crops. The Australian Wheat Board is offering to buy up supplies of GM canola at guaranteed prices.

Gene Ethics director Bob Phelps says: "Monsanto's W.A. advertisement does not even disclose that its offer is for free GM seed, describing it as an offer for FREE BAGS of hybrid canola seed. This misleading description should also interest the ACCC which seeks to prevent deceptive ads.

"The Terms and Conditions of the one for three offer attached to this email include: 'Free bag only applies to the seed component supplied by Canola Breeders and does not include stewardship fees on the seed as applied by Monsanto. Other applicable fees are the responsibility of and payable by the grower on the free bag/s.' (See:<http://www.cbwa.net.au/CBWA/varieties/pdf/CBEclipseRRpromotion.pdf>)

"Like Monsanto promises for the performance of its GM seed, this offer is not what it seems and should be refused by all sensible farmers."

Mr Phelps says grain traders have been paying up to \$50/tonne premium in response to strong local and overseas demand for GM-free grain and, for instance, Viterra's quote for April 19 is \$30 per tonne discount for GM canola at its silos in Melbourne and Adelaide. Values are similar throughout the country. "In response to farmers reluctance to buy, Monsanto has offered N.S.W. growers a price support that guarantees they will receive a maximum of \$10/tonne less for GM, provided they forward sell their crop and deliver the GM canola harvest to Cargill in Newcastle. We question whether such a price support scheme that encourages farmers to 'fix the price' is legal under ACCC rules against price fixing.

A Birchip Cropping Group report has also found that GM canola seed yields no more than top alternative varieties and has similar oil content. "Birchip's gross margin analysis {reported in the *Australian Farm Journal*, April 2012, Pp 20 & 21} also found that due to GM's sale price discount, GM seed royalties, brand-name chemicals required to be used, and extra transport costs to distant silos, GM canola is over \$150 per hectare less profitable than other canola options," Mr Phelps concludes. DALAI LAMA WINS TEMPLETON PRIZE – GIVES IT TO INDIAN CHARITY: *Press Trust of India*, 14 May, 2012. London: Tibetan spiritual leader the Dalai Lama today received the prestigious 1.1 million pound Templeton Prize and announced that most of the prize money will go to 'Save the Children' fund in India.

Speaking at the St Paul's Cathedral where he received the prize, 76-year-old Dalai Lama said that most of the prize money will go to the 'Save the Children' fund in India, with smaller bequests to a science and religion group which is studying the effects of Buddhist practice and to a project to train Buddhist monks as scientists.

About 900,000 pounds will go to 'Save the Children', an Indian NGO that works for child rights, with 125,000 pounds set aside for 'The Minds and Life Institute', a US based non-profit organisation. Money will also go towards a fund to educate Tibetan monks about science.

The Dalai Lama, who leads a Tibetan government in exile in India, is being awarded the prize for encouraging "serious scientific investigative reviews of the power of compassion", and its potential to address world problems. The John Templeton Foundation said that he was chosen for exploring these issues, which are key themes of his teachings, with people beyond his own religious traditions. It is the 40th anniversary of the Templeton Prize, which was established in 1972 as a global award honouring a living person who affirms "life's spiritual dimension", whether through insight, discovery, or practical works. "With an increasing reliance on technological advances to solve the world's problems, humanity also seeks the reassurance that only a spiritual quest can answer," Dr John Templeton, President of the foundation and son of the late prize founder said.

"The Dalai Lama offers a universal voice of compassion underpinned by a love and respect for spiritually relevant scientific research that centres on every single human being," he added. Previous awardees of The Templeton Prize included Mother Teresa.

While receiving the prize the Dalai Lama also said that he was shocked over the riots in London and other towns across Britain last summer, and expressed his sadness over the incidents in a letter to Prime Minister David Cameron. "I have the idea of Englishmen as mature, sensible, law-abiding people. If (riots) happen in England, it is a shock," he said.

"I sent a letter to the prime minister in which I expressed sadness and urged to him to think about the causes of the riots," he added.

The root cause for the riots, according to him was that the young were being "brought up to believe that life was just easy. Life is not easy. If you take for granted that life will be easy, then anger develops, frustration, and riots."

Asked about the Occupy protest outside St Paul's, he said: "If their reasons and motivations are

sincere, then I will join with them." He thought the protests were justified as a way of bringing to light grievances which would otherwise have been ignored.

FUNNY HOW THE NEWS AGENDA GETS 'TIRED' writes Robert Fisk: *The Independent*, 14 May, 2012. Robert Fisk: Must we stand idly by while world leaders spout this codswallop? Even Churchill told the Empire that Britain would 'not stand by idly and see Poland trampled'. Funny how the news agenda gets tired. Like the quotes.

Only a couple of months ago, we were all bracing for Israel's attack on Iran's nuclear installations. And for serious pressure on Bashar al-Assad to end his "barbaric campaign". I quote Susan Rice, La Clinton's lady at the UN. And now? Well, Bashar lingers in his palace while Iran goes off the boil. Instead, it's the underpants bomber. Or the super-underpants bomber. Or rather the super-underpants bomber who wasn't – because it was a sting operation and a CIA man (or a British agent "of Middle East origin"; choose as you wish) posed as a would-be super-underpants bomber to get hold of the super-underpants bomb so it could be taken to pieces by the lads and lasses in Langley, Virginia.

I weary a bit of this stuff. If the CIA and the Brits and the Saudis have really penetrated al-Qa'ida in the Arabian Peninsula - or AQAP, as we are now enjoined to call it, although the acronym sounds a bit like an insurance company - all well and good. But the fact that the Saudis originally supported the Taliban and that al-Qa'ida was until recently led by a Saudi and that most of the 9/11 bombers were Saudis and that an awful lot of other al-Qa'ida men are Saudis, does take the gleam off the cup.

Yet still – with the noble, imperishable exception of Matt Frei on panjandrum Jon Snow's brilliant Channel 4 news - we take all this stuff with mind-numbing, poker-faced seriousness. We do not question the story. Or the words. Or even the expressions. Let's start with Rice at the UN, who recently informed us, in reference to Bashar's "barbaric campaign of violence against the Syrian people", that - mark these words - "in the United States, our patience is exhausted". Well, La Clinton looked a little bit exhausted (was it the hair?) when she waded in herself. "World opinion," she said of the Assad regime, "is not going to stand idly by."

Haven't I heard this before? Why yes, I have. Back in 2009, Robert Gates was getting very exhausted with North Korea and its nuclear weapons. And what did he tell us, on 30 May to be exact? "We will not stand idly by" as Pyongyang developed nuclear weapons. Last year, Barrack Obama said America would not "stand idly by" when a tyrant (to wit, Muammar Gaddafi) "tells his people there will be no mercy". Earlier this year, we had the German Foreign Minister telling his egregious Israeli opposite number, Avigdor Lieberman, that Germany "will not stand idly by" if Israel's right to exist is questioned. And if you think the phrase is reserved only for the powerful, a certain N. Clegg announced just 18 months ago that the Government would not "stand idly by" if banks didn't rein in bonuses. Clegg is in good company. Homer used the expression in *The Simpsons*: "I will not stand idly by and watch you feed a hungry dog."

But none of us journos ever point out what a load of old codswallop this is. We report it at face value, as if the phrases are new, the indignation real, the drama exploding in front of us. We simply do not say or report that "not standing idly by" and patience being "exhausted" are among the greatest clichés of the political world.

Why do we not return to some original sources? Which, being an assiduous reader of mid-20th century history, I shall now do. And I'm afraid we've got to go back to That Wretched Bavarian Corporal (born Braunau on the river Inn, 20 April 1889) who was pretty adept at issuing threats and – unlike latter-day politicians – had a disturbing habit of meaning exactly what he said.

And so here he is, Adolf Hitler addressing his "volk" on 26 September 1938. He had just met Neville Chamberlain, but was very angry at the Czech Prime Minister Edvard Benes for not handing over the German-majority Sudetenland to the Nazis. And what did Hitler say?

"I am no longer willing to stand idly by." And – wait for it – "our patience is exhausted"... Truly, my patience is exhausted.
