# MAN-MADE DESERTS OR A PARADISE? By Betty Luks

More and more men and women are turning away from present farming methods and returning to, or converting to, organic and/or biodynamic methods of farming. Having come across another book on this news, "Desert or Paradise", (English language 2012), written by farmer Sepp Holzer who is known in such circles world-wide, I was reminded once more of Eric D. Butler's words quoted in On Target Vol.52, No.1 2016:

"Stalin knew he could never impose complete totalitarianism until he destroyed the Russian farmers. The future of Australia requires an independent rural Australia."

Sepp Holzer writes that he was invited to Russia to conduct workshops on his methods of farming: "At some point we found ourselves near St Petersburg where the eastern front used to be. Today there is a centre for communication and you can visit the mass graves. Thousands of people have died there. 18 bodies were found in the wilderness there in 2010. They were buried and nobody could tell whether they had been German or Russian. Nature had made them the same. This made me thoughtful as both my uncles had fought and died there. How fate had led me to the very place that had occupied the thoughts of my youth a lot! Today projects serving peace are happening there and people are learning to co-operate with nature again.

During my time in St Petersburg I met the vice chancellor of the Agricultural University. He confirmed that only a small part of Russia is being used agriculturally. Large areas lie fallow. Russia occupies about one seventh of the earth mass and if the land were shared between the Russian people, everyone would get about 12ha, and it is good soil! *(continued on next page)*

The old communist farms have declined though and giant hogweed, woundwort and prairie grass cover the plains and couch grass invades the fields. Russia will starve in front of a full plate, the victim of bureaucrats and big companies. In some of the former Soviet Union countries more than one quarter of the irrigated land is salinated. The drinking water is endangered as a result.

In addition, there is no traditional farming community in Russia. The history books teach us that most free farmers were deported to the gulags during Stalin's reign. The knowledge of how to work with the land has been lost in this way..."

#### AUSTRALIA'S VICTIMS OF BUREAUCRATS AND BIG COMPANIES

While Australia's situation cannot be compared with that of Russia we would do well to consider what happened to the Russian peasants and what is now happening in Australia and America. Thanks to the hard work of such groups as "Lock the Gate" and David Pascoe's Facebook page, we now know of the threats to Australia's prime food-growing land – and those Australians who have put up a fight are the 'victims of bureaucrats and big companies'!

**David Pascoe's Facebook:** Courageous whistleblower, Simone Marsh, shines a further spotlight into the murky and corrupt relationship between the Queensland gas industry and the politicians who are supposed to serve the interests of the public, 7 January 2016. She writes:

"Peter Garrett's recent memoir "*Big Blue Sky*", has offered further insight into the entry of the Queensland CSG-LNG export industry in 2010. Garrett, who at that time was the federal environment minister, had responsibility for decisions under the Commonwealth Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act (EPBC). Referring to the British Gas (QGC) and Santos CSG-LNG projects, Garrett states that one of his final decisions was actually a non-decision.

According to Garrett, despite unambiguous advice from Geosciences Australia regarding inadequate assessment of groundwater impacts on the Great Artesian Basin, intense pressure was applied. Federal treasurer Wayne Swan and resources minister Martin Ferguson had been "acutely focused on the decision".

In Beijing on 24 March 2010, Ferguson witnessed the signing of the sales contract between the BG Group chief executive, Frank Chapman (now Sir Frank), and the China National Offshore Oil Corporation (CNOOC) president, Fu Chengyu.

Other witnesses at the ceremony included the Duke of York, Prince Andrew and the Vice Minister of China's National Energy Administration (NEA), Lui Qi. Days earlier, on 12 March 2010, BG Group's Frank Chapman, Catherine Tanna and Rob Millhouse had been invited guests of Queensland Treasurer Andrew Fraser and Deputy Premier Paul Lucas - at the government box at Suncorp stadium in Brisbane. Queensland's Under-Treasurer, Gerard Bradley, and wife Imelda Bradley (Director of Special Projects at the Queensland Department of Justice and Attorney General) were also invited. Paul Lucas later (February 2011) moved into the position of Attorney-General of Queensland.

In his memoir, Garrett questions whether the Federal Attorney-General's department had been monitoring his activities during 2010. Not long after Garrett's "non-decision", he was moved out of the environment portfolio. Garrett had suspected that Swan wanted him out. Tony Burke was moved into the portfolio in Julia Gillard's second ministry. Within a matter of weeks (22 October 2010), Burke approved the first two east coast CSG-LNG projects. Five months later (March 2011) Wayne Swan appointed BG Group's Catherine Tanna to the board of the Reserve Bank of Australia.

Garrett's memoir adds weight to evidence given by me to a federal Senate Inquiry in 2014. Amongst one of several documents initially redacted by certain members of the Senate Select Committee, is an email sent to Queensland treasurer Andrew Fraser on 12 May 2010. The one-page email from Ian Fletcher, then Queensland director-general of the department responsible for issuing petroleum permits, outlines the status of QGC's environmental impact assessment..."

# IS THIS AN EXAMPLE OF AGENDA 21 where land will be confiscated and closed to farming?

Vicky Davis TVOI News on Jan 5, 2016: "Last night, the mainstream media was filled with stories about the "armed takeover" of the Malheur National Wildlife Refuge by people who have been termed antifederalist or anti-government militias. The truth is there is nothing that dramatic going on. I was at the Malheur Headquarters yesterday and was able to walk around freely. There were lots of media trucks and crews and even one government guy – Fish & Wildlife. The environment couldn't have been more relaxed but there were some serious conversations going on between different clusters of people.

### What Really Happened?

Owner/cameraman Michael Emry has been on scene in Burns, Oregon since the day before the rally was scheduled. He came with a group of other Idahoans who intended to provide an expression of concern for the Hammonds and support for the Harney County Committee of Safety. Today I was finally able to talk to Michael to find out what really happened here. The rally went on as scheduled and it was a huge success. Everyone was delighted by the turn out and the mood. But what happened at the termination of the march was that Ammon Bundy announced that they were taking a hard line and that a separate group was already at Malheur National Wildlife Refuge. They intended to occupy the Headquarters until the federal government returns the Refuge land to Harney County for productive use.

Harney County is a resource rich area but the agencies of the federal government over the years have used their bully authority to force ranchers, lumberers and farmers out of business at which point the feds take over the land and lock it up in the Refuge. This takes the property off the tax rolls and out of productive use.

# Hammond Case follows well-established pattern of abuse

The BLM (Bureau of Land Management) used false and scurrilous charges of eco-terrorism to put Dwight and his son in prison which obviously puts them out of the ranching business. The Feds forced them to sign a Right of First Refusal as a condition of their probation after they were released from prison having served the time that the original judge gave them. A Right of First Refusal means that the Hammonds must allow the BLM to buy the property first before it is offered to any other potential buyers.

At the time the Hammonds were released from prison, they were on their knees but would have been able to continue their ranching business so the BLM through the U.S. Attorneys office went after them again – appealing their sentence to the Ninth Circuit Court. The liberal Ninth Circuit overturned the original judge's sentence for the Hammonds and he applied the mandatory minimum under the Antiterrorism and Effective Death Penalty Act of 1996. That was the coup de grace for the Hammonds. They went back to prison and their land will go to the BLM to be locked up in the Refuge. According to Ammon Bundy who has done extensive research both on western land issues and the Hammond Case, as late as the 1980's, Harney County was one of the wealthiest counties in the state and now it is one of the poorest and it's due to federal acquisition of western lands.

Dwight and Stephen are not arsonists bent on destruction. They were ranchers trying to run their ranching business. The BLM viciously pursued the Hammonds on charges that the county prosecutor wouldn't prosecute because there wasn't any evidence that they did anything wrong. The fire in 2001 which was to burn off dead grass went a little farther than intended. It happens all the time both to the ranchers and to the BLM when they do controlled burns. The 2005 fire was a back burn fire. There was a fire on BLM land that was started by lightning. That fire was out of control and was coming towards the Hammonds home and buildings. The Hammonds lit a back-fire which did exactly what it was intended to do. It burned toward the wild fire and when the two fires met, the fire went out because there was no more fuel (unburned grass). It put the wild fire out and it saved the Hammonds buildings. And for those two events, the Hammonds were convicted of eco-terrorism True to form, the mainstream media – rather than digging to find the truth of the Occupy Malheur story, chose as they always do to demonize conservatives who having had their fill of government abuse, finally act out to call attention to it. The media does bleeding heart stories 24/7 for urban protestors who act out against government abuse, but God help anybody from a productive sector who complains about the government putting them out of business.

At this point, it's not known how this story will end. It's really up to the Ranchers of Harney County... Now that the world is watching the question is – will those Ranchers finally take a stand and speak out or will they allow the opportunity to pass that Ammon Bundy and the other men at the Malheur Headquarters put their lives on the line to provide to them...

# NATIONAL DIVIDEND OR GUARANTEED INCOME? Wallace Klinck, Canada

I personally do not favour reference to a "Guaranteed Income" because a dividend is not guaranteed and depends on the success of an enterprise. That the Social Credit National Dividend almost certainly will be in fact a "guaranteed income" is quite beside the point. *We have to get our definitions correct in order to maintain integrity of policy.* 

The National Dividend would not be derived from assessing someone else's financial income - whereas a "guaranteed income" could well be derived from taxation (insofar as there remains anything to tax) and constitutes confiscation and redistribution of incomes. Anything of this nature is not conceived upon the idea of an Inheritance but rather as social welfare by forced sharing. We do need a sharing society but taxation is not the appropriate approach to achieving it.

# **Guaranteed Income Financed by Taxation?**

Proponents of a "guaranteed income" have almost if not universally assumed that it would be financed by means of taxation. This reveals that they are oblivious to the flaw in the price-system and are basically committed to the idea that the world's problems are due to the over-simplified idea that some people have too much and must be relieved of it. This completely ignores the potential of society to produce abundance if it were possible to tap into the real credit of society with its enormous potential for an abundance of truly desirable production while simultaneously achieving more leisure for all.

This whole idea of giving the State a total and absolute control of the issue of financial credit is truly alarming. Financial credit is the means of activating real credit. Each of us as individuals has a store of "real credit" or capacity to achieve. Do we really want a situation where the ability of the individual to actualize his or her real credit is to be dependent on the permission of the State?

Creativity resides in individual human minds - not in some abstract "collective" administered by a clumsy and restrictive bureaucracy. People who favour this sort of State monopoly over credit often recommend that Social Crediters should change their name to "National Credit" or some such misnomer. Social Credit derives from the living relationships of individuals in a free society and not on some abstract collective which we call the State or the Government. Real creativity being decentralized in nature, individuals should have a wide variety of options in seeking to activate their creativity via financial means.

# Area of Consumption Where Primary Problem Resides

What is necessary is that the State should have passive statistics allowing it to break the existing monopoly of existing financial or credit-creating institutions by means of the direct issue of debt-free consumption credits. It is in the area of consumption that the primary economic problem resides and it is in this area that the corrective decentralizing measures must be implemented. If it has wide access to financial credit, industry will respond to consumer demand and has demonstrated a marvellous capacity to do so when allowed, even under the artificial restraints of conventional financial rules.

Financial institutions should be involved primarily in credit creation for recoverable production loans and in rendering account services rather than provision of consumer loans involving monetary expansion by credit creation. Social Credit measures would provide sufficient income for total absorption of end product. If individuals wish to engage in borrowing or lending amongst themselves and wish to do so individually or by organizational means that is their prerogative.

National Dividends can be used for direct consumption, lent to others, or even given to others if desired. Banks do what banks do and really have no mechanism to correct the flaw in the price-system which is simply an accountancy problem in the area of national accountancy and needs to be addressed in that area. We need to correct and standardize our national accountancy conventions. All this chatter about local exchange currencies, etc. is a rabbit trail - a waste of time and energy and a wholly unnecessary distraction from the essential task at hand. \*\*\*

# THE GREAT US-of-A DETERIORATING?

Step-by-step, Russia, China and other emerging economies are taking measures to lessen their dependency on the US dollar, to "de-dollarize." Oil is the world's largest traded commodity and it is almost entirely priced in dollars. Were that to end, the ability of the US military industrial complex to wage wars without end would be in deep trouble.

Perhaps that would open some doors to more peaceful ideas such as spending US taxpayer dollars on rebuilding the horrendous deterioration of basic USA economic infrastructure. The American Society of Civil Engineers in 2013 estimated \$3.6 trillion of basic infrastructure investment is needed in the United States over the next five years. They report that one out of every 9 bridges in America, more than 70,000 across the country, are deficient. Almost one-third of the major roads in the US are in poor condition. Only 2 of 14 major ports on the eastern seaboard will be able to accommodate the super-sized cargo ships that will soon be coming through the newly expanded Panama Canal. There are more than 14,000 miles of highspeed rail operating around the world, but none in the United States.

That kind of basic infrastructure spending would be a

A Bavarian mayor angry about Germany's asylum policy has sent a busload of Syrian migrants to Chancellor Angela Merkel's office in Berlin. But he has ended up paying for their accommodation in the capital himself. Peter Dreier, mayor of the district of Landshut, said he wanted to "send a signal" that Germany's asylum policies could not continue as before.

The bus arrived in Berlin on Thursday evening. All those on board volunteered to make the journey, the council said. Germany took in 1.1 million asylum seekers in 2015. Mr Dreier said he had informed Mrs Merkel of his bus plan in a phone call in October.

### What next for refugees in Germany?

German government spokesman Steffen Seibert said in

"I think that most informed people are aware of the forces that promoted the aggressive international actions which precipitated these problems of mass migration. Moreover, I think that the perpetrators were entirely aware of the consequences which would ensue - such consequences being part of their determined and enduring effort to eradicate the last vestiges of two millennia of Christian culture which reached its high point in Western Europe and the British Isles. I regard the architects and promoters of the European Union as arch traitors to their nations, and to Civilization, who have an allegiance not to their electors but to the concept of World Government and

far more economically beneficial source of real jobs and real tax revenue for the United States than more of John McCain's endless wars. Investment in infrastructure, as I have noted in previous articles, has a multiplier effect in creating new markets. Infrastructure creates economic efficiencies and tax revenues of some 11 to 1 for every one dollar invested as the economy becomes more efficient.

A dramatic decline for the role of the dollar as world reserve currency, if coupled with a Russia-styled domestic refocus on rebuilding America's domestic economy, rather than out-sourcing everything, could go a major way to rebalance a world gone mad with war. Paradoxically, the de-dollarization, by denying Washington the ability to finance future wars by the investment in US Treasury debt from Chinese, Russian and other foreign bond buyers, could be a valuable contribution to genuine world peace. Wouldn't that be nice for a change?

#### INVENTING THE INDIVIDUAL: How Christianity Gave Us Our Political Freedoms by Chris Knight

The world today is one where political freedoms are decreasing, not increasing. Daniel Hannan, a British member of the European Parliament, author of *Inventing Freedom: How the English-Speaking Peoples Made the Modern World*, (HarperCollins, 2013), has argued that the political systems of the "Anglo" world - Australia, New Zealand, Canada, Britain and the United States - are based on the idea that the state should be subject to the rule of law, not the other way around.

Nevertheless, Britain's MI5 has been spying on British citizens, examining phone call, text and email data for some time. A clampdown on so-called "extremism" and the creation of Orwellian-like organisations, will undertake previously unanticipated restrictions on freedom of speech, association and movement. That is just the start. The European Union technocrats in the light of Islamist terrorists attacks have targeted what they think is the real source of the problem: intolerance. Here is what journalist Jennifer Oriel says in summary of this (*The Australian*, October 21, 2015, p.12):

"Drafted by the European Council on Tolerance and Reconciliation, the European Framework National Statute for the Promotion of Tolerance is an odious renunciation of the values that distinguish the free world from its totalitarian counterparts. This is where scholarly books such as Larry Siedentop, *Inventing the Individual: The Origins of Western Liberalism*, (Penguin, 2014) is of great merit. Like Hannon's book, Siedentop is well aware that people in the West have lost their moral compass, or what he calls our "moral bearings". "We no longer have a persuasive story to tell ourselves about our origins and development".

Siedentop shows in exhaustive scholarly detail that it is not a coincidence that liberal freedom is developed in the Christian West. In fact Christianity gave us liberalism because it was Christianity which appreciated that it was individuals who had souls, and these individuals were loved by a God of charity and goodness. The individuals were viewed as being made in the image of God and hence having the metaphysical and moral qualities that God has - God having these qualities in a perfected and infinitely more developed way. And without the concept of freedom, nothing in Christianity would make sense, including Christ's sacrifice on the cross. Siedentop does the full scholarship and traces out the intellectual history of ideas woven through this narrative, Tertullian, Augustine, Charlemagne and down to modern times

The concluding sentence of the book is: "If we in the West do not understand the moral depth of our own tradition, how can we hope to shape the conversation of mankind?" Indeed, core historically-grounded liberties are being lost by the day under attack from totalitarian traditions which draw in part from multiculturalism. Against this, thinkers need to defend the Western tradition from those among us ready to tear it apart. It will not be easy because the law itself, the education institutions such as the schools and universities, are the tools of this destructive new class elite.

Our political and economic elites are lazy and go the way of treating Australia as an eternal colony. If the experiment that is "Australia" is to succeed, the only viable long-term approach is independence, selfreliance and the way of freedom, all core values of social credit.

#### A CASHLESS SOCIETY: The Australian Constitutional Ramifications and Strategies of Resistance by Arnis Luks and Ian Wilson LL.B.

Welfare recipients in Ceduna, South Australia, in February 2016, will be the subject's of the trial of a Cashless Welfare Card, its aim being to control people's spending on gambling, alcohol and drugs. Across the world nations are racing to embrace the cashless, electronic, digital world. Estonia already has a virtually cashless society and 95% of all retail sales in Sweden are cashless. The government of Denmark is intending to eradicate cash, as if it was some sort of noxious weed, by 2030.

Arguments given for the cashless society range from convenience for consumers (cash is said to be "dirty", contaminated by "germs") to the control of terrorism. Applying the Hegelian Dialectic, the Pentagon has argued that surveillance of every purchase by every citizen is necessary in the "war on terror". And that is the principal argument against the cashless society: not the increased risk of digital crime, exploitation by those with a monopoly of cashless credit (which we have now, anyway), but the loss of individual freedom and a risk of ultimate government tyranny, by creations of a complete technocracy - the obtaining of political power from the "scientific" control of capital and economic life. Betty Luks, "A Carbon Currency Rationing Future", New Times Survey, is a good paper on this.

**The Australian Constitution:** Section 51 (xii) is a head of power which enables the Commonwealth to make laws with regard to currency, coinage and legal tender. A determined parliament could, in theory, lead the move in Australia to cashlessness by abrogating our financial sovereignty to an unelected central banker/technocrat.

The Australian Constitution is sparing on rights, being basically an enabling doctrine motivated to bring together the Australian nation and keep business rolling. However our freedoms could be protected by the courts (even by unrighteous judges) as part of our sacred common-law tradition, but this requires determination and political will by an informed, active minority. The average Joe at the pub or shopper in the mall does not see that "cashlessness" equates to complete control by the New World Order.

# We are only one, or are we?

After having viewed Robert Balzola's video from the National Weekend Seminar in Adelaide, we are encouraged that we are not alone in this war. We also note the wrestling going on within the factional branches of the Liberal party, as the (communist) Left attempts to cherry pick candidates for each electorate across Australia. This would have led to a system no better than the Politburo presenting one candidate only (from the Communist Party) for the electorates to vote for.

It is also inspiring to listen to Phillip Benwell chairman Australian Monarchist League, demonstrating how the harvest is rich in potential allies for the correct political issues, (again from the National Weekend videos). We must recognise that our own 'calling' requires every one of us to do what we are able in this battle to save Western Christian Civilisation.

Use alternative media to highlight campaigns and results. Use legal tender in all your transactions. Inform your politician of your views on this issue. If the issue is "HOT" in your electorate, work with like minded people to focus energy on this "one issue". Establish an alternative trading group within your immediate contacts (farmers' market). Find a tradable commodity and trade with your contacts outside of the conventional system - this will assist you to endure (resist the blackmail as was done to the Greek people by the banksters). Stock up.

# BLASTING AWAY ALZHEIMERS by Uncle Len with Amyloid deposits on the Brain

I collect illnesses, especially mental illnesses, as the rich might collect paintings. No, that is not true at all it implies an element of free will and I don't have much of that fuel left in my tank. Like Job, I am, as Yoda from Star Wars would say in his grammarmincing way.

# ACTION TARGETS FOR THE WEEK-KG

**Correspondence:** Preferably by written letter posted to the MP's office or Parliament; emails are a poor second choice because they are easily deleted or may generate a very brief reply, but some people prefer a more personal contact, in which case you might meet the MP or speak by telephone. The written way creates a record of your request and the reply given. This is important for further interaction and for the record. Still other forms of action include letters to editors, talk-back radio and gathering "opinion poll" details from the public at supermarkets or other locations where people gather. The results may be sent to the appropriate MP.

# TPP

The ABC radio reported the gains for Australia of signing the TPP Agreement would be a trade increase of only 1%, while other trading partners stood to gain up to 10%.

### Actionists please contact all your State Senators.

Concentrate on Cross Bench, ALP and independentstyle Coalition senators. Ask the senators to vote against the TPP because the ISDS Clause will permit multi-national manufacturers to sue our Government if any legislation affects their profit. It is foolish to place Australia in such a position with a disputes court above our Constitution and Parliament. In fact it is probably un-Constitutional for Parliament to commit to an authority above our Government, and should it succeed in being passed by the Senate, needs to be challenged in our Australian High Court.

**By asking a question**, your MP should send a reply. Getting the correct answer will not only inform you, but will provide some learning to the MP.

So in addition to asking them to oppose the TPP, you may ask them:

 If improvements or amendments to the TPP are desired, what is the procedure to achieve such change?
If Australia chose to withdraw from the TPP, what procedure would be required?

3. What is the duration of the TPP?

**Contact your MP/Senator now.** The TPP will soon be before the Parliament.
