THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK: CONFLICT OF PURPOSE, OF POLICY

by Geoffrey Dobbs: What we are engaged in is a spiritual warfare, that is, a conflict of purpose, or as we have learnt to call it, of policy. In a sense, all wars are about policy, but they are conflicts of the same policy – each trying to damage the other, to attack and enlarge the weak points in the other and to impose its will by fear upon the other... Such war is an expression of Monopolism - perhaps its ultimate expression – whether in the form of Monopolo-theism (belief in a unitary Dictator-God, as in Judaism and Islam) or in the form of Monopolo-humanism (Man is the Ultimate power, which is wielded by the Top Men).

Hence the focus of militant monopolism in the near East between the Chosen People of Allah and of Jehovah, each with its ‘sacred right’ to impose its will on others (as in former times between monopolist forms of Christianity). But since these conflicts are about human power, the divine pretext for them can be easily dropped in favour of pure humanism, of which the most organised form is Marxist-Leninist communism – a religion of human power, based upon a philosophy of conflict as the means of human advance – essentially Dualistic or Manichaeian...

The essence of the Christian Doctrine of Creation is that God is good and his works are good – that is, what we call reality and goodness are the same thing... Socialists are in the vanguard of the human mob, rushing towards slavery and disaster. Conservatives are in the rear guard, but all heading the same way. The way to head off a mob, whether of people or cattle, is to divert the leaders, not the tail end. When we get involved in confrontation, still more in actual conflict, we are fighting the good in our opponents, the truth which has been twisted round against us. When such conflicts have been forced upon us we may have to fight for survival, but the Enemy has already won a victory, and such conflicts should never be sought. “Truth”, as has been well said, “is the first casualty in War.”

Our Major Strategy: Resolution not Revolution or Confrontation!

So now, what is our major strategy as Christians in the spiritual war? It is resolution, not revolution, or confrontation. We have our orders: “Love your enemies! Do good to them that harm you!” This is often dismissed as impracticable idealism, but it is the very reverse. It is hard-headed, practical common sense. It is the only thing that actually works and defeats evil, provided of course, that it is bound back to reality in practical detail every time.

For instance, how can we love our enemies if we do not identify them, meet them, mix with them, and discover what sort of people they are, why they are our enemies, and what truth as well as falsehood there may be behind their enmity? We do not have to like them, though it helps if we can; but to join in the game of mutual denunciation by groups of people beating the air with spoken or written words of fury at the evil of others mostly directed at those who agree with them, divides the truth, and gets us nowhere except into a morass of futility.

“Doing good” does not mean “do-gooding”, a perverted word for a horrible perversion of the instinct of compassion, meaning the denial of sin and therefore of forgiveness and the indulgence of corruption, taking away free will and responsibility. On the contrary, **it means appealing to and stimulating the qualities of integrity, responsibility, intelligence and courage. It means sympathising with and sharing other people’s real aims and helping them to achieve what they want, in the world of reality, rather than what we want.**

This being our strategy, let us now try to apply its principles to the tactics of our actions in the current world. If we think it over we find that, as social crediters, we have something vital and constructive to offer to the resolution of practically every ‘problem’, which besets our fellow men, and once this is realised we soon find we have very little time for anything else...” - - - taken from “*The Strategy and Tactics of Spiritual Warfare*” by Geoffrey Dobbs ***

HERE IS WHAT TRUMP HAS BEEN SMOKING: SWEDISH ETHNORACIAL SOCIAL CHAOS

The “false news” media zeroed in on Trump for allegedly speaking of a “phony terror attack” in Sweden and the former Swedish foreign minister wondered what Trump was “smoking”: <http://nypost.com/2017/02/19/swedes-ask-what-trumps-smoking-after-he-cites-unknown-terror-attack/>.

Trump, however, did not state that a terrorist attack as such had occurred in Sweden, but said, “You’ve got to keep our country safe. You look at what’s happening in Germany, you look at what’s happening last night in Sweden. Sweden, who would believe this? They took in large numbers. They’re having problems like they never thought possible.”

Do you see any mention in this of a terrorist attack, at least conventionally defined? No, anyone with eyes would see that this is not so.

What is happening in Sweden?

At least recently, we have rioters in the Swedish suburb of Rinkeby, a migrant majority district, burning cars, looting, beating up people and putting them in hospital: <https://www.rt.com/news/378071-stockholm-riots-police-shots/>.

Unlike the unrest in France where there may be police brutality involved that sparked things off, in the Rinkeby riot, the spark was police arresting a wanted migrant at a subway station. Apparently criminals must roam free; gone is the rule of law.

Apart from the latest riots, winding the clock back just a bit, we have the story of Swedish police appealing to the public for help in dealing with a wave of violence that was rolling out of control. Here is what one news item said:

“Police in the Swedish city of Malmö made an urgent plea for locals to assist them in solving scores of serious crimes, including dozens of attempted killings, murders, beatings, rapes and other offenses as police struggle to grapple with a spike in violence.

In an open letter, Malmö police chief Stefan Sinteus on Friday encouraged citizens to provide testimonies in a hope that they might help police to find perpetrators in an array of otherwise stalled investigations.

“I can assure you that the police in Malmö are doing everything we can for suspected perpetrators to be held accountable. But we cannot do it on our own. We depend on you, and your witness statements, to solve these violent crimes. Therefore I appeal now to you: Help us,” Sinteus wrote.

The letter followed reports that potential witnesses in the murder of a 16-year-old Iraqi boy, Ahmed Obaid, murdered in the city’s Rosengard district on January 14, were reluctant to provide any accounts after racist threats directed at his former schoolmates were posted under the photo of his dead body.

“They are scared. They are terrified and are wondering who’s going to be shot next,” the school’s headmaster told Swedish *Sydsvenskan* newspaper, as cited by the *Local*.

“People lie and tell untruths to [mis]direct us. It is a problem for us”, former investigator JB Cederholm told *Sydsvenskan*.

Rosengard, which has received media attention as the “most notorious refugee ghetto” of Sweden, has an over 80 percent migrant population, predominantly of Middle Eastern, African and Eastern European origin. It has repeatedly been a scene of gang and multi-ethnic violence and is prone to social unrest, with less than 40 percent of its residents having a job.” See <https://www.rt.com/news/375364-sweden-police-appeal-violence-malmo/>.

THE CURE FOR DEPRESSION

Stephen S. Ilardi, *The Depression Cure: The 6-Step Program to Beat Depression without Drugs*, (DaCapo Press, 2009), is a must-read book for anyone suffering from depression.

The fundamental premise of the book is that “human beings were never designed for the poorly nourished, sedentary, indoor, sleep-deprived, socially isolated, frenzied pace of twenty-first-century life.” In other words, the human body is not adapted to modern techno-industrial lifestyles. He gives the example of the obesity epidemic, caused by our Stone Aged bodies still seeking to store calories in fear of coming hard times. There is an abundance of energy-rich foods, in a life with little exercise. In American 65 percent of adults are overweight due to both lack of exercise and the abundance of high calorie food, such as junk food, burgers, pizzas and other high carb/high fat foods. Hence, humans experience an array of diseases, such as syndrome X and other metabolic diseases: https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Metabolic_syndrome.

The rate of depression in Third World countries is a fraction of what it is in the West, and countries in East Asia, which have rapidly industrialised, have experienced a corresponding rise in depression levels. Depression is virtually non-existent in hunter-gatherer societies such as the Kaluli people of the New Guinea highlands: https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Kaluli_people, although they get up to other things.

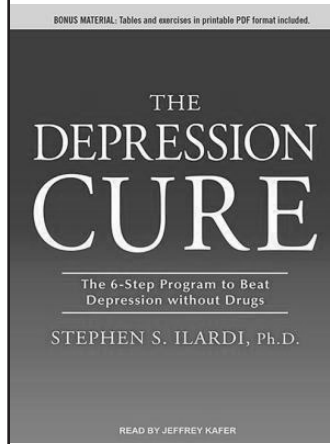
The book offers a six-step path to reducing depression, via the “therapeutic Lifestyle change” (TLC). The six components of the program each have anti-depressive capacities. They are an increase in omega-3 fatty acids, primarily through high quality supplements; engaging social activity, not being alone but interacting with people and stopping ruminating, churning over things; social support: having friends and not being isolated; physical exercise; sunlight exposure (increasing vitamin D), and high quality sleep. The book details how one can go about achieving all of this. It is stated that the program is more effective than drugs, and the changes are all good and healthy anyway.

If any readers are suffering from depression, especially after reading some of the news items that we face each day, this book may offer help. ***
