The Victorian government, which believes only in power, has atheistic Marxist-Leninism at the core of it's philosophy - state control of individuals, property and production. The curfew in Melbourne has been 'called out' by Michael Wyles QC as not lawful, as has the closing of the borders between the various states. The executive, particularly in Victoria, is operating outside the law and this does not appear to bother or slow down their decrees.

The Victorian Parliamentary Reform Act 2003 changed the balance of power between both houses of parliament and the Reserve Powers of the Governor into the dictatorship we are presently witnessing. It may be these very Reserve Powers constitutionally vested by practice and tradition in the Governor that could release the Victorian people from this dictatorship. Domination by government or industry is anti-christian. Monopoly in any form is anti Christian - satanic.

Domination, or the dominance hierarchy, or Darwinism, is also preached from psuedo-conservatives such as our current PM Scott Morrison, Ludwig von Mises, neo-liberalism, Libertarianism and Prof Jordon Peterson, promoting monopolies, get big or get out - industry and government - man only as an economic unit - again atheistic and satanic. For some, there is a clear variance between their stated belief system and what they actually do - *you shall know them by their fruits.* Both these dominating power movements operate at the expense of the 'individuals' within community. Our cultural inheritance is allowed to be stolen or pilfered away by others, under either a liberal or labor administration. There is no effective representation in any current parliaments for the working man (traditional labour), nor the small to medium business man, let alone a homebody centred around the family. And yet it is the family that is the basic unit - the foundational unit within society - it is the reason why we come together in the first place. If individuals and families are not catered for within any of these powermovements we must look elsewhere other than atheism: socialism or neo-liberalism - both orientated from a monotheistic (all powerful) philosophy of dialectical materialism.

The carnage reeked on Victoria is actually a demonstration of the great foresight of our founding fathers with the design and purpose/intent of our Federal Constitution in particular. They were ahead of the game called freedom, further advanced than even USA and Britain. The Federal Constitution divides power, even the power of parliament, by holding a balancing, a division, of power across both houses, with non-specified reserve powers vested in the Crown. This is a reflection of the Trinitarian Christian Philosophy orientated towards the Godhead. The Father is God, The Son is God, The Spirit is God. Co-equal, Co-eternal – mutual love and cooperation. **Extract from the Australian Monarchist League's email:**

Under our system of governance, parliament is the supreme administrative and law-making body. It is the parliament, under the Crown, that is in charge. The government, including the prime minister and all ministers (the executive) are responsible to the parliament. That is our system of responsible government unlike, say, in the United States where their system is different and the presidency itself holds enormous executive power. Our prime minister does not hold such power and, in any event, cannot abrogate whatever executive authority he may have to any non-elected person, such as a medical adviser. *(extract continued next page)*

It is up to the governor-general and, in the states, the governors, to ensure that no politician sworn in by them exceeds any power that may devolve upon him or her under the constitution. Furthermore, the parliaments, federal and state, must meet on a regular basis. They have been elected by the people to run the country and no emergency can override the meeting of the parliaments, however inconvenient it may be for individuals. After all, it is the duty of all members of parliament, as representatives on behalf of the people, to hold governments (the executive) to account. **- end of extract TRINITARIANISM**

division/distribution of power - civics in a nutshell.

Trinitarian thinking sets the framework for understanding our CIVICS within the Christian philosophy template of placing government and all leadership roles into <u>positions of service</u> – *Greatest of all will be a servant - Do unto him as you would have him do unto you.* This sets Christianity apart from 'every' <u>power-movement</u>. Serving every individual is the justification for coming together (government). If any individual is left behind due to a policy shortfall, then the policy needs to be changed to serve that individual as well. We do not see this in Victoria. Individuals are left suffering in isolation, suicides are going through the roof, and the executive (the individual persons making these decrees) should be held to account for this carnage - and yet they are purposely the <u>unaccountable bureaucracy</u>.

Daniel Andrews, as does the bureaucracy around him (the executive) - is living out the belief system that Victorians are experiencing - Marxist-Leninism - power. Man is only an animal - matter in motion - a product of chance. There is no higher authority, nor design nor purpose behind creation. He, as this higher animal, conceives a thought in his mind and decrees the thought as the only allowable answer to this problem. Man sets the rules of the universe, not the other way around, that man should observe and learn what the rules of the universe are and then abide by them - you might call those observed rules of the universe the <u>natural law</u>.

All that is necessary is for this self-proclaimed deity to provide sufficient propaganda to sustain the thinking of the mob. Not observing the outworking of the thought, but only relying on numbers to reflect this reality, this self-proclaimed deity cannot, or will not, see the carnage of the outworking of their decrees. They can only see numbers, beautiful numbers. An abstraction more real than the observable world. Money thinking is similar the abstraction is more real than the observable world.

As a higher animal, emotions like 'consideration, concern, empathy' do not exist in their abstract world. Emotions would denote a spirit within the organism and therefore cannot be real, but show signs of mental weakness in need of re-education or if sufficiently removed from 'reality' in need of liquidation. This conditioning of the mind to dominantly think in the abstract (left hemisphere) has only recently been documented in *"The Master and His Emissary: The Divided Brain and the Making of the Western World"* by Dr Iain McGilchrist. <u>Thought must be balanced between</u> both hemispheres of the brain - to be <u>observed</u> in it's natural outworking, its <u>embodiment</u>, - and then adjusted accordingly. Historically this was achieved by the Trivium within the education system - grammar, rhetoric and logic - seeing more than one side during the many regular and varied debates.

We are to look at the incarnating (outworking) of this policy based on the philosophy of Dialectical Materialism, from which we can assess its effectiveness - it's justification for existence. The policy is held in place by force - the police and extreme fines - not the outworking of something you might call natural, but simply of 'might is right' power politics. The social cohesion is fragmenting and civilisation is dissolving under the policy of this atheistic materialistic philosophy.

This current political situation is an opportunity for a resurgence of research into civics and the regeneration of our faith – placing Christian thinking at the fore to lead us out of this dilemma - this vacuum of faithlessness. **CIVICS**

Christian Civics, as part of our rich cultural heritage, is the vital subject with the inherent ability to resolve the Victorian dilemma. Orientating of OnTarget

I have received several queries around "Why has OT changed from only 'disseminating' the NEWS - what is the purpose for the change ? "

We needed to look critically at ourselves to uncover 'what was missing from our journal OnTarget'. ALOR, and OnTarget in this case, is an off-shoot of the Social Credit Movement established around the writings of CH Douglas. The journal's emphasis has changed over the years towards only disseminating of the NEWS, but failing to offer Social Credit orientated guidance as the educational tool it was established to provide. Target for the Week

State elections will soon be held in Queensland and Victoria is due for a poll in 2022. Opinion polls are showing support for Coalition parties which has been generated by ALP actions in overplaying the Covid 19 situation. In Queensland the border restrictions have been too severe and the Premier's claim that her hospitals were for Queenslanders; not NSW citizens, never mind how ill they may be, has not helped her. Victorians meanwhile have been subjected to the harshest Covid restrictions imaginable. No matter how much the incidence of Covid reduced, the Premier insisted on continuing restrictions. The population were willing to accept the strict rules for a while but with no end in sight, they have become restless - and rightly so.

In both of these States, the Opposition Coalition parties have been conspicuous by their inaction. Do they deserve your vote on election day ? It is understandable that voters wish to see the end of their ALP Government but to simply vote in the Opposition is not good enough. You will be giving them victory by default ! Unless Coalition parties stand for definite policies on health matters like Covid and other issues like a recovering economy they will not deserve your vote. Another issue surrounds our personal rights and freedom, both of which have suffered of late.

At election time, both the Coalition and ALP bargain on receiving say 45% of the vote from loyal supporters, so they attempt to win over the swinging 6% to gain victory. In these coming elections, the choice will be 'more of the same' or 'almost more of the same' unless the public can generate some decent policies from the parties.

It is understandable that people wish to see a change in Government but to simply hand over to the current Opposition will be unlikely to deliver real change. If a substantial number of voters cast an informal vote and the party winning Government received enough support from say just 35% of the voters (the others receiving say 30%) the political climate would change instantly because they both would realise they must do more to earn votes.

Queenslanders should quickly act on these matters in time for their election and it is not too soon for Victorians to begin action in advance of the 2022 election. - *ND*
