### AM I MY BROTHER'S KEEPER? By Arnis Luks

In my research for this week I had to go to a very dark place. A place of treachery and treason, of disloyalty to your very kith and kin. A place where your brother may not be considered human at all. The place where the words 'harlot' and 'whore' don't emphasise sufficiently the revulsion I felt going there. While I was there I met fellow travellers who had also been duped into dehumanising their fellow man for other purposes. I may touch on who they are later in this article.

Yuri Bezmenov, under the pseudonym Thomas David Schuman, wrote a book called "*Love Letter to America*", explaining in detail the steps a nation faces on its road to Moscow - being Sovietised. The demoralisation process continues for 15 to 20 years, but in our case has been ongoing for at least 60 years. This demoralisation process compels the average person to deeply question who they are, who their nation is, constantly being brought to the point of self loathing. We see this process in our education facilities presenting less than truthful depictions of our significant cultural and historical achievements, to the point of deliberate psychological harm to our children, with guilt, disarming and self loathing as an entire people.

The news cycle at the moment is making great mileage against our brave war-service men and women. There is design in this propaganda to seriously affect individuals within our military and also our personal (national) psychological well-being - to ultimately loath ourselves as a people and as individuals. This methodology of brainwashing to the point of self-loathing, has been continually developed from the early Pavlovian experiments, to the Korean prisoners of war brainwashed by the Chinese Communists, to the Tavistock Institute of Human Relations in Britain. The seat of the science is propaganda or manipulation of public opinion. It is a hideous science of human psychological manipulation, further reinforced by the social media conglomerations.

**extract:** In the course of a speech delivered on April 12, 1948, in the Canadian House of Commons, Mr. Norman Jaques, M.P., said: "Speaking of internationalism and the real purpose and motive of internationalism, I have made a few notes on the social credit analysis of the hidden motives behind this drive for internationalism. It is an essential strategy for world dictatorship. The central strategy is to gain the monopoly of credit and of world propaganda so as systematically and continuously to spread false doctrines and to exploit the inevitable confusion resulting from putting such false doctrines into practice. This exploitation takes the form of centralizing every kind of control, the creation of greater and greater monopolies leading to the police state, and to the final step of world government by world cartels controlled by international financiers.

Some of the meshes of this international net are U.N.R.R.A., Bretton Woods, emergency food board and U.N.E.S.C.O., by which nations surrender control of their credit, food supplies and propaganda; in other words, a world cartel of credits, propaganda and food to be used as sanctions against any recalcitrant countries." National sovereignty is an obstacle in the way of these international socialists and would-be dictators. An inner ring of internationalists, extending to many countries, repudiate loyalty to the country of their adoption; they give their loyalty to their international ring and its ideals. Through their control of financial policy they are able to exert a controlling influence over the governments of the countries in which they live. Their plan is to replace national with corporate government, the control being within the international ring. This is the empire

of international cartels with the international financier as the emperor. With them war is a means to an end. War is 'the pursuit of policy by other means.' These internationalists work to a plan. Let me name some of them. Mond sets up a chemical cartel linked with Germany and America. Samuel recommends state ownership of coal. Isaacs (Lord Reading), negotiates a war debt settlement with Wall Street, binding the British to undisclosed terms, Sieff sets up Political and Economic Planning, (PEP), using the war as an excuse to overcome opposition. Cassel finances the London School of Economics to train the bureaucracy for the future world socialist state. Laski preaches class- that is civil-war. The state assumes the ownership of coal and other real assets, and international finance involves the state in dollar debt. The socialists bankrupt the state, and the international financiers foreclose on the physical assets. In the meantime the people, forced into the factories under the slogan 'Work or Want,' are controlled by quotas and ration books, ticketed and dossiered by social security." **end extract**

Douglas shows the treachery and treason by those who stood to gain the most, not just for profit but for power, world power - "*And he said to him: To thee will I give all this power, and the glory of them; for to me they are delivered, and to whom I will, I give them. If thou therefore wilt adore before me, all shall be thine. And Jesus answering said to him: It is written: Thou shalt adore the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.*"

I must again emphasise that war (killing of another human being) is unnatural. 98% of humanity is incapable of entering into the necessary state of mind to process killing another human being without serious mental conditioning (brainwashing), or drugs.

### **Vikings**

When Viking villages went to war in unison, the berserkers often wore special clothing, for instance furs of a wolf or bear, to indicate that this person was a berserker, and would not be able to tell friend from foe when in "*bersærkergang*". In this way, other allies would know to keep their distance.

Some scholars propose that certain examples of berserker rage had been induced voluntarily by the consumption of drugs such as the hallucinogenic mushroom *Amanita muscaria* or massive amounts of alcohol. However, this is much debated and has been thrown into doubt by the discovery of seeds belonging to the plant black henbane - *Hyoscyamus niger* in a Viking grave that was unearthed near Fyrkat, Denmark in 1977. An analysis of the symptoms caused by Hyoscyamus niger are also similar to the symptoms ascribed to the berserker state, which suggest it may have been used to generate their warlike mood.

Other explanations for the berserker's madness that have been put forward include self-induced hysteria, epilepsy, or mental illness, among other causes. One theory of the berserkers suggests that the physical manifestations of the berserker behaviour alongside their rage was a form of self-induced hysteria. Initiated before battle through a ritualistic process, also known as *effektnummer*, which included actions such as shield-biting and animalistic howling.

Jonathan Shay makes an explicit connection between the berserker rage of soldiers and the hyper arousal of post traumatic stress disorder. In *Achilles in Vietnam - Combat Trauma and the Undoing of Character*, he writes:

"If a soldier survives the berserk state, it imparts emotional deadness and vulnerability to explosive rage to his psychology and permanent hyper arousal to his physiology — hallmarks of post-traumatic stress disorder in combat veterans. My clinical experience with Vietnam combat veterans prompts me to place the berserk state at the heart of their most severe psychological and psycho physiological injuries."

### **Canada**

Late in 1992 a Canadian Airborne Regiment was sent to Somalia on a "Peace Enforcement" mission. As a consequence of this deployment the Canadian media sensationalised atrocities attributed to these soldiers to the point that the Airborne Regiment was disbanded in 1995. The real story of "conditioning for killing", or who stood to gain the most from the deployment to Somalia never comes out. Individual soldiers were sacrificed, not only during their deployment but afterwards as part of an ongoing psycho-political warfare against the service men and women and the nation of Canada. They are just fodder for psychological, political and financial purposes similar to our own service men and women of today. When Vikings took *Hyoscyamus niger* to place themselves into hyper-arousal for combat, it must also be a considered option of our own troops to overcome their natural aversion to killing another human being.

## Australia

## Afghanistan

In the case of the great natural gas and oil fields of Turkmenistan, immediately north of Afghanistan, the US government has for a decade (1990-2000-ed) strongly supported plans by US-led business groups for both an oil pipeline from Turkmenistan to the Arabian sea via Afghanistan and a gas pipeline from Turkmenistan across Afghanistan to Pakistan. Such pipelines would serve important US interests in a number of ways:

- Drawing the Central Asian oil states away from the Russian sphere of influence and establishing the foundation for a strong US position.
- Thwarting the development of Iranian regional influence by limiting Turkmenistan-Iranian gas links and thwarting a plan for a Turkmenistan-Iran oil pipeline to the Arabian Sea.
- Diversify US sources of oil and gas, and, by increasing production sources, help keep prices low.
- Benefiting US oil and construction companies with growing interests in the region.
- Providing a basis for much-needed economic prosperity in the region, which might provide a basis for political stability.

## Former Scottish first minister Alex Salmond lashes Howard, Blair over Chilcot findings on war in Iraq

Scotland's former first minister Alex Salmond has launched a scathing broadside at Tony Blair and his Western allies over the US-led invasion of Iraq in 2003, following the release of the damning Chilcot report.

And Mr Salmond has branded former Australian prime minister John Howard, Mr Blair's ally in the so-called 'coalition of the willing', a "great disappointment".



"I don't think I'd want my prime minister seeing his international role as nudging the British prime minister and saying, 'Have you thought of this way to get to war?'," Mr Salmond told Lateline.

"The Australian prime minister should be carving out their own independent course in the world with allies and standing up for Australia, not taking part in illegal international engagements," he added.

The inquiry's long-awaited report into the Iraq war strongly criticised former British prime minister Tony Blair and his government, saying they led the country into war based on flawed intelligence that should have been challenged.

For his part, Mr Howard has said that while he respected the findings, he did not agree with all of them.

"There was no lie. There were errors in intelligence, but there was no lie," Mr Howard said in response.

But Mr Salmond says the war was **"a disgraceful episode of the total misleading of a parliament."**

"Any parliament worth its salt, whether here in Westminster or in Scotland or in Australia, doesn't stand for being misled, particularly on an issue like peace and war which has caused such death or such casualties, such carnage we see now."
