HOLY WEEK By Arnis Luks

Holy Week is a time to pause and reflect. The 1994 video by KGB defector Yuri Bezmenov (available on our website), depicts the precarious position the West now finds itself. He shows how subversion of our culture, predominantly through the universities and then flowing to our leadership, has brought us to our knees. After a lifetime of taking the New World Order head-on by the Eric Butlers and Jeremy Lees of this world, we find ourselves at the point of civilisational collapse, and even now it is difficult to point the finger directly at the enemy. Yuri Bezmenov walks through the process of how it was done and how to counter the final outcome.

Today we find three eastern state governments limiting groups of more than two people. Even couples who live separately are having trouble ‘coupling’. One state has now shut its border completely. It is bizarre that the once tough Anzacs' progeny have forgotten what stock they come from. There appears to be no will to fight, the cross-generational demoralisation has been so comprehensive, having fed our youth to the 'ravens of this world'. We have lived to see the out-working of the "Parable of the Sower" from a spiritual and cultural perspective.

As Bezmenov states in the video, the only way back is an equal period of education and patriotic-nationalistic thinking. **Centralised-nationalism (Nazism) is little different than centralised-internationalism (Communism).** A period of reorientation, re-education, and focus on traditional family, community, our rich cultural heritage and then nationhood, would be fitting in this most holiest of seasons. None better than our online library.

I have been fortunate in placing copies of two important books into our online Library. ***“The Law of Civilisation and Decay”*** by Brooks Adams and ***“The Commonwealth Bank of Australia”*** by CC Faulkner. Brooks Adams highlights how the manipulation of finance, inflation-deflation, erosion of available coinage and other methods of financial manipulation, have been the final demise of many civilisations, placing the population under debt-bondage for generations. Our federal government through the taxation office, has just seconded 110,000 medical staff, handing over our medical system to direction from the World Health Organisation - UN. The government has also committed to finance 25% of the nation's workforce for the next six months. All on the basis of a fear not yet realised - pre-traumatic stress disorder. The government's promise of job-keeper allowance and other payments to businesses, if Yuri Bezmenov is correct, are the final steps of Marxist-Leninist communism being implemented for Australia. Promises with no intention of working through to conclusion, essentially bankrupting Australia and placing the whole population (through the ability to tax) into bondage to private debt merchants.

This brings us to the second book: CC Faulkner's depiction of *“The Commonwealth Bank of Australia”*, from the initial legislative act of 1911, until the printing of the book 1923. Under the directorship of Denison Miller, Australia was, through correct financial policy, able to process the entire First World War and exit it debt-free. During this era the People's Bank financed vast infrastructure projects, industry, farming and personal housing, all by long-term low-interest loans. Some loans not even requiring the repayment of principal.

Our federal government has just borrowed an unprecedented amount from the private money market and will place this nation into hock, perhaps (like the UK war debt) for 100 years, when it is completely unnecessary. This rapid expansion of the money supply, with no productive output from industry while we are in lockdown,

will produce massive inflation (for basics) and deflation (homes). This strategy will collapse our already enfeebled economy.

In this period of reflection and re-orientation, we look for what has happened successfully in the past and if we must take counsel, do so only from those with a proven record of success.

Trump calls the mainstream media MSM "fake news". Vested interests have also sponsored scholastic research in the universities since the earliest days of Rockefeller, who managed to produce what we now know as big-Pharma. Is it any wonder that the Therapeutic Goods Administration advising our federal government, will not look favourably at the efficacy of intravenous-vitamin-C for the latest seasonal virus? There is no profit to be found in therapy which cannot be patented nor licensed.

I recently received an email highlighting the current methodology of testing for coronavirus as deeply flawed, producing significant volumes of false-positives. The whole sordid mess is propaganda. Others have described the current situation in much stronger language.

Lindy Chamberlain's final defence was based on the 'flawed' scientific methodology of reagents in the presence of foetal blood. Vested interests initially put her in jail, but in the end tenacity and truth prevailed.

I watched the Yuri Bezmenov once more to consider the depth of what he was saying. The first is that we are in a state of ideological warfare with many fronts and have been so for more than 50 years. This long-term policy emanating through the universities and other places of learning, is reinforced by those educated classes who now occupy positions of significant influence, rendering the population demoralised (no moral anchor) and unable to come to any sensible conclusions. Where do 'you' place your hope or faith? Do you not see it yet?

Governments, acting in concert around the world, are now suggesting 'immunity passports' (free from the coronavirus), which will force medical-martial-law onto everyone - a certificate of compliance. The news cycle talks of suspending 'awards' and 'enterprise agreements'. This will escalate friction in the days ahead with the intention of moving towards a 'general strike' to collapse our country's economy completely. The communists have figured it all out.

Back to Basics - Power Vested in The People

Scrutiny, in these unprecedented times, of Government officials and representatives needs to be by 'the people', looking 'only at results achieved'. If it is directionally incorrect (results not achieved) then the official or representative needs pressure to change direction or be removed from office. We 'the people' need to take back 'power' to the only safe place - ourselves. For too long we

have allowed others to make decisions we should have made ourselves - why doesn't the government...?

The yellow vests in France campaigning for a whole year have now been taken from the MSM news cycle, Hong Kong the same, essentially censored out.

Our economy must be stabilised to allow us once again to be self-reliant. This can only be achieved by the re-introduction of the People's Bank - CBA - to include a National Dividend to balance Production-Prices with Consumption-Spending Power. Any inflationary pressures can be resisted with the re-introduction of a Consumer Price Discount which was utilised to stabilise prices of essential goods during the war years. This is not unprecedented, having been utilised once before to work through difficult times to conclusion.

The borrowing of enormous amounts of new debt by our government will be utilised predominantly to service existing loans and mortgages, including supporting the big end of town. Little will return to the real economy, but rather be cancelled out as repayment to the private money merchants - effectively endebting us further by way of future taxation to unprecedented levels. We will not be able to dig our way out of this one. Brookes Adams "*The Law of Civilisation and Decay*" has shown how this will end in a vale of tears. Do you not see it yet?

Freedom cannot be exercised effectively without political and personal responsibility. This could be achieved with the introduction of Citizens Initiative, Referenda and Recall, and then for the individual to also be accountable with the 'Responsible Vote'.

With police and military now at every corner and exit, they should be encouraged to turn back to upholding the law and not guarding us as 'in a prison'. Their primary function must be maintaining the stability of our nation and protection from destructive ideological influences. **Uncertainty - Property Prices Falling**

Home prices are on the way down, some predicting a 40% loss of value, which will dissolve any personal equity in the holdings. This will probably call for personal and private top-ups and perhaps lead to government Bank Bail-ins to cover the shortfall. Resolution, not Revolution

Large numbers of people today are, to some extent conscious of the existence of a power behind the political governments of the world. We have persistently warned our readers of that power and that the aim of the international financiers is to control the world.

Their design is to reinforce their control by destroying the sovereignty of the Government over vital functions of defence, such as naval and military forces and finance. The transfer of control of these functions to some form of Federal Union or World Government, mainly composed of alien internationalists, will satisfy their lust for possession of supreme and unchallengeable power.

The aim of British people all over the world is to retain and enhance the power and freedom of the individual in his private enterprise, his local institutions (embodying local characteristics and culture) and his local governments. The statement made by the Right Honourable F.M. The statement is an anachronism and a contradiction in terms. A "friend" is one in whom noble loyalty promotes a sense of the obligation to do his best for his kin, his fellow countrymen, his race. An "alien" is a stranger, not owing allegiance to the same sovereign. Without allegiance, an alien remains an alien. Any subordination, of the sovereignty of His Majesty the King outrages that allegiance which binds our people together. The word "allegiance" comes from the Latin word, "*ligaro*" to build. From that allegiance springs the demand that all soldiers and servants of the Crown shall swear to God of their fidelity to the cause of sovereignty.

As the infiltration methods of our secret enemies challenge our sovereignty, our courage may well "mounteth with occasion." Alert groups of "threes and fives" may serve their fellow Britishers in promoting action by all to instruct their parliamentary representatives to raise objection to a repulsive regulation in Parliament and, to demand that it shall be withdrawn immediately. ***

THE FEAR OF LEISURE An Address to the Leisure Society By A.R. ORAGE 1934

Extract: How these Money-tickets that come out of the Productive system get into the Productive system is a simple matter. They are put in, in the form of loans, by private Money-ticket factories, called Banks, which have an exclusive monopoly of Money-ticket manufacture.

We must surely have noticed in our tour of England's work-yard a number of elegant buildings to which some producers were always running to borrow tickets and others were running to return them. They are the Banks, where the Money-tickets come from, and to which they return.

Our immediate interest, however, is to compare the number of Money-tickets, not that are poured into industry, but that trickle to the shopping nation out of industry, with the Price-values created in the shop in the same period. Obviously if the Money-tickets issued to shopping England were the exact equivalent of the Price-values created by shop-keeping England, the collective Monetary Income of the nation would be able to buy the collective Price-value of the Goods produced.

We might dispute about the distribution of the tickets, but collectively, at least, there would be enough of them to buy our total Production.

The problem of equating the nation's means of Consumption with the nation's means of Production would be solved if every addition to Price-value resulted in an equal addition to Income. But what we find, in fact, is that the Monetary Income of the nation, derived from the Productive system in the form of Wages, etc., is not equivalent to the Price-values created in the same period. The two streams of Prices and Income do not move at the same rate and volume.

The stream of Price-values to the shop-window moves much faster than the stream of Money-tickets to the shopping public, with the result that the annual collective shopping tickets of the nation, called its Income, are insufficient to meet the collective annual Price-values created in its shop. Now this is a matter of fact and not of theory; and it can be proved by simple arithmetic.

Our shop-keeper, for instance, has told us that, at a rough estimate, our annual output of Price-values is ten thousand million pounds and probably more. And our taxing officials tell us, more accurately, that our annual Monetary Income is about two thousand five hundred million pounds. As four is to one, so is our output of Price-values to the Money-tickets with which to meet them.

The nation's means of Consumption measured in Money-tickets, in short, is at least no more than a quarter of its means of Production measured in Prices. Here, I believe, in this gap between Income and Prices, is the root-cause of our present difficulties.

On the two provable assumptions : (a) that the Money-tickets distributed as Income to shoppers are our only title to go shopping—that is, to live; and (b) that the total number of tickets distributed among us is only enough to meet a quarter of the Price-values of the Goods in our shop— we can easily understand why we have to fight each other for tickets; why everybody looks for employment in the factory or, alternatively, for somebody to give tickets to him; why there are always more Goods than Buyers; and finally, why no Socialist scheme for taxing the rich, no “Communist” or Fascist scheme for administering the workshop, and no amount of Planning of Production can be of the least use so long as this Gap between Prices and Incomes remains.

And when we add that this gap is constantly widening with the progressive relative depopulation of the Productive system you will realise that our progress is towards the absurdity of a Maximum of Production and a Minimum of Consumption. Only, long before then, something will happen; something will break, as, in fact, it is breaking all around us. ***
