REWARDS AND PUNISHMENT - ARE THESE OUR ONLY OPTIONS? By Arnis Luks

This week Russian President Vladimir Putin gave a speech at the Valdai International Discussion Club. He then comfortably sat through several hours of questioning. The English translation appeared and then disappeared from many websites. One translation is placed onto our front page for the record. He is a man of formidable physical and mental stamina on full public display. I carefully read the English translation of the speech and found nothing offensive nor surprising. His political orientation is to preserve, protect and advance his nation and its ancient and diverse culture, and to dismantle world hegemony by building alternatives with others. I took a deep breath and then began to consider our own nation and our own cultural leadership and where they are taking us. I see no one of this calibre on the horizon, whose love of the nation and our culture shines through. **Mimicry**

Dan Andrews appears to be a sure foot-in for the next Victorian election because the people are offered nothing and unwilling to make sufficient personal effort to lift themselves out of their own political and cultural quagmire. I know of no individual who is speaking Truth to the people of Victoria. Correct me if I have missed something or someone here who is speaking Truth to power. Is there a beacon of Truth out there for Australia I have missed?

The Victorian opposition leader Matthew Guy demonstrates a desire to outmanoeuvre the existing Labor incumbent by accelerating the Green agenda even faster. He is simply mimicking the former Prime Minister Scott Morrison's disastrous election strategy. There is no political opposition. The Liberals are consumed with the progressive agenda and offer little variance to the existing Labor/Socialist government. They are happy to lay down and hand political power back to the already-selected-leader Dan. Harsh words maybe, but I am not alone. What happens every day forward in the political life of Victoria is far more important than this election's probably already pre-determined result. Victorians are going to receive a continuation of the same political distress as is the remainder of Australia.

In Britain the leader of the Labour Party Sir Keir Starmer is awash across mainstream media outlets welcoming Bill Gates inside the Parliamentary building. The elites are preparing the ground for a Labour victory at the next general election in Great Britain (due May 2024). The Conservative leader Rishi Sunak, as current Prime Minister, is simply a place-holder until the next general election. I do not expect the Tories to last until then. The elite are manoeuvring Sir Keir Starmer into the public gaze to ensure their man, who will be promoting their policies, does exactly as they expect. The public will be allowed to go through the political process of voting, but the outcome is already assured. British Conservatives will be (in the mind of the public) run-down to a state of even greater incompetency by the MSM. USA midterm elections demonstrate a similar pattern. The public are being kept mesmerised by all forms of media. Can the crowd / public awaken from their perpetual slumber of indifference while continually being fed a diet of beer and circuses?

We are offered little choice through the voting franchise. The mainstream media (which completely dominates the major political parties) have the power-game operating entirely in their area of the court. We have our own forms of Pravda that is alive and well throughout Australia's, Britain's and USA's mainstream/social media outlets.

We just don't readily recognise the mainstream media as the actual controlling Bastion of government policy. Industry and media are concentric (share the same centre, the larger often completely surrounding the smaller). Combined, they control the entire political processes. Britain readily illustrated the real seat of power by the revolving door of Prime Ministerships. Pakistan similarly with the sacking of Imran Khan. Australia reinforced also with the same revolving door across Labor and Liberal Prime Ministerships not that long ago. This branch of media/industry-controlled-government is privately owned and holds no election for its position of significant political influence. We go through the process every few years of having elections, but the policies don't change.

Our own leadership, across civic, political, industrial and faith institutions, are all products of a perverted and specialised indoctrination centre we call education, who hold no great love towards our nation nor our cultural heritage. Through gender/social studies, history, sociology and other forms of psychological manipulation our own children are being prepared for the future slave state. We don't even contain the necessary resolve to withdraw our progeny from this cesspit of indoctrination. The demoralisation of Australia, being the final stage of Communist subversion, is almost complete. The election process will not avert this imminent disaster. 'What's in it for me' will continue to produce the same political results.

In my life experiences I have usually been the rootcause of my own personal discomfort. At these times, I turned towards God to help me work through my selfinflicted dilemmas. As I've gained in years, these selfinflicted dilemmas have become less frequent. Part of this is because I spend time seeking Truth, or God if you like.

Ted Rock wrote an essay titled 'The Christian Roots of Social Credit': https://alor.org/Storage/Library/Rock%20 E%20-%20Religious%20Discussion.htm In this work, the application of God's Grace as a consequence of man accepting his Divine calling is in contradistinction to the doctrine of Rewards and Punishment. If only I had recognised that Truth (Canon - Natural Law) I could have saved myself a lot of personal discomfort. Being who I am, unfortunately, this question did not readily enter my thought processes until much later in life after significant pain. The incarnation (the Word becoming Flesh in our

life) is an attempt to describe acceptance of this Divine calling, which means, if it means anything, getting up each day and asking God what it is He would have me do? Prof Jordan Peterson presented a similar message in his title '12 Rules For Life'. He reinforced the need to tidy up our own bedroom first. It starts exactly where we are, with the people we are involved with, and continues every day, giving up self to do God's Will. I believe God wants Victorians and all Australians to choose Truth by incarnating their faith into good works. We have all been given a free will to do just that - or not.

There is also the pressing need to agree as to what that 'good is' that we are to seek out. Our Colloquial Culture

I often heard war stories of the Australian diggers' resourcefulness, mostly due to their inherent characteristic of disrespecting any form of authority. To him whom much is given, much is required...* These are all scriptural Truths identifying our unique differences and peculiar callings. Individual Initiative knows no bounds, and is only limited by our own imagination.

The thought of an invasion in 1914, and again in 1939, and the need to defend our nation came steadily to most, despite great fear. The truth of war, those that manipulated and exploited the situation for personal gain, those that sent millions to their untimely death, has been told but few have learnt from these horrid lessons.

In my youth I held a dissenting view from the crowd. A teacher once polled our class as to how we might vote ON TARGET Pa and found in the wash-up that I voted differently from all the others. Asking me why, I answered that my father taught me to think a little differently than most others. Gustav Le Bon and Rene Girard both wrote of this phenomenon of crowd behaviour - wanting the security of conformity. CH Douglas indicated that our uniqueness is demonstrated by our own ability to separate ourselves from the crowd, to step away rather than conform.

René Girard illustrates across his many book titles the human traits of the scapegoat, desire and mimicry. The scapegoat, Girard argues, is the ancient psychological practice of human sacrifice whereby civilisations are founded upon some kind of utopia. Experiencing differing forms of dictatorships, that 'threatened purge' is only ever a heartbeat away. Ukraine could intensify to a nuclear hot war at a moment's notice. The Chinese may be experiencing purging right now, but due to media censorship we won't hear about it. The Donbass experienced the loss of 14,000 lives since the Ukraine revolution 2014. Europe holds the potential to walk into a world war should the military-industrial-complex and the money powers get their way. We dare not consider the many millions of unborn and elderly or infirmed who are destroyed every year, and yet we think nothing of it. We can so easily and readily slip into this mindset of the scapegoat (someone else), providing it is not ourselves. Hosea 6:6 For I desired mercy, and not sacrifice: and the knowledge of God more than holocausts (offerings-ed)

The crowd, which is an archetypical representation of us all, called for the crucifixion (sacrifice) of the Christ. **Desire**

Marketing-masters tailor their message to draw upon what are these great human weaknesses, but it goes much deeper than that. In my early working days I found myself in a hotbed of Socialists and Communist's alike. At an impetuous moment I asked one bloke why he was a Communist? He candidly replied 'I want some of 'their' money'. I assume 'they' is anybody who has more money than this highly paid tradesmen.

Interestingly, the ABC staff hold strong socialist credentials, and, I assume, hold a similar world view while being the most highly paid careerists.

Robert Kearns, a mechanical engineer, developed the intermittent windshield wiper. Shortly after, both Ford and Chrysler began using his invention without giving him credit. Kearns successfully sued both companies for millions. Both Ford and Chrysler stole this invention and were obviously prepared to take their chances. Ethics (desire) didn't enter the equation. The public, similarly, desired this intermittent wiper device.

I was directed towards the latest catalogue from an electronics store which highlighted most items ranging from multi-hundreds to multi-thousands of dollars. I'm sure most people could survive quite well without possessing any of these items. Desire is a most insidious human frailty. The roaring 1920s, prior to the great depression, was a time of material plenty with great confidence that nothing was going to change – until it did. Must we wait until the coming doom occurs? What to do in regard to the upcoming Victorian election.

The current representatives seeking re-election have failed the Victorian public. They have individually and collectively neglected to hold the state Executive to account across the lockdown and accepted the dictatorship of Dan Andrews with barely a murmur. Far from protecting the Victorian public, by their silence they are complicit having supported the tyranny. They were not demonstrating (or any other such thing) on street corners against these impositions of the loss of our health freedoms.
