## THE SEASONS By Arnis Luks

Festivals have traditionally aligned with the ebb and flow of the seasons, the natural world once reflected within most Christian calendars. This past weekend marked the spring equinox for the southern hemisphere. Interestingly, I searched across the internet looking for a traditional Christian calendar to mark the festival-naturalworld correlation with the Scriptures. I saw the syncretism of a world religion permeated throughout most mainline Christian calendars. The dark lords certainly have infiltrated every corner.

Prior to refrigeration, storage of foods was achieved by salting, or preserving using fermentation. Producing silage from various grain/grass crops, ensured a food supply for stock across the cold non-producing winter months. Prior to the Industrial Revolution whereby man's physical strength was superseded by his ingenuity and harnessing of solar energy, the volume of local food production was limited by the physical strength of man and animals to produce food. This has been superseded by modern technology, advancements within the industrial arts, and expansive transportation systems perhaps by a factor of 1000 to 1.

The marking of the seasons within a calendar, anchors or orientates man to his physical environment of the earth and the natural rhythms. The earth provides our sustenance, and we experience the constant processes, of creation of new life, the harvest, and then death (returning to the soil). We can't avoid observing the natural world and adhering to its rhythms. We can't plant dryland crops in the North or Southern polar regions. We can't successfully plant summer crops in winter, nor vice versa. When the First Fleet arrived at Botany Bay, the growing season was inverted from the northern hemisphere cycle. They had to accept and adjust to suit the natural rhythms and cycles of this new world.

Mankind attempting to deny, or worse still, defy the natural world, will only ensure his actual demise. A significant amount of northern hemisphere flora and fauna were successfully transitioned to the Australian climatic conditions. One successful example was the European honey bee (Apis mellifera). South Australian honey production is some of the most prolific in the world. I hear or read of hives in England producing perhaps 1 or 2 kg

A friend's harvest just these past few days has resulted in perhaps half a tonne of honey for the first take of the season from their backyard hobby. This is a wonderful result which is perhaps the 'best opening-take I have seen' for the previous 10 years. This has occurred because of good husbandry, the right environmental circumstances due to a solar minimum (a cyclic period of low sunspot activity), a mild-temperate climate, and the prolific amount of eucalypt in flower. Last season there was little flower, and I harvested no honey at all from our hives.

### Mankind's Un-natural World View

The world powers (the elite) are economically shutting down the West, but simultaneously accelerating the Third World East. This is occurring because of their domination over the fraudulent financial system injecting their own policy into the economy. It is not a phenomenon of the natural world, but rather the elite's un-natural engagement with controlling 'all of mankind'. Climate change, sustainability and all the other cult words are simply the financial witchdoctor's black magic to mesmerise the West, to no longer look towards the natural world for God's bounty. The witchdoctor is not just present within the many forms of the mainstream media, but heavily entrenched within the occupied territories of the churches. This cult of pagan-humanism is overshadowing the entire world, while consolidating their control even within the various branches of many religions.

BRICS nations are earmarked for ascendancy, and if news reports are correct, China's Navy is now superior in total numbers to the USA's. There is no physical reason why the USA is not producing more naval vessels, only, a direct outcome of financial policy. They, the controllers of central bank policy, are the real dark lords who rule this world. When governments abrogated their constituted responsibility over finance, banking and insurance, they surrendered sovereignty of their own nations to this world power. The fact that this is never openly discussed, further reinforces the surrendering of what are the adequately constituted powers of the various national governments.

There is no physical reason whatsoever why Australia cannot have a ship building industry, an adequate defence forces supplied from our own manufacturing bases like South Australia once had, its own legitimate commonwealth scientific and industrial research organisation, and its own legitimate bureau of meteorology that factually reports on the state of the world. It is only financial policy imposed over our governments that perverts our view of the real world. Uncovering to Discover

The discovery of the methods-of-control-of-heatenergy, firstly from coal to steam, then oil to steam, steam to electricity and now nuclear to steam to electricity, each has increased the total energy resources available for mankind. In our delusional and pagan belief, we are building giant wind turbines and solar farms, huge-batteries that only protect the energy supply of a city for a few minutes, and larger and larger interconnectors, all of which are to centralise control of the production of electrical energy, while we are shutting down local manufacturing, powered by local generating facilities, supplied with local sources of various fuels.

The most efficient boilers ever to produce electrical power, only ever achieve about an 80% efficiency of the available heat-energy-conversion to steam-power-generated. Electrical Power Generation also produces heat, which causes further losses from this original fuel to steam ratio of 80%. Transmitting power across power lines further produces losses. Actual power available at the worksite can be as little as 30% of the heat energy produced from the original boiler.

The products of combustion are CO2 and water vapour, both forms of plant food. Having worked in the gas fields at Moomba SA, I can vouchsafe that there was no scorched earth in that vicinity, nor is there scorched earth near the Adelaide gas fired power station on Torrens Island, nor in Gippsland, Victoria where brown and black coal is used to generate power.

Looking at the seasons and the natural ebb and flow

of the cycles of the earth, I conclude there is nothing out of order, except those monstrosities in the paddocks or offshore that look like alien towers, or those mirrors working at most <30% of the time. So, it becomes a 30% of 30% at best, if the sun is shining and the wind is blowing above 20 knots. Sufficient are they?

What is physically available and sourced locally, like iron ore, coal, port facilities and a ready workforce, is the most energy efficient system that can be devised - not requiring transport, nor further efficiency-losses by delivering to and fro, and then finally on to market. This observed reality minimises our actual and real environmental footprint, measured in terms of lifecycle-energy-requirements.

CSIRO and BOM are missing in action as scientific institutions, having yielded a long time ago to Gaia under former NSW Labor Premier Neville Wran's directorship.

Port Augusta, with fuel (coal or gas) power-generation, steel and ship building with a ready port facility, along with multiple car plants and whitegoods manufacturers located nearby, was the most energy efficient industrial area in Australia. No need to transport energy nor raw materials from Western Australia to China, and then back again after manufacturing was completed. Green humbug came from non-sense policies that first kicked off under Liberal PM Malcolm Fraser in 1975. Yet, that is what we are doing in the name of Gaia - the ancient Greek goddess of the earth.

The total CO2 production from mankind is increasing. It is not dissipating, but rather increasing to produce this miss-worded 'environmentally sustainable' means of producing electrical energy. If we built skyscrapers in the bush, and after 25 years left them there to rot, this would make as much sense from the nonsense we are doing.

These policies are devoid of rational thought considering the life-cycle of each monstrosity to save the planet. Electric cars that spontaneously ignite are only the tip of the iceberg of environmental-scandal. The amount of energy consumed to source and extract the raw material, then transport to the refining destination, convert into a useful material for production, produce the end object whether it be a wind turbine, a solar panel, or a battery for a green car, the life-cycle energy requirement is greater than what can be done within existing conventional methods - locally. To a climate zealot this is unexplainable, even if you physically walk them around the environmental-disaster of Port Augusta.

### Monopoly

Private bankers have their own personal mint which does not appear in notes and coins, but rather as 'debt to them' in the form of loans, incurred by all governments, all industry and all individuals. "I want one of those!" in ever increasing volume until by volume alone the want reaches maximum expression. "I WANT ONE!"

At the earliest age the bawling of the infant is the only way that they can communicate, getting louder and louder until the nappy is changed, the hunger is satiated, or the comfort is given. Oh, for the simple wants of a baby!

As growing children learn to talk, it transforms into the quotes above.

At a teenage level, if you've done something half right, they are merely testing their boundaries and developing their own sets of limits (which inevitably will clash with yours at times)

Growing up is a process that can be hard on both children and parents, yet we've managed to do it, for better or worse, since the beginning of time. The resultant society will often reflect this, and parenting methods will become a discussion for a while.

Logic, calm and responsibility thrown back on them, usually allows this development to mature. That and a good example to follow, did Mum and Dad argue?, raise their voices to win an argument?, or did they discuss it and come to a mutual decision? Did the explanations of these decisions make sense?

At school we practised debating for a while, developing arguments and responses. That process along with some public speaking are some of the best tools I developed during my education.

The rules for debating follow through to life, in almost all interactions between adults and with your children when they are old enough to understand.

When you meet someone new and start up a discussion,

you won't always see eye to eye on everything, it would be strange if you did. We don't raise our voices, hold our breath, or chant something over and over until that person agrees! At least I hope not!

A bulldog fan meets a colly-wobble, does it descend into a shouting match, "mine is better than yours", sometimes? never? Well! I would never say never! Usually you discuss the game, rivalries, players and how you'll thrash the pants off them next time you clash. In the finish, you agree to disagree. Such is rivalry.

Sadly, in politics, things appear to have taken a turn in a downward direction. Many of the inmates in the big house look like good candidates for a finishing school or a live-in Nanny!

Or perhaps they need to shift back in with Mum and Dad for a little while, so they can be reminded of what good behaviour looks like.

Perhaps the voters in their electorates could mail them a copy of "*The Rules of Debating*" along with a letter suggesting they lift their game. Children are watching and they are learning bad habits!

The last few years have really brought home to me the extent of the problem.

Since I was a teenager, Dad always had Parliament question time tuned in on ABC radio. Blaring out while we were fencing or at other farm chores when the ute was nearby. I can distinctly remember comments about, "playing the man, not the argument" and what a weak personality it showed. As a summary debater I would pick up on these things. Yes indeed, no counter argument at all, did not address the topic, no logical rebuttal. Very poor marks for that one!

Question time is now televised and available online to view, has been for some time. You can imagine my horror as I watch live debates going on. You should try it sometime, it will give you a new respect (or not) for some of our elected employees.

Serious topics are raised and discussed, looked at for clarity and truth, finding out by rational discussion if we've considered all the angles carefully, all the reasons 'Yes', and all the reasons 'No'. Hang on! Is that the case? **Zoom In** 

The chamber is virtually empty, just the speaker of the house (he has to be there) and a smattering of others, usually those in support of the member who has the floor. **OR** 

As the member rises to speak, he is introduced by the speaker, there is (PAN ABOUT) a quick exodus of the chamber. Emptied faster than a hospital chamber pot. Despite legitimate concerns contained in the coming

speech, no one wants to listen! Is this why we need a

voice?

WE pay these employees of ours to do a job, part of that is to carefully consider each proposal, to look at the arguments and make decisions based on facts and the impact it would have on their particular electorate
