Eric Mercola has more recently produced a second Burzynski documentary titled 'Cancer is Serious Business' here: https://estore.burzynskimovie.com/ an exposé of the FDA and its incestuous relationship with Big Pharma.

Burzynski's FDA medically-approved trials and treatment methodology continues to demonstrate its efficacy against cancer. Big Pharma has been and still is doing all that they can to destroy him, the clinic, and any chance of providing a legitimate treatment that may impact on their own lucrative side-lines. The motive is purely economic and a demonstration of why monopoly can be so pervasive and evil once in place.

Rightly so does the Catholic church, through their Encyclicals, equally-condemn both capitalism and communism. Both are forms of political and economic tyranny as quickly becomes obvious.

I found this relevant recognising the validity of the comment 'Under the Capitalist Sun, Nothing is Sacred'. Big-pharma, chemo, radiation and the jab all readily come to mind, as does the pursuit of war by the military-industrial complex. Both are in fact of the same pedigree, e.g. Zyclone B and Roundup.

I'm not a fan of *Sky News* being a Murdoch (monopolist) enterprise, however, the demonstration of biased-reporting and preconceived-tactics from 'our' ABC is worth a look at, if for no other reason than to see their bias and methodology in action.

Consensus is not science, but rather pseudoscience. We live in an age of the 'Uniparty' and 'Hopium'. The public constantly being psychologically nudged to support one or the other of the major political parties every election cycle in our hope that things will be better. But they never are. It is just more of the same by both majors.

## On The Road - Report

The first ALOR meeting (of a greater Australian-wide tour) occurred in Angaston, South Australia the previous Tuesday. Victorian meetings will commence in a few short weeks, with WA to follow soon after. Concerned members of the public were keenly interested in hearing the National Director's report.

Australia is in a perilous state of affairs with the Director calling on every person to perform their civic duty. I am of the view that our circumstances, while perilous, are also a significant opportunity that must be seized upon.

In discussions with the folk at Angaston, the issue of a regional hospital and medical facilities came up. In SA's capital Adelaide, we have experienced the new face of 'health', with the billion-dollar centralised hospital. Towards the southern suburbs of Adelaide, we have also experienced the ever-expanding medical training facilities of Flinders University and other associated hospitals. The face of health in South Australia is virtually and practically a monopoly.

While this medical monopoly provides little obvious regional re-solution for Angaston, it does afford that community a real chance to take a serious look at natural health as a viable alternative to monopolised-medicine. The Barossa region, which Angaston is very much a part of, is the wine heartland of oldest repute. In the 1960s living in Geelong, Victoria, I had a neighbour who went on a bus tour to the Barossa Region, South Australia just to experience the acres upon acres of vineyards, wineries, and small townships. She came back with the most vivid memories willingly described to all the children asking about her holiday.

I often drive past Vineyards heading south to the Fleurieu Peninsula and look to the base of the vines to see if they have been sprayed or cultivated to suppress the weed growth. This observation of weed management gives me some idea as to whether the vines are spray-free or not, which becomes a point of consideration regarding purchasing the fruit of the vine from that estate.

A recent phone conversation about Bill Mollison's Permaculture and the methodologies utilised within this and others, such as the Keyline Landscape discipline. As is realistic with available time, we practice it within

our own gardens at home. The observation in weed management becomes part of seeking out those sources of agricultural produce we desire.

The Burzynski article has caused me to think a little further. This Permaculture approach could be a huge opportunity for the folk at Angaston should they choose to seize upon, firstly for their own pursuit of health, and extending it further, as an advertised advantage to increase their own market share. I am sure with the significant sacking of medical staff due to their refusal to accept the mandated-jab, that there would be ample local-community support for a project of this nature. We either accept medical-monopoly, or we take deliberate steps to minimise the effects of that tyranny.

#### Vale Bill Carey

Normally the passing of ALOR stalwarts is memorialised within the *NewTimes Survey* journal, however this week's major theme is regarding two passed stalwarts who have led as 'an example of community-minded-activists' for others to emulate.

**Operation BankWatch:** Bill Carey and Jim Cronin, both from Eyre Peninsular, South Australia were instrumental in establishing the Operation BankWatch action group in the late 1980s. Several extended droughts and adverse harvests had forced large numbers of Eyre Peninsula farmers to the wall. Continuous revolution isn't only occurring against the traditional family and values. It is also occurring across our economy. An economically strong middle-class provides a genuine counter-measure against monopolised tyranny. Small business is more efficient overall, and able to implement innovation more readily. Transnational corporations on the other hand, are similar to big government with big bureaucracy. The middle-class are the legitimate backbone and the real strength of our national economy.

The Adani coalmine as a reflection of monopoly, provides little real benefit for the nation of Australia. A few hundred jobs, while multiple billions worth of minerals are taken out of the country. The infrastructure providing services for this monopolised exploitation are the legitimate strength of our economy. They are the ones who place substantial amounts of money into the pockets of Australian families. The roads, railways, utilities, ports are all part of this infrastructure which derives little financial benefit for all Australians from this exploitation, yet is that necessary heart of the economy that allows the exploitation to occur. The saying 'a self-made man' is an absurdity. The institutions, culture and civic amenities all

allow some to thrive. Monopolists only concentrate on themselves and their exploitation of these services while the public derive little real or financial benefit. I travel the country each year and see further and further expansion of the exploitation of our mineral reserves and our rivers, while more-advanced machinery and technology are utilised to produce the saleable commodities for profit. Come with me and I will point them out to you as we travel.

#### **Lima Declaration**

Most of Australia's industry and manufacturing has gone overseas due to centralist policy emanating from the United Nations. Both major parties have supported this since the mid-70s, with the Liberals leading the charge under Prime Minister Malcolm Fraser and then Treasurer John Howard. The end result of which we find today, is very little of legitimate primary industry remains on Australian soil, the downgrading of real incomes, and national dependence on overseas suppliers, with the ever expanding corporatised state under the public/private partnerships and transnational trade agreements.

Peta Credlin is making noises about the greenleftist corporatist state, but neglects to highlight those monopolistic-policy-roots go firmly into the Liberal camp. The Liberals put this policy into effect, which have come to a head under the TPP Trans-Pacific Partnership trade agreements that, thanks to the Franklin Dam High Court decision, are now considered superior to our Constitution as being the supreme law of this land. Australia as a nation can be taken to the world court and be adjudicated under these trade agreements by judges appointed by the Bank of International Settlements and the World Bank. Prior to this 1983 High Court finding, the supreme law of the nation of Australia was /is our Commonwealth Constitution. The major political parties collaborating together brought this about, which Peta Credlin, who as head of the Prime Minister's Department under Liberal PM Tony Abbott, now remains silent.

The Sovereign Australia movement is somewhat legitimate with their claim of Admiralty Law existing through our courts. Transnational Trade agreements can impoverish the economy of a nation as has been done in Pakistan's case, (former cricketer and now politician Imran Khan thrown in prison for opposing). In a very real and practical sense he was denied natural justice - access to any legitimate defence and subsequently sentenced to imprisonment without trial immediately prior to the elections now having taken place in Pakistan.

Donald Trump may find himself in similar circumstances. The International Centre for Settlement of Investment Disputes is an international arbitration institution established in 1966 for legal dispute resolution and conciliation between international investors and States. ICSID is part of and funded by the World Bank Group, headquartered in Washington, D.C., in the United States. The World Bank Sanctions Board, composed of seven

(7) external judges, is an independent administrative tribunal that serves as the final decision-maker in all contested cases of sanctionable misconduct in development projects financed by the World Bank.

### Under the Capitalist Sun, Nothing is Sacred

Dr Stanislaw R. Burzynski nor Imran Khan are exceptions to this rule that <u>nothing is sacred</u> in the way of profit or political power. They are both examples of this pursuit for profit and political power.

I find it incredulous, *difficult to believe*, that PHON Sen Malcolm Roberts and other Neoliberal and Libertarians cannot see the evil within this. Perhaps they have never had it pointed out to them that the nature of reality is always Trinitarian - free, moral and responsible. In this instance the immoral and irresponsible factors are compelled to give way to *laissez-faire*. Basically, and in fact, corporatised anarchy.

We are social beings, and in this modern age of the advanced industrial arts, manufacturing and production have become a social function. We don't need a massive workforce that consumes every free moment of every available body, but rather, we are able to set the machines to work, which allows, or should allow, each person a claim upon the fruit of these modern productive processes. The purpose of production, its reason for existence, it's *locus standi* – is consumption. The financial system, is in no way under its existing monopolised existence, geared to reflect this principle of reality. Every Australian government since at least 1924 has pandered to this money-monopoly rather than represent the best interests of the people and the nation of Australia. Not the custodians/possessors of money, but rather the creators-out-of-nothing of all new money. This greatest of all monopolies, also happens to appoint those same judges to that ultimate world court that adjudicate nations standing against corporate entities and their orgy of the pursuit of profit and political power.

As written previously, the Catholic Encyclicals equally condemn both capitalism and communism as abhorrently evil, which they are.

Both deny the scriptural Truths from the utterances of the Christ (in red), that:

Systems are made to serve man(kind), Not man(kind) made to serve systems.
