DEBAUCH THE PEOPLES TO EXPLOIT THEIR LAND By Arnis Luks

I have started to read '*200 Years Together*' by Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn. The tome of some nearly 800 pages, comes in the original Russian and an 'authorised' French translation. I was reading an 'un-authorised' English translation. There are several un-authorised English PDF versions available for download. One appears to be in print, although I could not locate it, here: Russo-Jewish History – *Two Hundred Years Together* by Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn pdf here: <https://archive.org/details/200YearsTogether>

Solzhenitsyn's work is timely and necessary to balance the almost daily articles from the major media outlets regarding persecution experienced by the Jewish peoples. This is while the displacement (by bombing and killing) of the original, some two millennia at least, Palestinian people occurs.

The history of the Russo-Jewish peoples, and the many, many efforts by their leaders to accommodate 60% of the world's Jewish population is a story in itself. This gross hypocrisy of a personal gain brings me back to Solzhenitsyn's: '*200 Years Together*' describing the same scourge against the Russian peasants, at the time of famine, was the conversion of grain into alcoholic spirits that further debilitated those Russian nationals. A similar policy during the 'Opium Wars' over China; this occurs whenever peoples are to be subjugated by an foreign power, or internal revolution to place their puppets

into power. The drugs of dependence may vary over time, but the purpose remains the same: to break down their civic and cultural cohesion – for future subjugation. Both the Russo-native landlords and the merchants were equally at fault for this policy of societal destruction, working in collaboration against the Russian peasants’ resolve to resist this drug of debilitation.

LUDICROUS: ABSURD, RIDICULOUS, LAUGHABLE. FROM THE LATIN *LUDICRUM* STAGE-PLAY – By Neville Archibald

Oh, I love the English language, it has borrowed much and has an appropriate word for almost anything. It has been used in plays and abused in songs, used confusingly in courts and deceptively in politics. It is the last of these that I am looking at today.

The race for world control was always considered by the mainstream as a kooky theory, a conspiracist's mad nightmare. Yet so many of our classic plays, so many historical observations have been penned about political intrigue and corruption. The works of Shakespeare, Machiavelli, more recently Arendt and Solzhenitsyn and many others. In real life, the many intrigues of great nations present themselves for scrutiny over and over again in history. Somehow though, we are expected to believe that in this, our time, that all are figments of the unhinged among us.

That time has passed! Unless you are locked away

never to see the light of day, it cannot be helped that you will witness these events. The more aware of you with better memories, or those directly affected by events, will be seeing more as the process continues. These things you see, you must call out! We have Shakespeare’s Mad King Lear, senile and ageing and refusing to give up his throne, despite falls, lost lines and forgetting why he’s there. Then we see someone, often termed the leader of the free world, the US president who looks to run a second term. Where is the outcry, the demand for money back as the show deteriorates into a sitcom series worthy of the best imaginative minds.

Closer to home, my classic, is the promise by our then Victorian Premier, Dan Andrews, of two weeks to flatten the curve while we build four thousand more ICU beds. His “stand-alone conversion of a big space into what would be one of the biggest intensive care units in our country, perhaps anywhere in the world”, never eventuated. His promises at that time seemed far-fetched to me, but this compensation for the lock-down pain he was imposing, conned many into not resisting his amazing overreach of power. His back-flip and denial of ever promising this, was nothing short of astounding to me, yet people still continued to love him and very few in the press even bothered to denounce it.

Not long after, figures showed that Victoria had not actually increased beds at all over this difficult time, but that they had in fact decreased, from 516 before the pandemic, to 476. Andrews, involved in politics in the health portfolio for many years was well positioned to know what was possible. For people in the grip of fear (largely media and government induced) not to demand some form of accountability, still leaves me at a loss for words. He got to leave office on his terms after he was ready, our hospital system is still in turmoil and the blame still being apportioned to Covid alone.

I try to imagine a playwright capable of turning these things into classics, or a foe whose ability to mimic comes close. Perhaps I just haven’t read enough. At what point does the ludicrous become enough to cause a reaction. This is not a play we can walk out of, we are a part of it. We need to loudly proclaim it is ours, the scriptwriters are in our employ, we are the directors, we should be calling CUT. ***
