

To research *Prophecy and Politics*, Grace Halsell went on Holy Land tours sponsored by Jerry Falwell and she attended the first Christian Zionist Congress held in the Basel, Switzerland auditorium where 88 years earlier Theodore Herzl had called the first Jewish Zionist Congress.

The book traces the development, beginning in 1967, of the powerful alliance between the state of Israel and the TV evangelists. Grace Halsell has covered both the Korean and Vietnam wars as a journalist, was a White House speechwriter for Pres Lyndon Johnson, and has written 10 books, among them the well received *Soul Sisters*, and *Journey to Jerusalem*. A native of Texas, she lives in Washington, DC. Militant TV evangelists are preaching that a nuclear holocaust is inevitable, and their message is influencing top-level governmental leaders in the US, Israel and elsewhere.

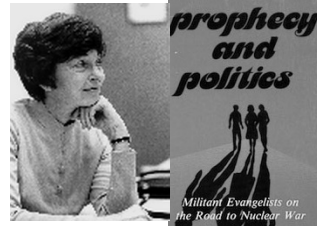
Reaching an estimated 60 million Americans, charismatic war-minded evangelists insist that they have the right and power to help orchestrate not only their End of Times, but doomsday for all the rest of the species.

As the rising stars of the New Christian Right and the Republican Party, these militant conservatives seemingly have unlimited financial resources, a site in Israel for “the last great battle” and a line of reasoning for a nuclear war - because God wills it. They preach, promote and actually sell Americans on the idea of building more bombs and then using them to destroy Planet Earth.

As one of the estimated 18 million Americans who reportedly read Hal Lindsay’s *The Late Great Planet Earth*, Ronald Regan began public musings as early as 1971 that indicated his apparent acceptance of a biblical interpretation of prophecy holding that a nuclear war is inevitable.

Along with Hal Lindsay, TV evangelists Pat Robertson, Jimmy Swaggart, Jerry formal, Jim Bakker, Oral Roberts, Kenneth Copeland, Richard De Haan and Rex Humbard, all preached that only a nuclear war will bring Christ back to earth. Convinced that God has fore-ordained that precisely those of us living in this generation must wage the battle of Armageddon, they tell their millions of listeners that we can do nothing to prevent the ultimate holocaust. Arms negotiations, they insist are useless and any talk of peace is “heresy”.

This is not another book about religious “kooks” and fanatics. It is a frightening expose; a book of major historical and political significance for everyone who dreams of a peaceful nuclear-free world.

Major Clifford Hugh Douglas,
 M.I.Mech.E., M.I.E.E., consulting engineer,
 economist, author, and founder of the Douglas
 Social Credit Movement, was born in 1879
 and died in 1952. Among other posts which
 he held in his earlier years were those of
 engineer with the —
 Canadian General Electric company,
 Peterborough, Canada, — Assistant Engineer,
 Lachine Rapids Hydraulic Construction,
 Deputy Chief Electrical Engineer, Buenos
 Aires, and Pacific Railway;
 Chief Engineer and Manager in India British
 Westinghouse Company;
 Assistant Superintendent, Royal Aircraft
 Factory Farnborough (GB).



During the First World War he was a Major in the Royal Flying Corps and later in the
 R.A.F. (Reserve).
 After retiring from his engineering career, he and his wife ran a small yacht-building
 yard on Southampton Water for several years.
 The combination of beauty with functional efficiency in a successfully designed racing
 yacht had a special appeal for him.
 When he lived in an old water mill in Hampshire he used the water wheel to turn a
 dynamo which lit and warmed the house as well as providing power for lathes and other
 tools. Later, when he moved to Scotland, many of his friends and followers remember
 helping to build his small hydro-electric-powered house, sited on the local burn which
 ran through his land. Since decentralisation of economic power was of the essence of
 his teaching, it should be put on record that he practised what he preached.
 One of his most interesting jobs, just before the 1914 War, was that of conducting
 preliminary experimental work and preparing plans and specifications for the electrical
 work on the Post Office Tube in London, with later supervision of the installation of
 plant in what was to be one of the earliest examples of complete automation in the
 history of engineering.

Institutions exist to serve Individuals

Accepting this statement (*systems were made for man, and not men for systems*)

as a basis of constructive effort, it seems clear that all forms, whether of government,
 industry or society must exist contingently to the furtherance of the principles
 contained in it. If a State system can be shown to be inimical to them it must go,
 if social customs hamper their continuous expansion - they must be modified, if
 unbridled industrialism checks their growth, then industrialism must be reined in.

That is to say, we must build up from the Individual, not down from the State.
