Although less than 100 pages in length, this work of Major C.H. Douglas is unquestionably one of the most important books of this century. As its title indicates, *The Brief for the Prosecution* is an indictment of those persons, groups and organisations responsible for



the systematic sabotage of Western Civilisation as a prelude to fastening upon a bewildered and deliberately demoralised humanity, an all-powerful World Government - a tyranny of unspeakable horror. Written in 1943, the expose ...is concentrated mainly on the period between the two World Wars, as they are called - from the Bolshevik Revolution to the emergence of Communist Russia as chief beneficiary of World War II.
